[PROPOSED] ORDER

This matter is before the undersigned Hearing Officer on Enforcement Counsel's Motion to Strike Respondents' Purported Motions *in Limine*, filed on March 20, 2014.

It is HEREBY ORDERED that the following motions filed by Respondents on March 19, 2014 are stricken: (1) Respondents' Motion in Limine to Preclude the Bureau From Using These Proceedings to Regulate the Business of Insurance or Collaterally Attack the Actions of State Insurance Regulators; (2) Respondents' Motion in Limine to Strike the Bureau's Claims for Remedies Other Than Injunctive Relief for Conduct Prior to July 21, 2011; (3) Respondents' Motion in Limine to Dismiss Respondents Atrium Insurance Corporation and Atrium Reinsurance Corporation for Lack of Statutory Authority; and (4) Respondents' Motion In Limine to Strike Claims Predicated on Ceding Payments Allowed by the Bureau in April and May 2013.

It is FURTHER ORDERED THAT Enforcement Counsel shall not be required to respond to those Motions.

It is FURTHER ORDERED THAT the relief sought by Respondents in those Motions is denied.
