## **In the Matter of IrvineWebWorks, Inc. d/b/a Student Loan Processing.US – Case 8:14-cv-01967-JVS-DFM**

### **Background:**

The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, or CFPB, settled legal claims against Student Loan Processing.US, also known as IrvineWebWorks, Inc., for charging consumers illegal fees, deceiving people about the costs of its services, and falsely saying it was affiliated with the U.S. Department of Education. According to the terms of the settlement reached in this case, Student Loan Processing.US was required to permanently shut down all operations, cancel all contracts with consumers, and stop charging consumers any fees.

### **Victim Compensation:**

In December of 2016, the CFPB began mailing checks to eligible consumers who paid fees, including an enrollment fee or monthly maintenance fees, to Student Loan Processing.US pursuant to any agreement entered into on or before March 15, 2016, and who did not already receive a full refund of those fees.
