WRITER, MD: A CREATIVE WRITING WORKSHOP FOR PHYSICIANS

This course will launch in the fall of 2012 in conjunction with the Centre for Creative Writing and Oral Culture and the Department of English at the University of Manitoba. It will be limited to twelve physicians. Writer Dave Williamson will lead the group in a structured, task-oriented setting. SELF-DIRECTED CLINICAL TRAINEESHIPS

Self-directed clinical traineeships are prolonged learning experiences, usually planned to enhance current knowledge or to learn new knowledge and skills. They are personally designed, flexible and effective training for practicing clinicians.
