2014 = 707

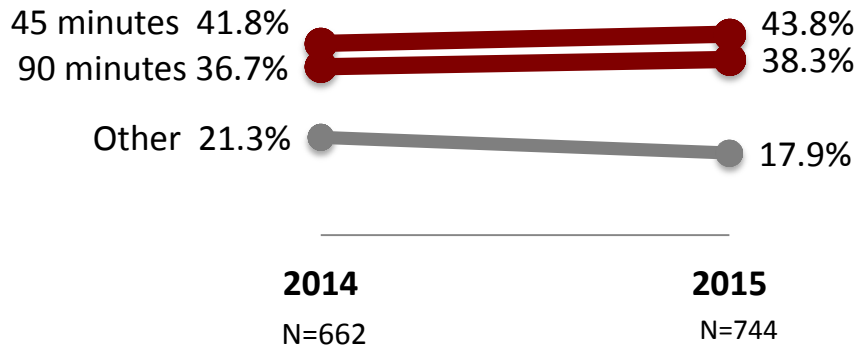
2015 = 777

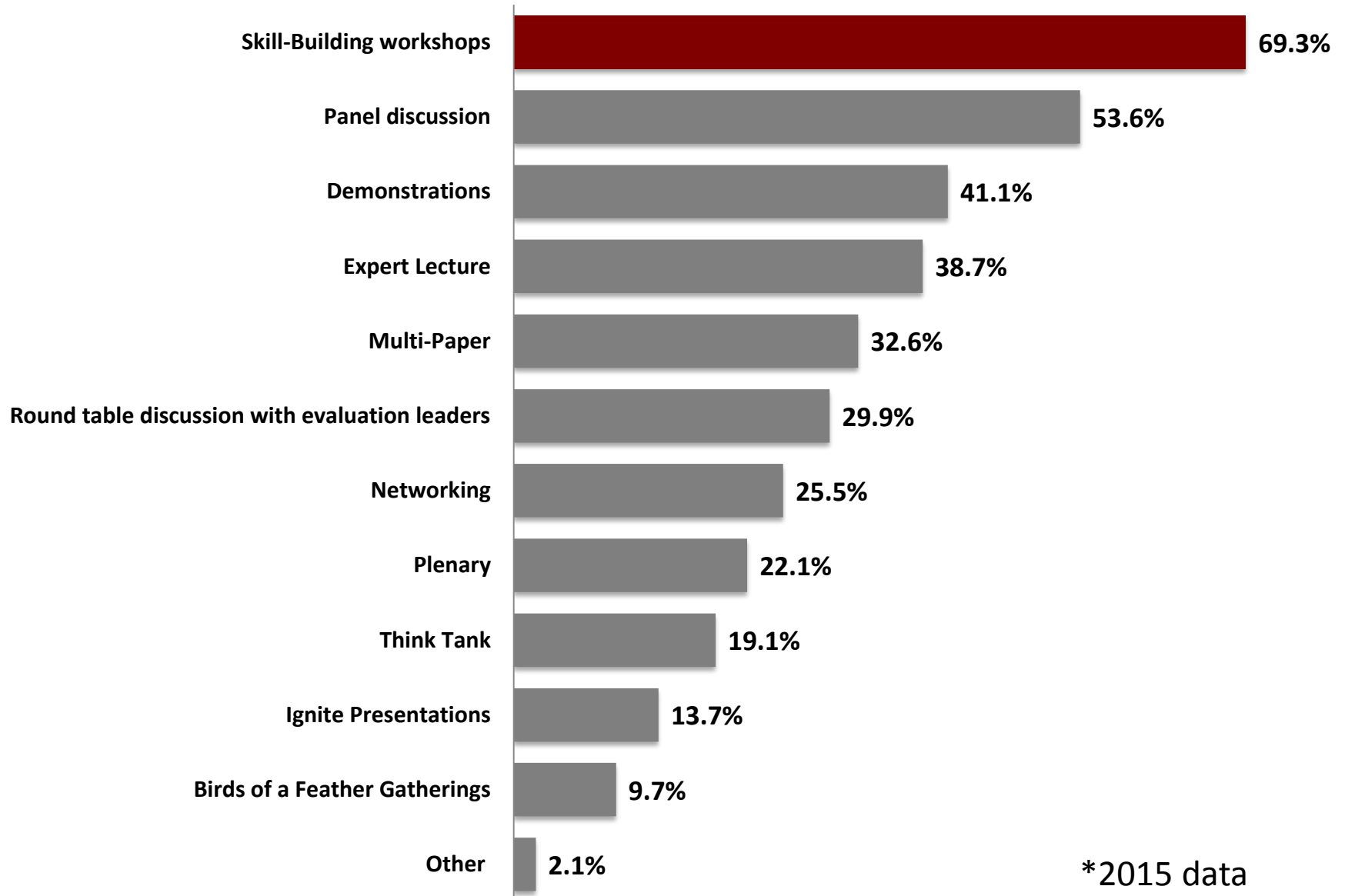
