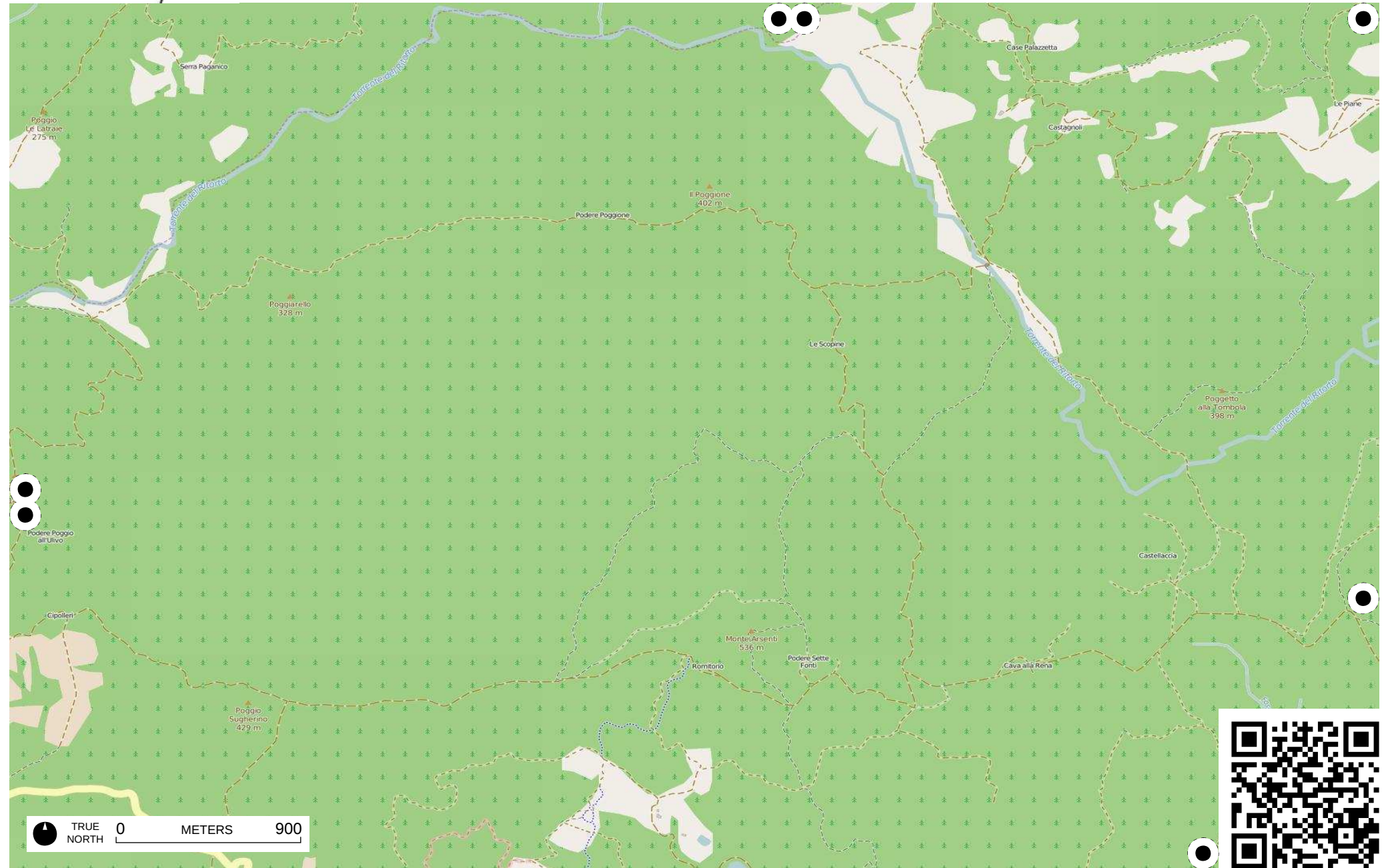


This topographic map displays the terrain around Poggio Sugherino. Key features include:
