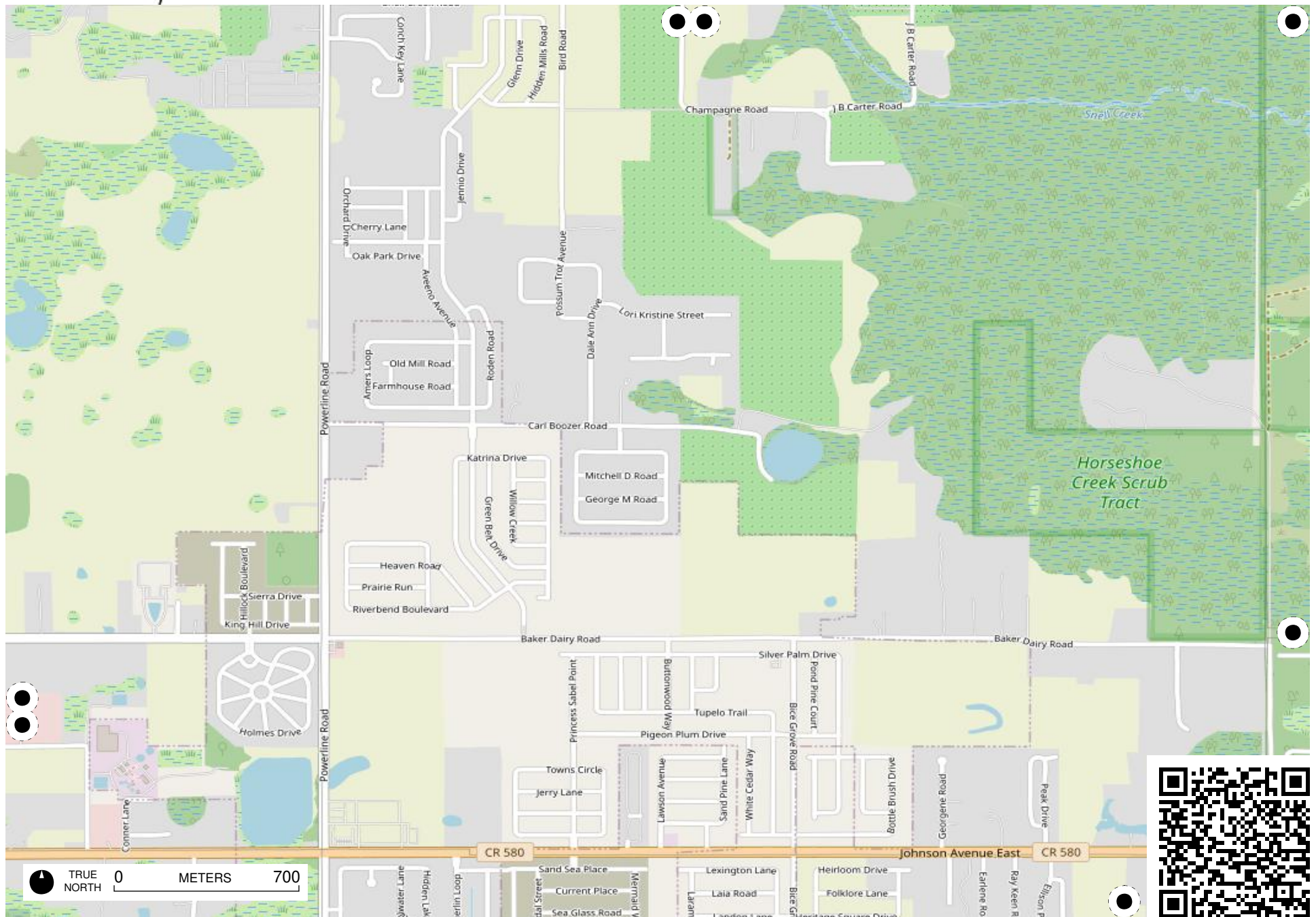
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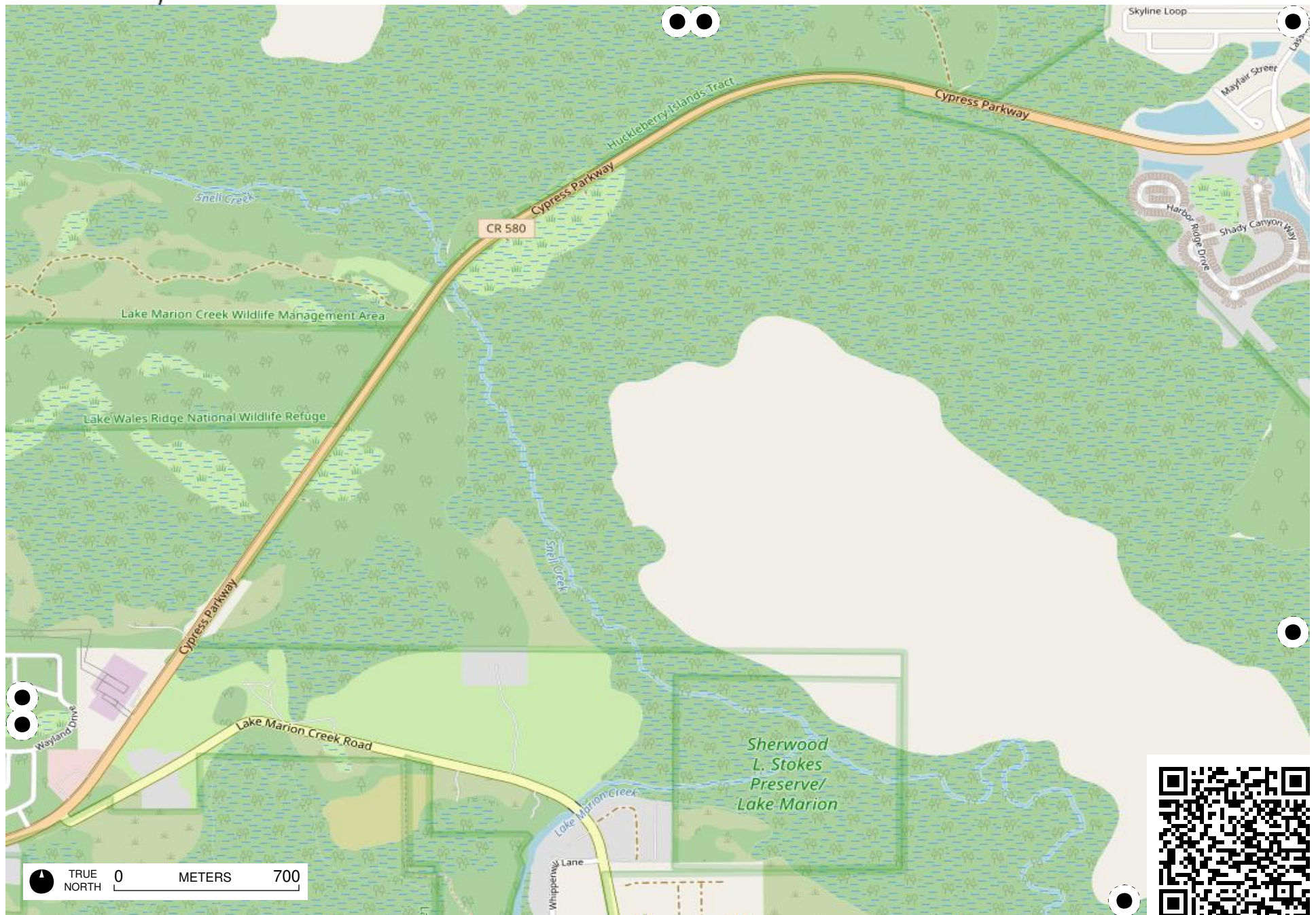
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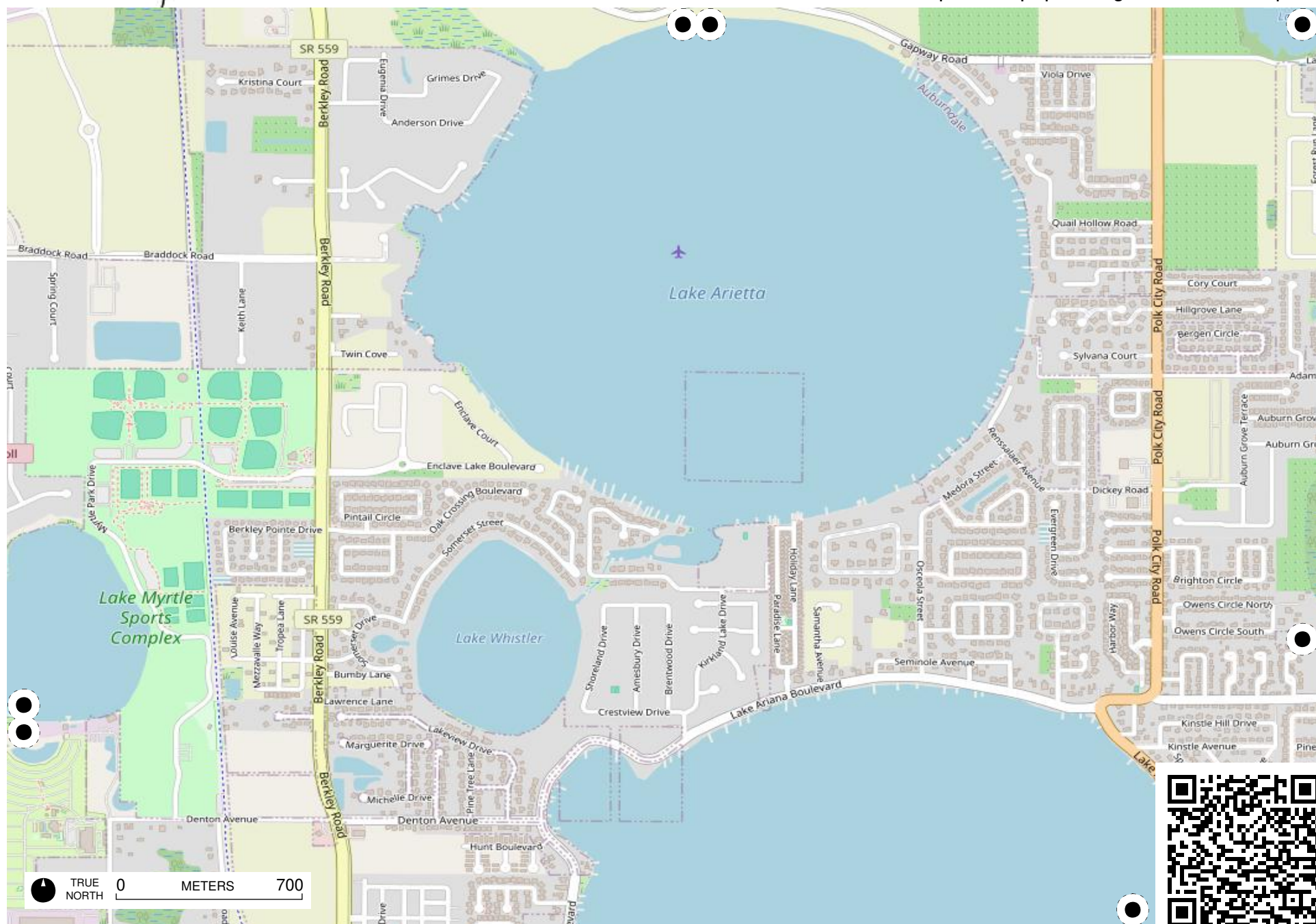


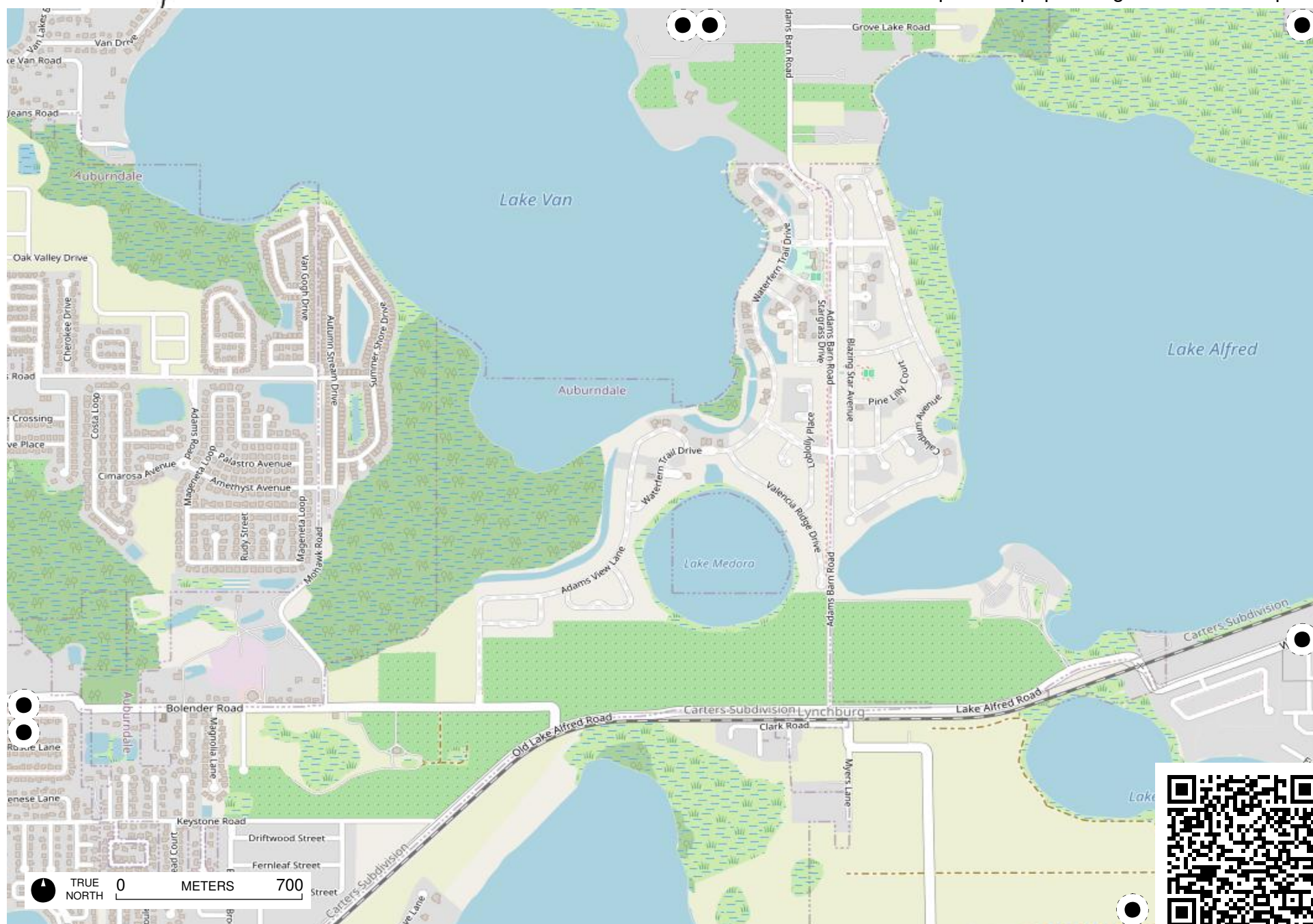


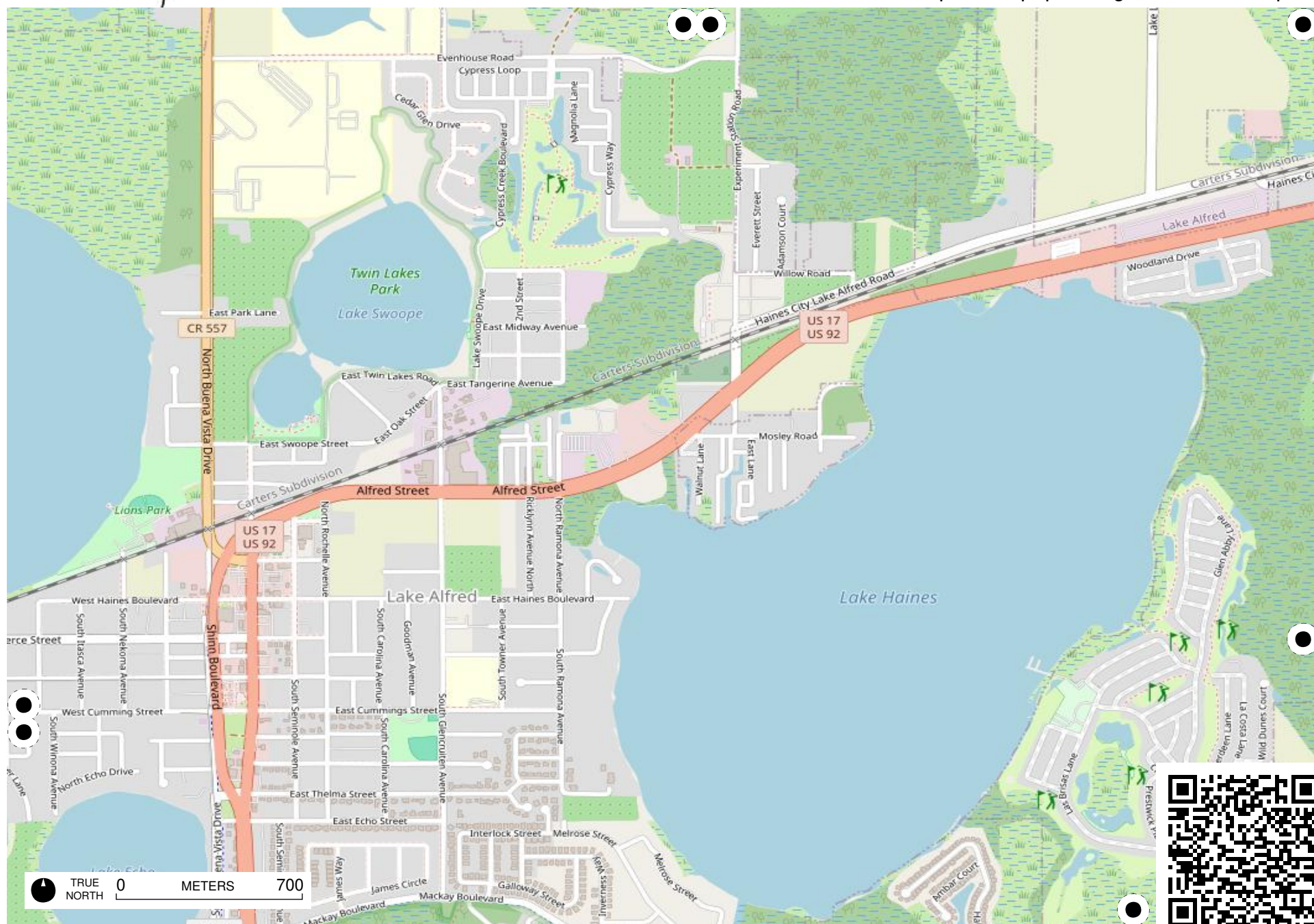


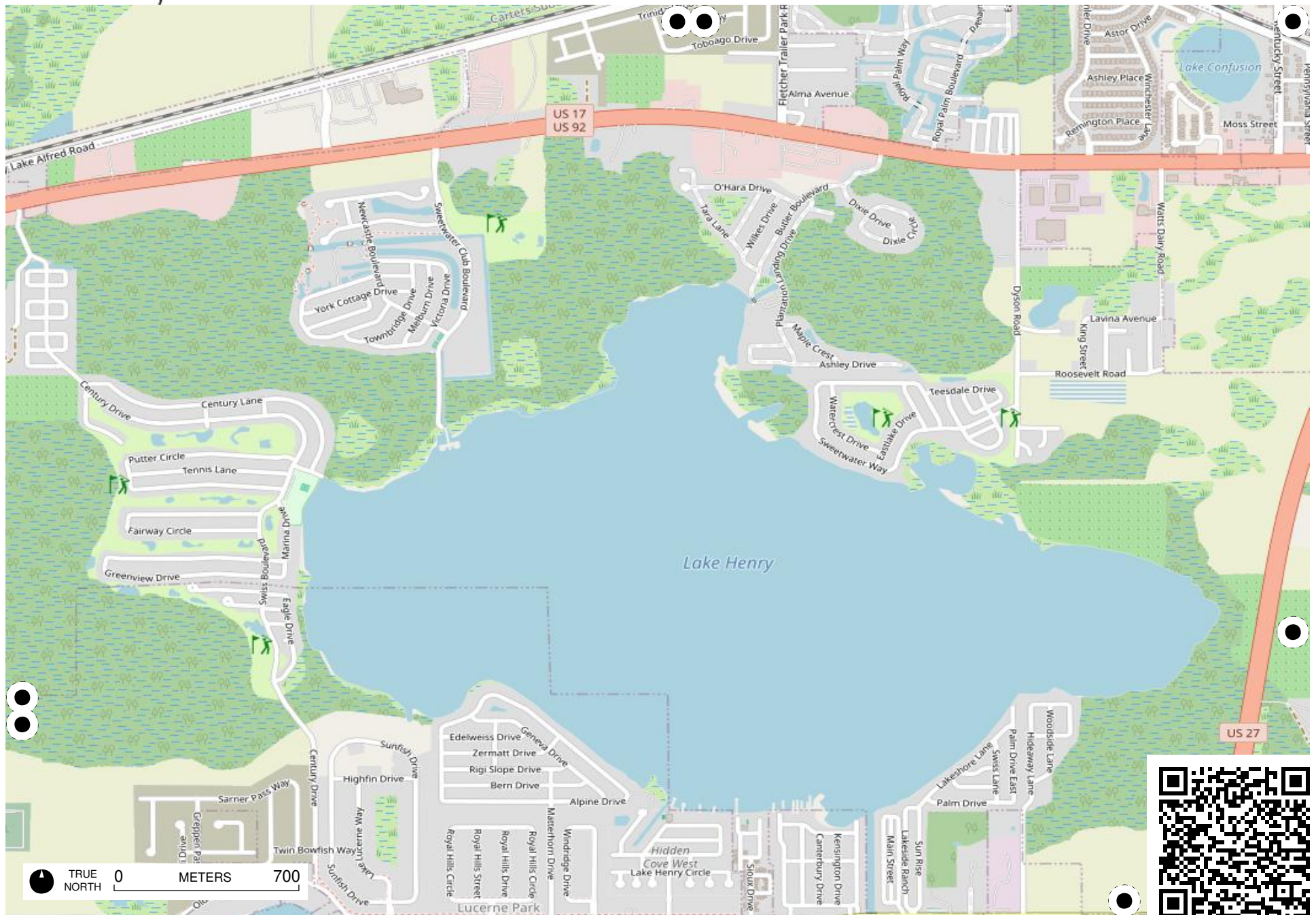


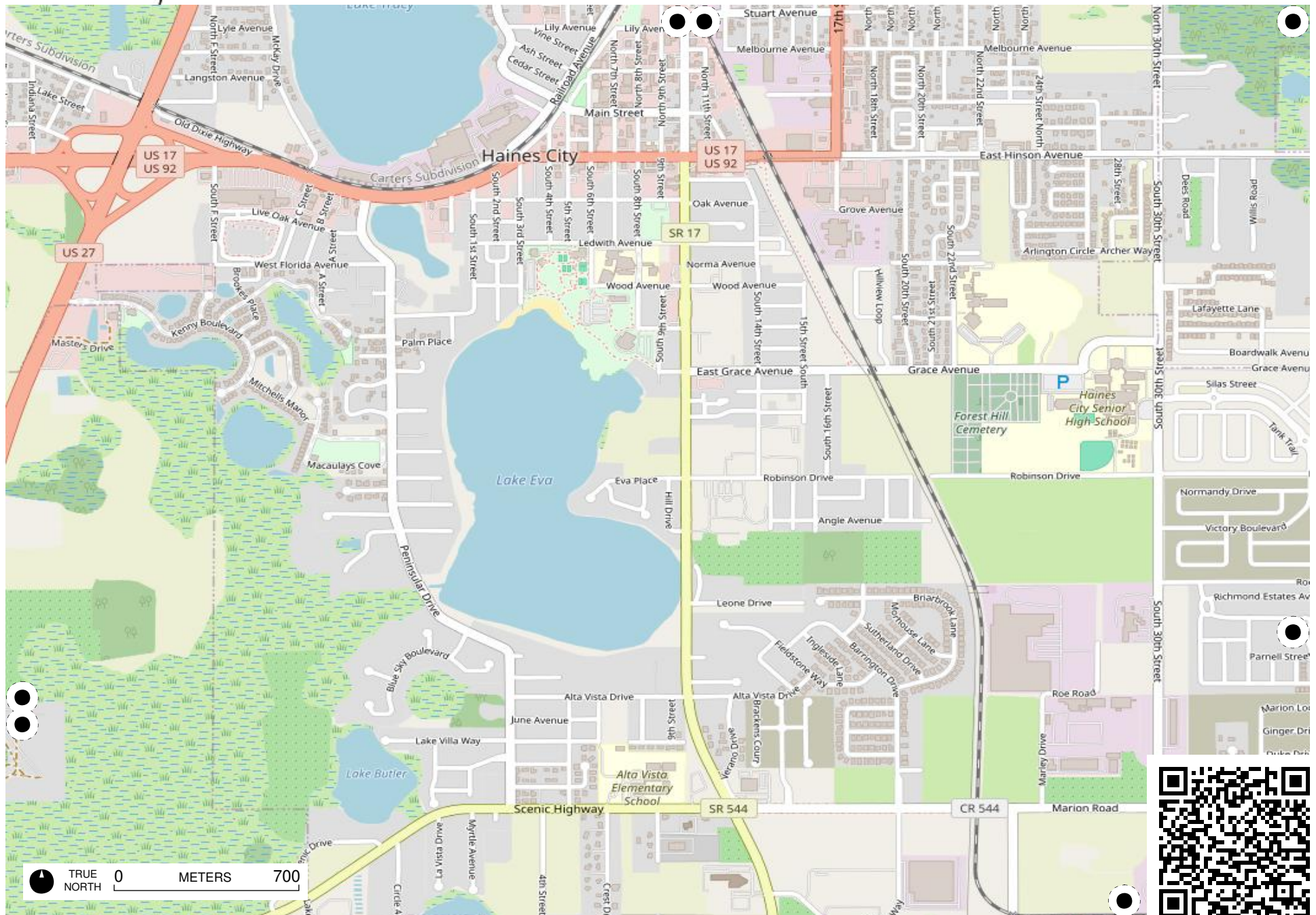


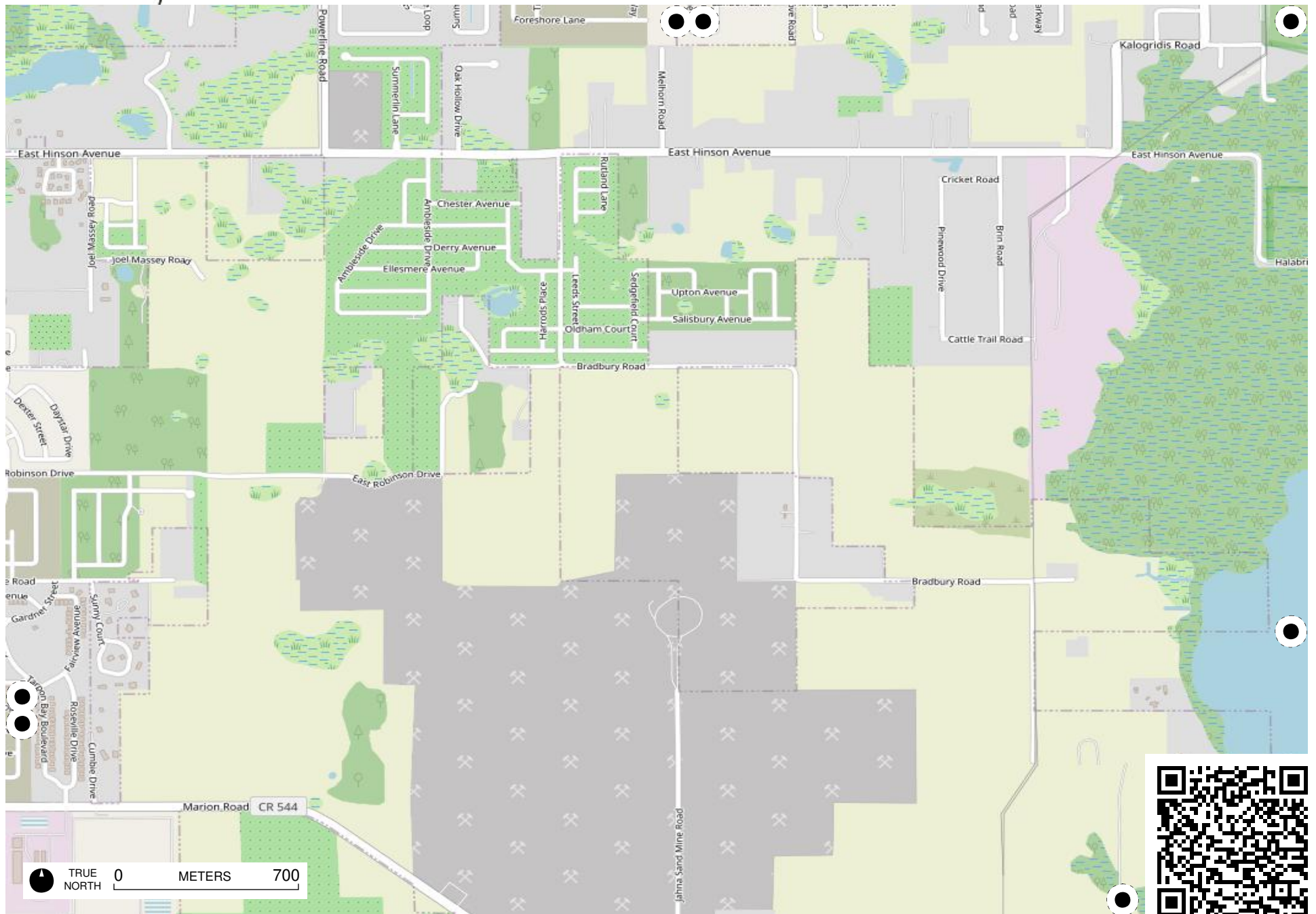


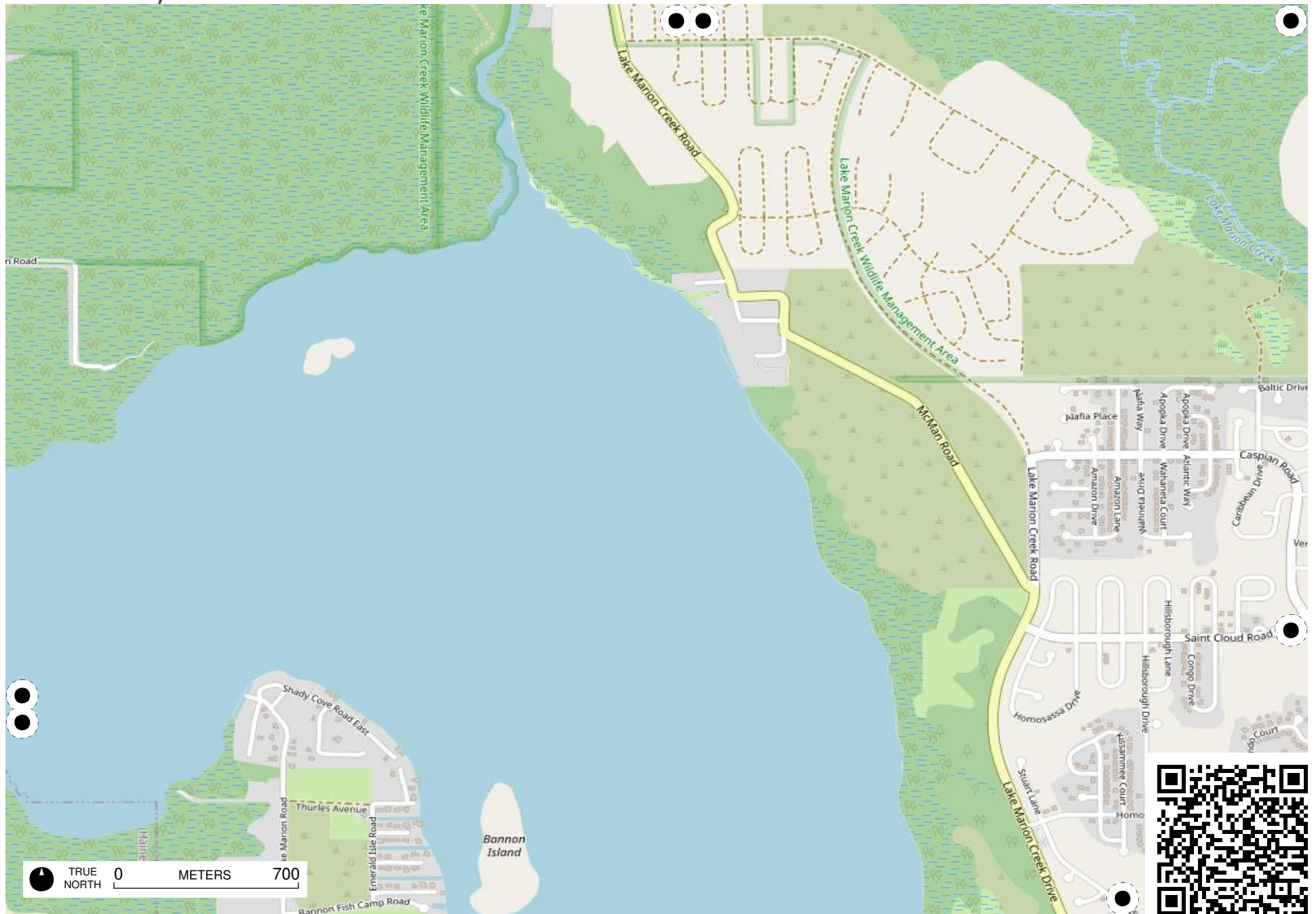


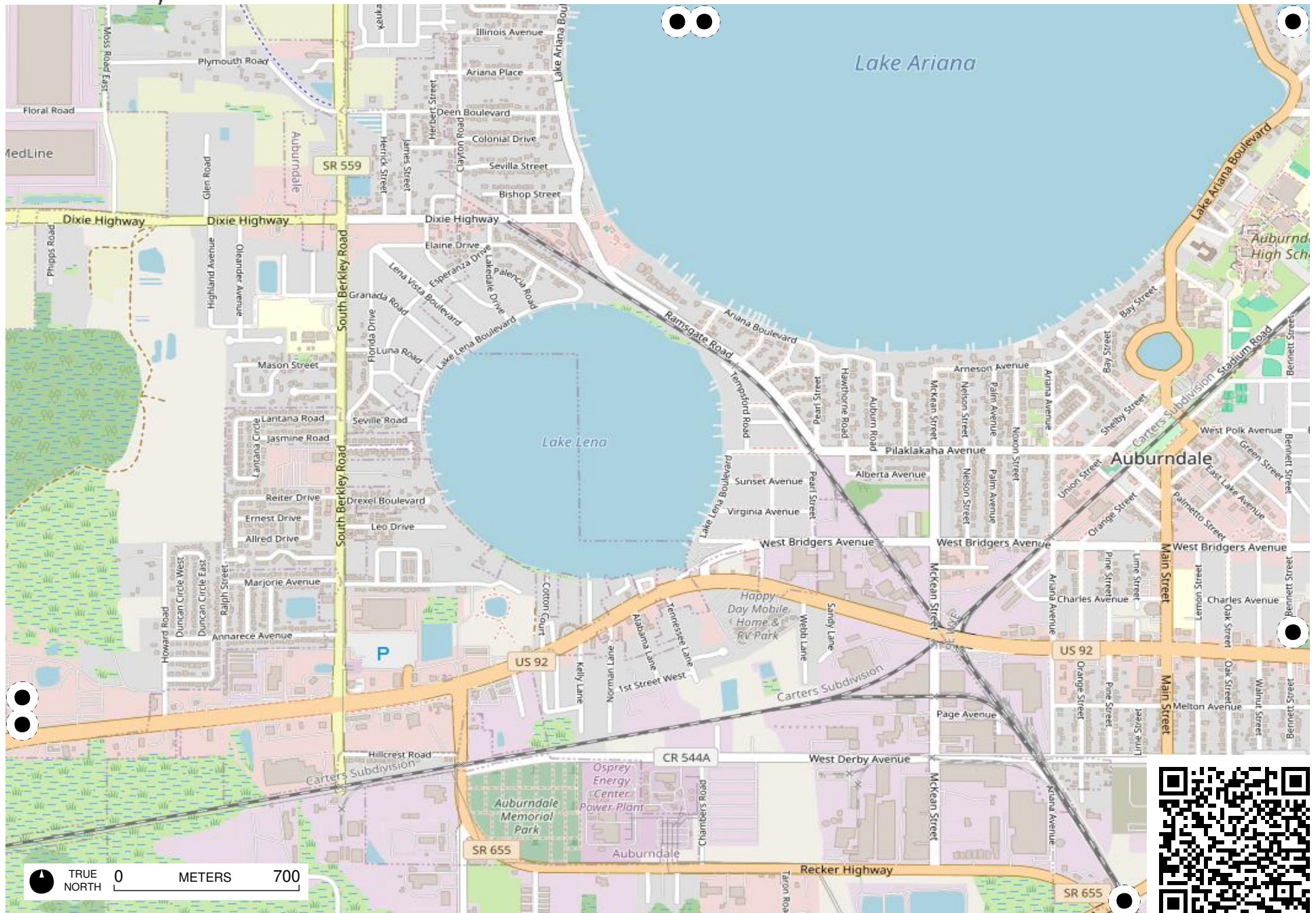


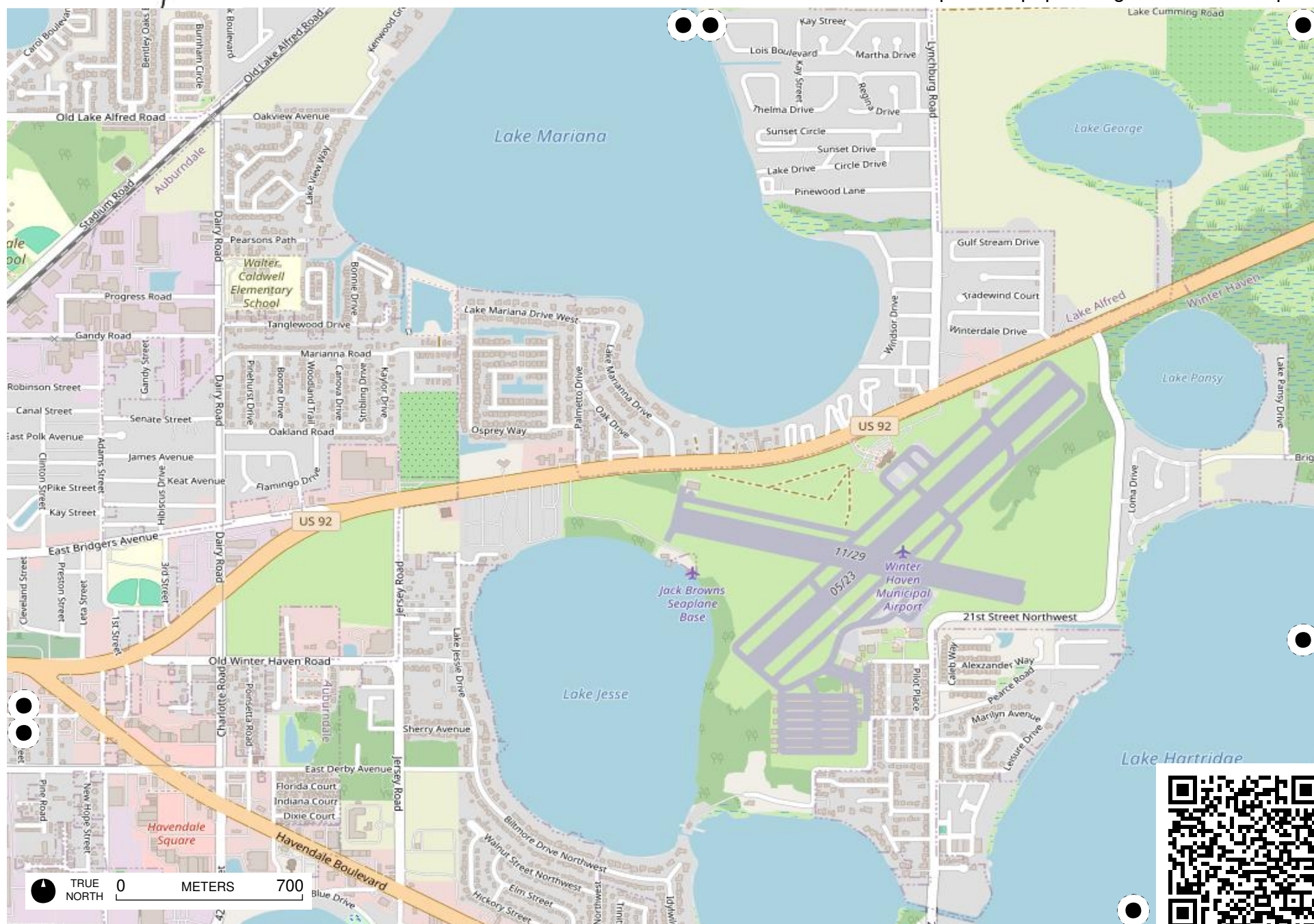


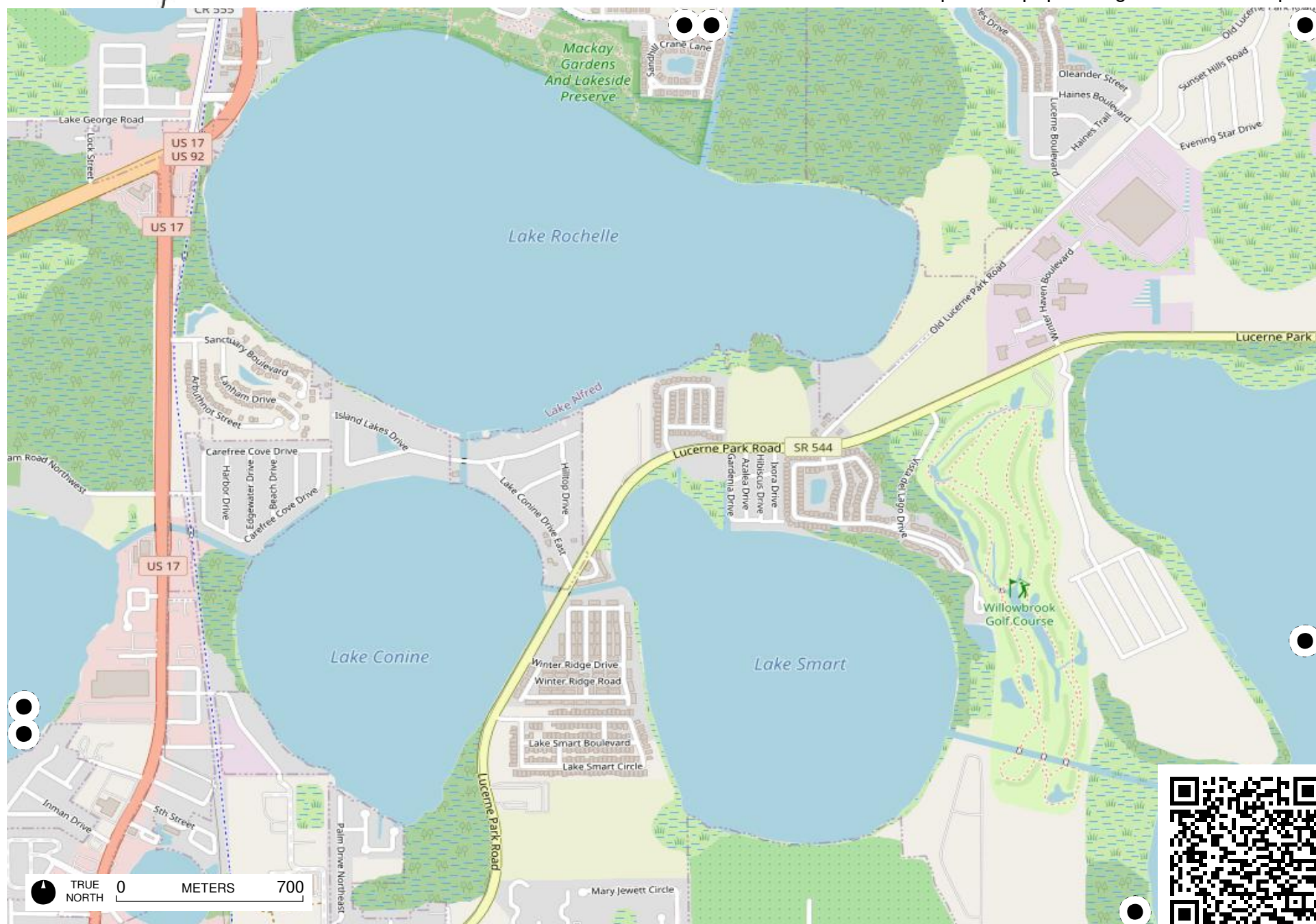


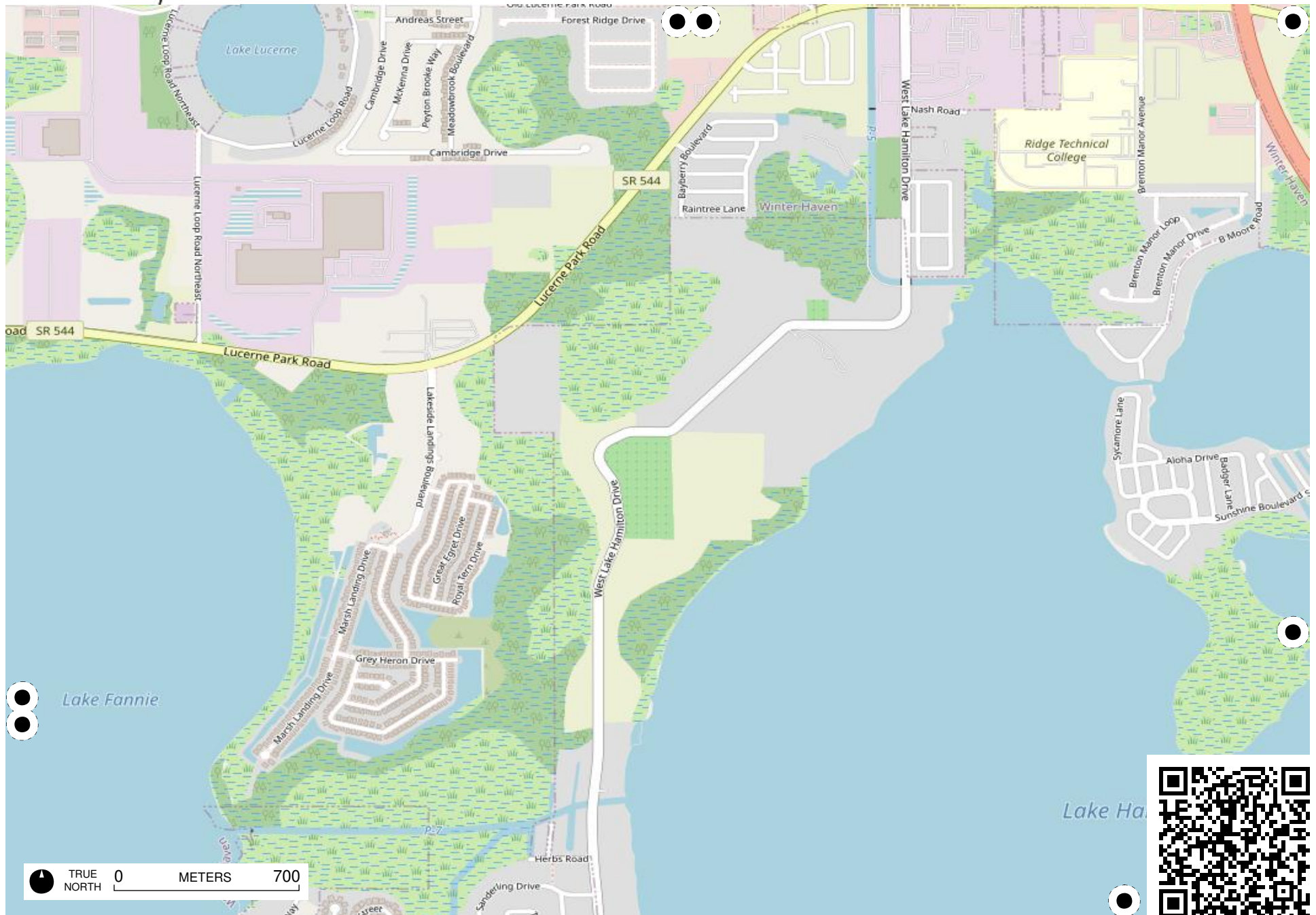


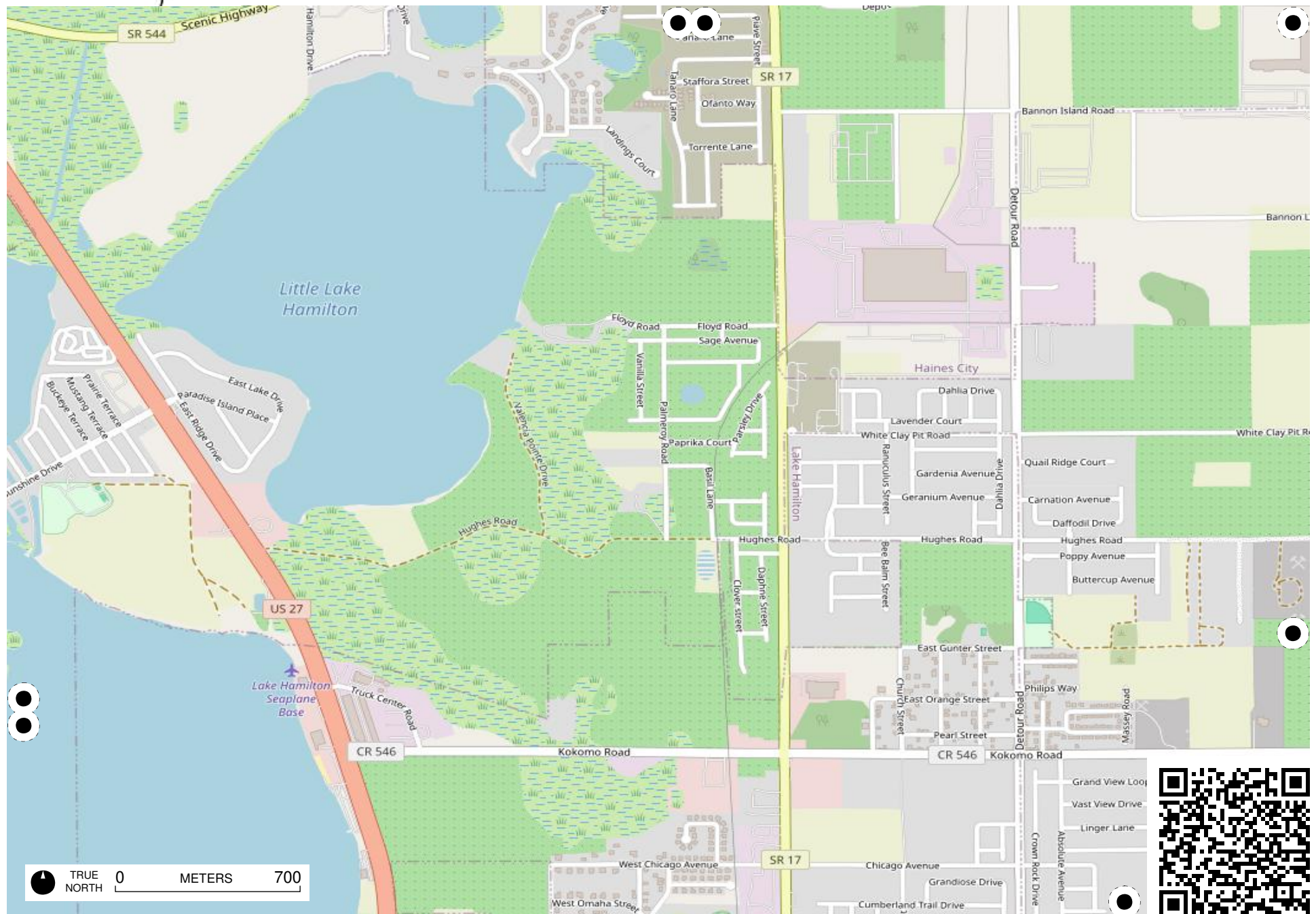


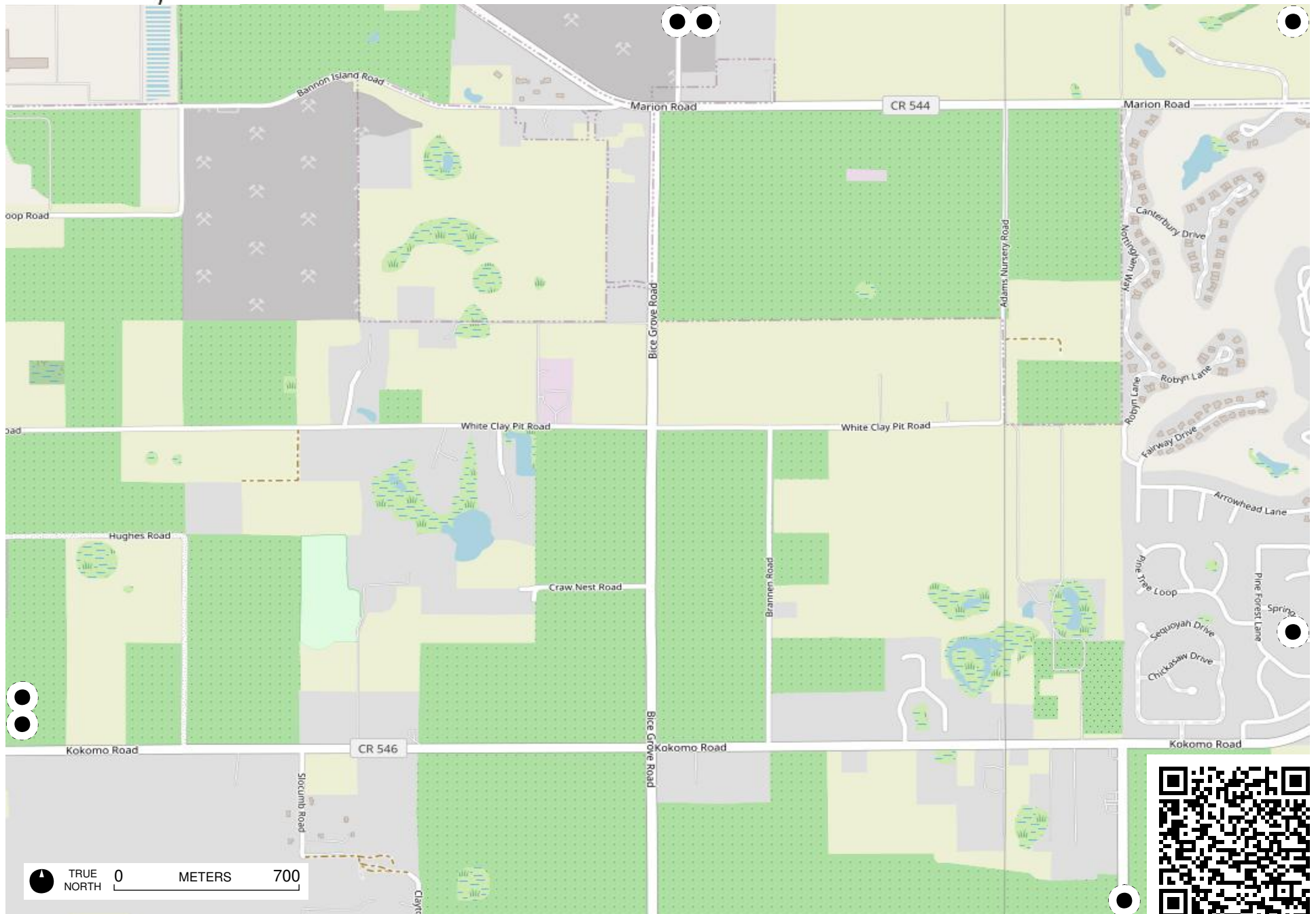


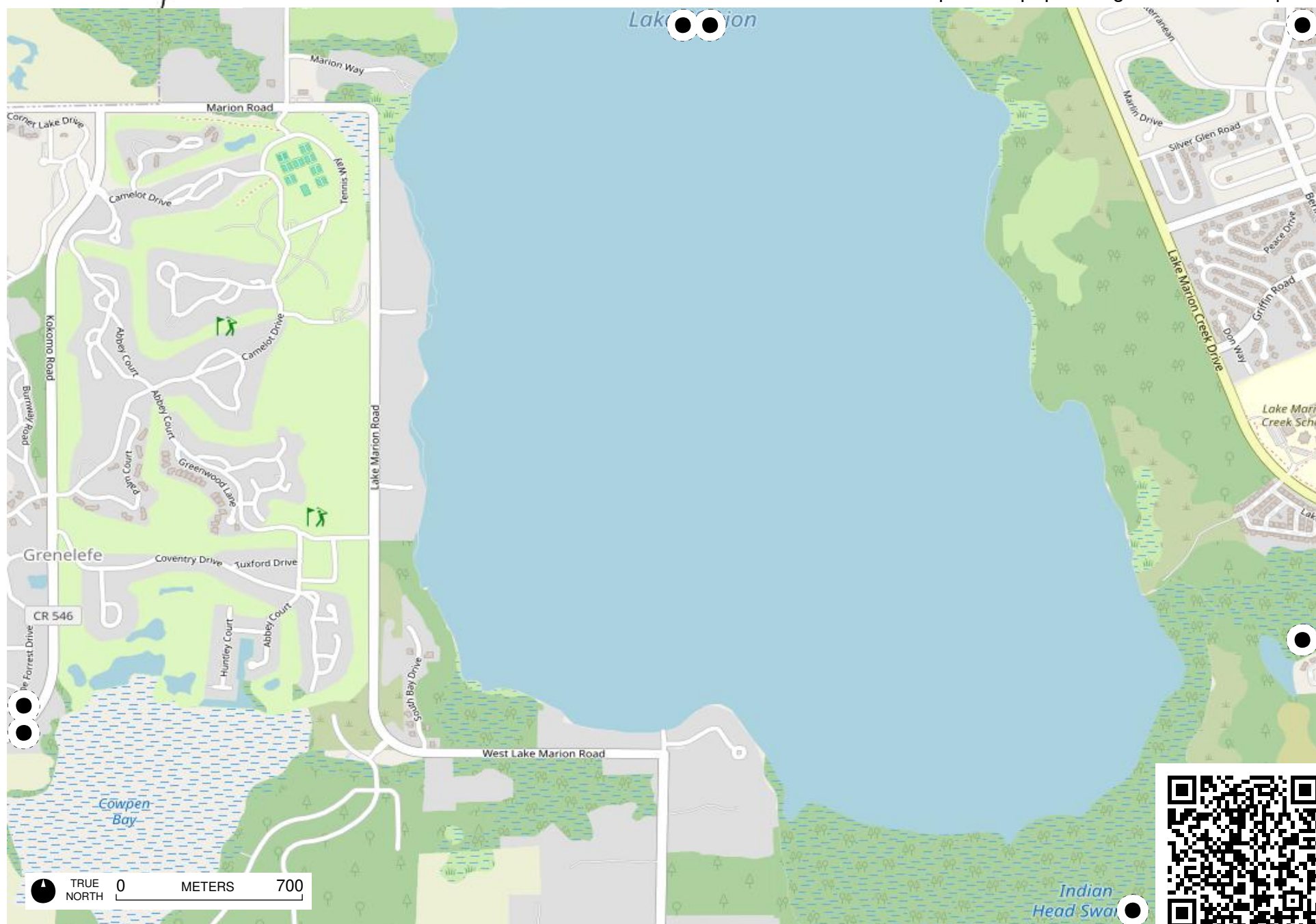


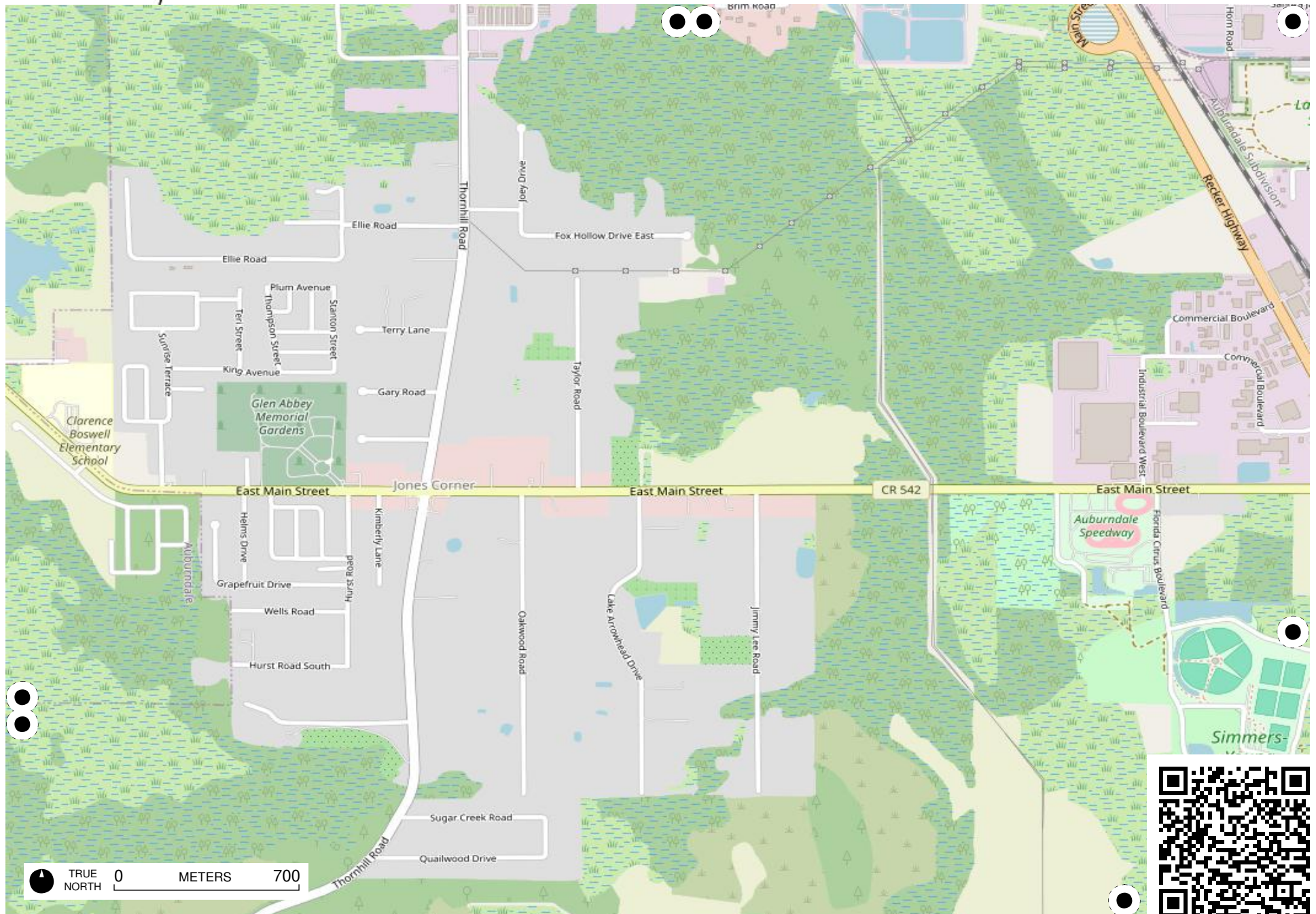












This map shows the Inwood neighborhood in Inglewood, California. Key features include:
