

NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

FLORENCE COUNTY

The Florence County Municipal General Election will be held Tuesday, November 4, 2025. Any person wishing to vote in this election must register no later than Sunday, October 5, 2025. Voter registration by mail forms will be accepted if postmarked by Monday, October 6, 2025.

The following early voting centers will be open during the early voting period from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday October 20-31 (closed Saturdays and Sundays) at the following locations:

Johnsonville Library - 242 S. Georgetown Hwy. Johnsonville, SC 29555

Pamplico Library - 100 E. Main St. Pamplico, SC 29583

Timmonsville Library - 298 W. Smith St, Timmonsville, SC

Olanta Library - 210 E. Hampton St, Olanta SC 29114

Election Central - 219 Third Loop Rd, Florence SC 29505

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs at their polling place.

- S.C. Driver's License
 - Includes standard License and REAL ID
- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card
 - Includes standard ID card and REAL ID
 - Includes SC Concealed Weapons Permit
- S.C Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
 - Includes all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport
 - Includes US Passport ID Card

If you have one of these Photo IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from the Department of Motor Vehicles or their county voter registration office. Voters who encounter an obstacle to getting a Photo ID should bring their paper voter registration card without a photo with them to their polling

place. These voters can then sign an affidavit swearing to their identity and to their obstacle to obtain a Photo ID and vote a provisional ballot. This ballot will count unless the County Board of Voter Registration and Elections has grounds to believe the affidavit is false. At 10:00 a.m. on November 4, the County Board of Voter Registration and Elections will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at the Florence County Voter Registration & Elections Office, 219 Third Loop Road, Florence SC 29505, 843-665-3094.

At 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 6, the County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in this election. This hearing will be held at the Florence County Voter Registration & Elections Office, 219 Third Loop Road, Florence SC 29505, 843-665-3094.

The following precincts and polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. NOTE: Polling locations are subject to change due to the potential unavailability of some locations due to unforeseen circumstances. Always check your polling place at scVOTES.gov before any election.
