### Role Responsibilities

The Central Technical Director is to be Jesus-centered as His disciple and as a leader in His church, living a radical life as the Kingdom of God demands. He/She is to continuously cultivate their relationship with Christ and serve others with a cross-bearing heart. His/Her approach to ministry must be decisive, innovative and contagious with a proven and inherent leadership competency that resulted in healthy Kingdom ministry.

Additionally, the Central Technical Director will ...

- Oversee campus specific production elements for weekends, student ministries, conferences and other special events
- Lead the weekly development and training of volunteer teams
- Maintain workspaces and coordinate repairs of equipment
- Assist with conferences, installs or other events as required

### General Requirements

The Central Technical Director must ...

- Understand and embrace the theology of inaugurated eschatology and its implications for followers of Christ
- Believe that the Holy Spirit indwells and empowers every follower of Jesus, and consistently experience the very power and presence of God at work inside, through, and around him/her as he/she participates in God's mission in the world
- Demonstrate a passion and aptitude for making disciples of Jesus and prioritize his/her life and ministry accordingly
- Share in the continued mission of Jesus by consistently ministering, through the power of the Holy Spirit, God's presence, love, truth, and power to all those he/she encounters
- Embrace genuine Christian community as the primary vehicle of discipleship at The Chapel
- Live a life defined by a revolutionary commitment to, and personal sacrifice for, the cause of Jesus Christ in the Kingdom of God

- Working knowledge of digital audio networks and transmission, specifically with Dante, Soundgrid, GIGA-ACE and MADI
- Complete understanding of professional audio systems and Yamaha audio consoles
- Understanding of Art-Net Networks, DMX Networking, Pro Video Player & Pro Video Server software, and Jands Vista lighting systems
- Understanding of Cinematic cameras and Ross Carbonite switchers
- Proven ability to successfully support and train volunteer teams
