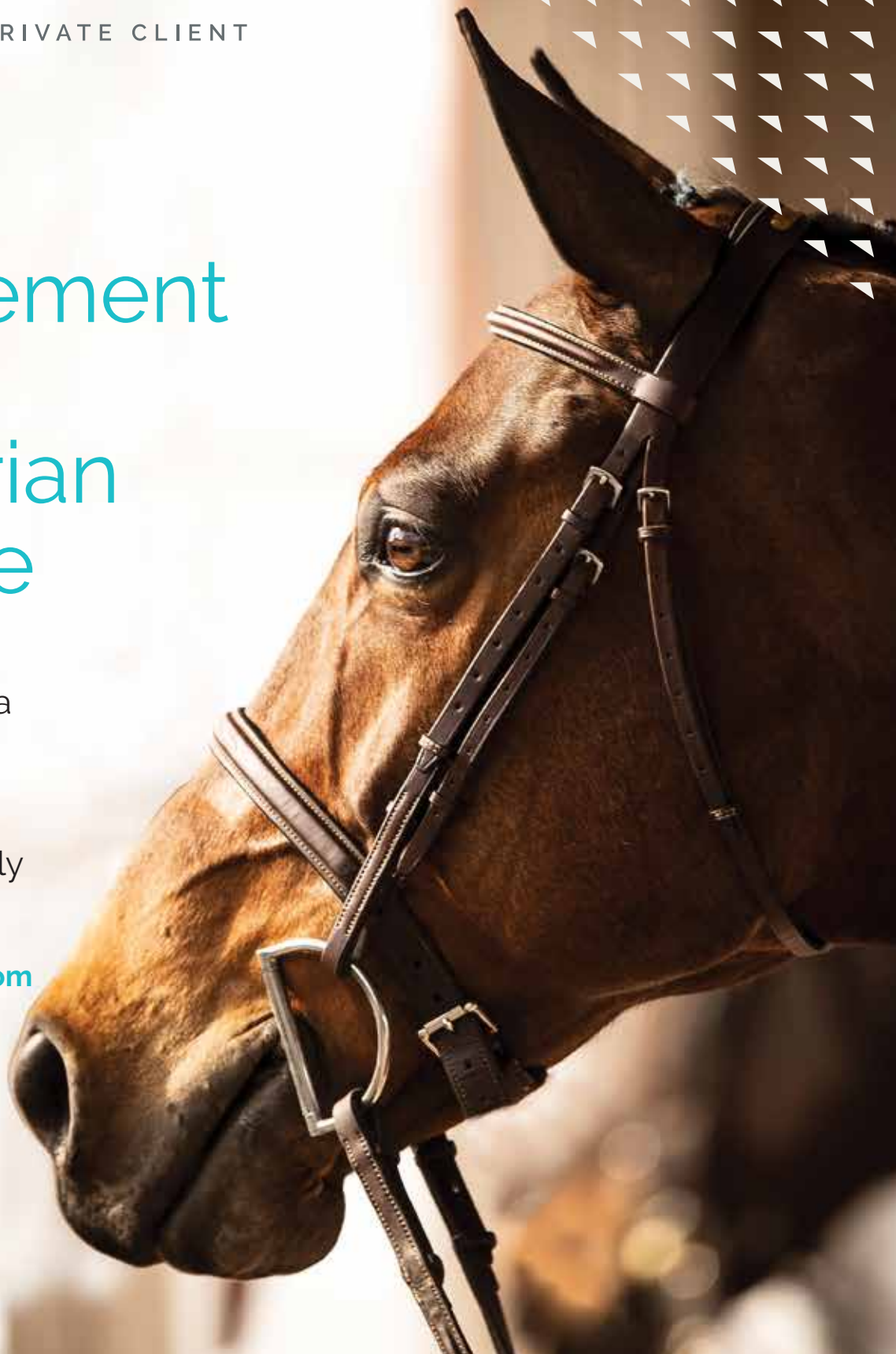

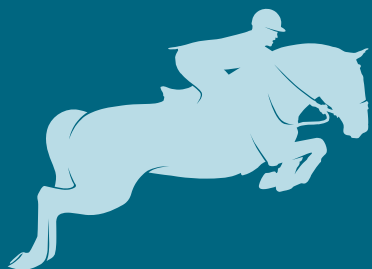

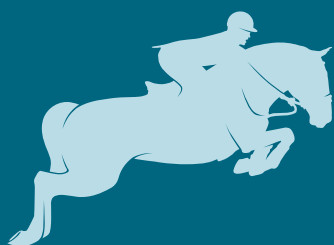

Only Juniors and Amateurs may declare for the applicable Junior or Amateur-Owner section. In order to earn points toward IHD Awards and Finals, Horses must be enrolled in the International Hunter Derby program. Enrollment is not required to compete in the class.

SECURE STABLING - Horses must purchase a stall and be stabled on the grounds 24 hours prior to the start of the class. Horses must remain on the competition grounds until finished competing in the Derby. Any horse in violation of this requirement will be disqualified.

JOGGING - Horses are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of the over fences performance. Horses may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion. Judges have the authority to disqualify a horse if deemed unsound.

SCHOOLING REQUIREMENTS - During the 24 hour period prior to the class, horses must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas only. Competition number must be worn at all times while mounted.

ORDER OF GO - The Order of Go for the First Round will be drawn. The Order for the Second Round will be reverse order of scores from Round 1. The Order for the Jump-off, if any, will be the same as that for Round 2.

ATTIRE - Formal attire required. Buff breeches and shad belly, white breeches and dark or scarlet coat, hunt colors coat or official sponsor or team jacket permitted.

RIBBONS & AWARDS - Ribbons 1-12 for First Round, Second Round and Overall.

ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING THE COMPETITION

- All horses must remain in the schooling area under the supervision of the Supervisor and the Paddock Manager.
- Only one rider per horse.
- Riders are responsible for the course walk as well as the management and schooling of their own horse.

- Two refusals will result in elimination from the round.

TACK/EQUIPMENT - Conventional tack per JP 111. Running or standing martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted. Change of tack is permissible between phases.

This program will allow riders and trainers to choose what height, what days, and in what rings their Young Jumpers compete, allowing flexibility and affordability in developing the horses of tomorrow.

Whether you are training for the Child/Adult Jumper at the Marshall & Sterling Insurance League Finals, or the Olympic Games in Paris, Milan or Los Angeles, the HITS Young Jumper Program supports the horses in training, their owners, riders, and the people who care for them.

HITS OCALA YOUNG JUMPER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Under this Program, any horse 7-Years Old or under may show in up to three "open" jumper classes at .65m-1.30m, and have the class fees waived for those classes. See details below. This is in addition to the Young Jumper 5-, 6- and 7-Year Old Jumper Classes that are already offered with a free entry fee. Horses will be eligible to receive Prize Money in classes that offer it. Special Classes, Classics, or classes restricted to Juniors, Amateurs, Child or Adult riders are not included in the program. Exception: a class shown "hors concours" will be eligible for the Program, but prize money will not be paid. Additional Rounds in the Tuesday Jumper Classes (Classes 715 1.0m, and 719 1.10m or any other class that may be added to Tuesday) will count as "classes." Hunter and Equitation classes will not count for this program, and will not be credited.

Horses must have their age on file with their USEF/USHJA Registration, declare their age when Registering with USEF/USHJA at the show, or have their age proven by their FEI Passport, Breed Papers or a statement from a licensed Veterinarian on official Letterhead.

Horses must be Declared for the Young Jumper Program at the time of check-in each week, when back numbers are picked up for the show. At checkout, Exhibitors must review accounts with the Show Office for class credits. Horses will be credited for the class fees for the three lowest priced classes eligible for the program. Example: if the horse shows in three "Non-Nominated" jumper classes, and one "Nominated" jumper class, the three "Non-Nominated" classes will be credited. The Show office is not responsible for credits not issued for horses whose accounts are not closed out in the Show Office, or by email or remote method. Horses not declared for the Young Jumper program at check-in will not be eligible to have their class fees credited.

Horses will be charged for any Stalls, All Inclusive Facility Fee, USEF/USHJA Horse/Drug Fees, Nomination Fees and any other Association Fees (Showpass fees, Horse or Owner/Rider/Trainer Membership fees, etc.), any Feed/Bedding, Paddocks, RV's, Restaurant Charges, and any other Miscellaneous Fees (Shoeing, Vet, Post Entry Fee, etc.), and any entry or nominating fees for classes beyond the three eligible classes showed in.

Horses must purchase a weekly stall from the horseshow to be eligible for this program. Nomination Fees will not be credited.

Any questions or discrepancies not covered herein will be decided by Show Management, its decision to be final. Updates may be made to this policy as needed.

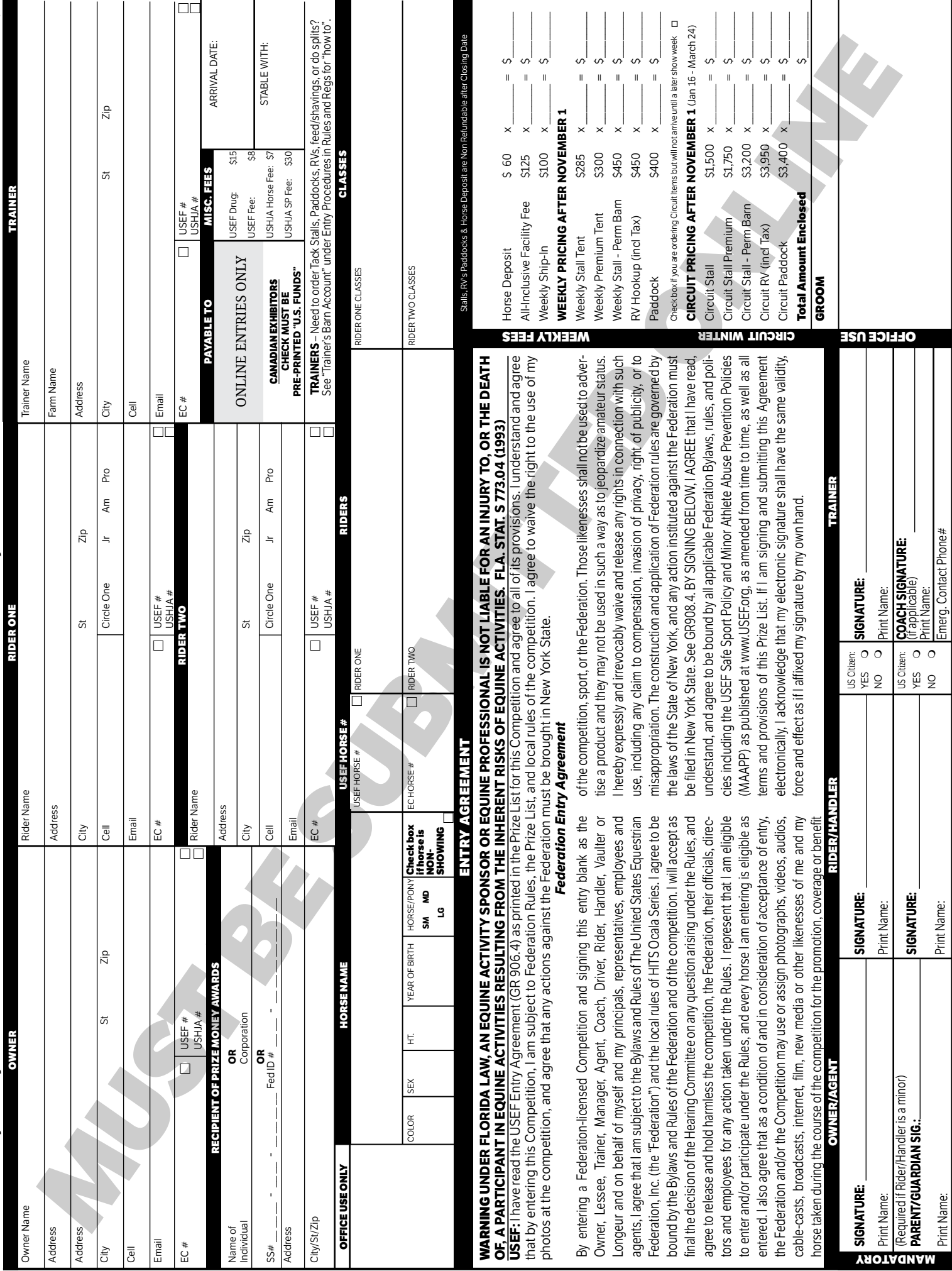


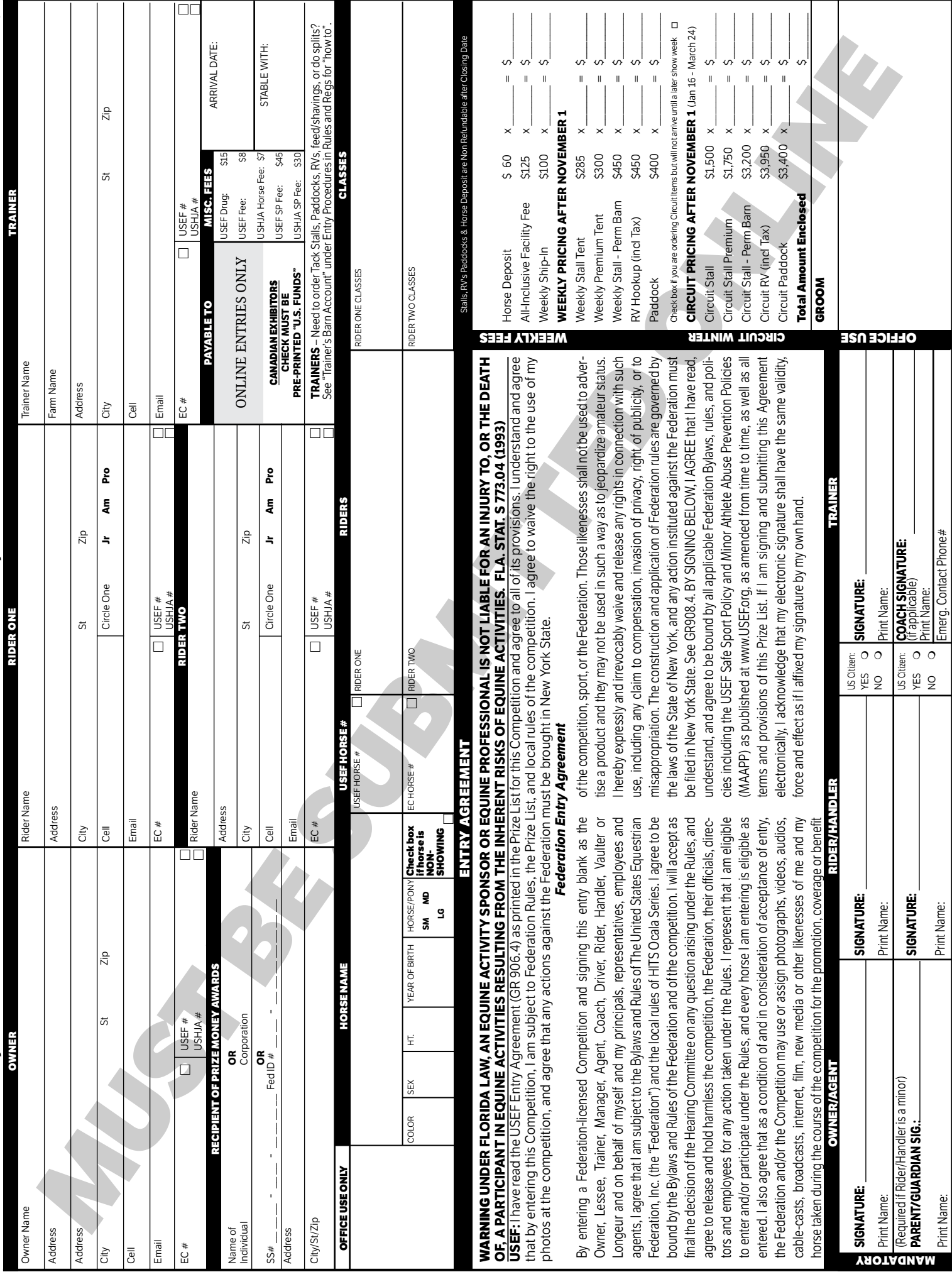

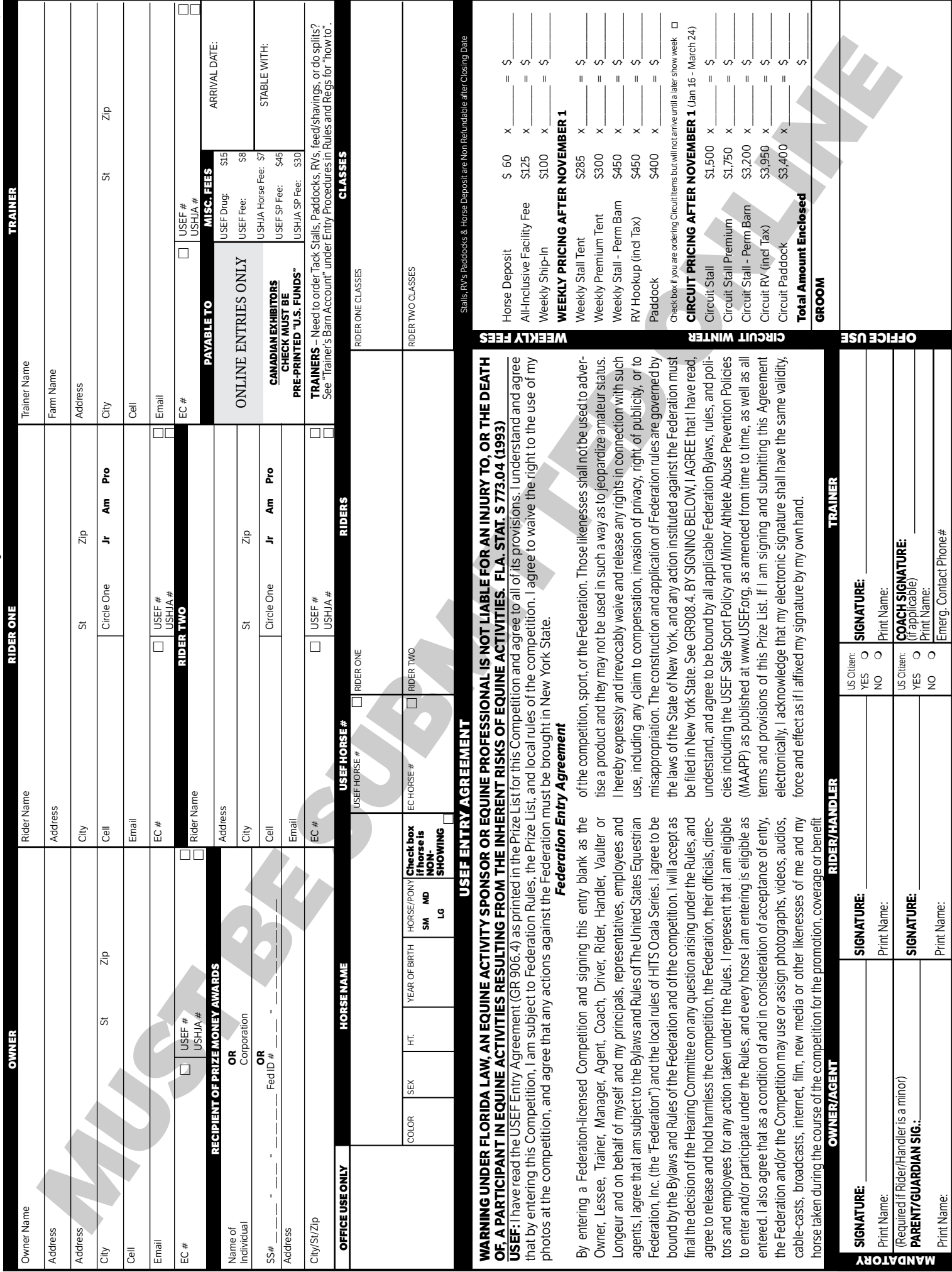

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and **HITS OCALA WINTER CIRCUIT ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events")**; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**").

WARNING:

Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. **WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY:** In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

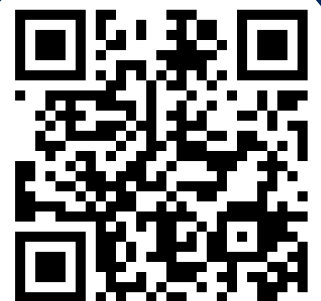

EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

HITS Post Time Farm | Ocala, Florida

Revised as of October 2023

Protecting the health of your horse and other horses at HITS Ocala Winter Circuit is of the utmost importance to HITS. HITS has implemented Required Biosecurity Measures to decrease the risk of introduction and/or spread of contagious or infectious disease at its shows.

Horses must arrive only between the hours of 8 am - 5 pm daily. Off-hours arrival must obtain permission from Show Management by calling 352.620.2275, 24 hours prior to arrival.

UPON ARRIVAL TO HITS POST TIME FARM, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE & PROVIDE:

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED DATED WITHIN TWELVE MONTHS

(365 days) of the ending date of each show. This includes horses that originate from the state where the event is being held. All horses entering the Show Grounds must have a Negative Coggins on file. Coggins must reflect the horse's SHOW NAME.

EVENT PARTICIPATION DECLARATION

Required

Signed by the owner/agent/trainer verifying that the horse has been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and has not had a fever above 102°F within 72 hours (3 days) of arrival. Event Participation Declaration Form available in this prize list and at HITSShows.com.

A new Event Participation Declaration Form must be filed each time the horse enters the property. Horses stabled off the property that "ship-in" on a regular basis must comply with this requirement as well as additional requirements noted on the following pages. Visit HITSShows.com for further details.

PROOF OF VACCINATION

Required

Via a signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **Equine Influenza (EIV)**

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: **Rhinopneumonitis (EHV 1 and EHV 4)**

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for that show.

PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering the Showgrounds both Showing and Non-Showing. These documents must be filed in the Show Office **before any competition numbers will be issued.** In addition, random checks for Equine Health Requirements will occur. Be sure to keep a copy of all of your horse's Equine Health Requirements in an easily accessible spot (in your tack room or tack trunk, truck or trailer) to ensure you can comply with this requirement. The results on all required papers must indicate the horse's registered (show) name.

Any horse not accompanied by these documents will be directed to the Show Veterinarian to obtain the required documents and/or vaccinations, and/or will be placed in quarantined stabling until the proper documents are obtained. Any horse showing signs of fever/illness/stress is subject to examination by HITS Officials and/or the Show Veterinarian, who may at their sole discretion, place the horse in quarantined stabling or take further action if deemed necessary.

SHIP-INS / DAY TRIPPERS

Any Horse entering the Grounds of HITS Ocala, showing or non-showing, must abide by the Equine Health Requirements as set forth in the prize list. In addition, horses that ship-in daily for their classes, for warm-ups, or that are on the grounds for any reason and do not reside in a stall on the Showgrounds must also abide by the following:

Ship-in / Day Parking: Ship-in/Day Parking will be in the designated lot behind Tents 12-16, next to Barn 24 (2 Horse Trailers only). Day Parking will not be allowed in any other area on the Showgrounds, and will **not be allowed anywhere along 137th Avenue.**

Health Documentation: All ship-ins/day trippers (showing or non-showing) must file the proper Health Requirements in the show office, and must be prepared to present those health records at any time while on the Showgrounds. Ship-ins/day trippers will be subject to random checks by HITS Staff. Keep a copy of all of your horse's records in your truck or trailer to ensure you can comply with this requirement. If proper records are not immediately available, the horse(s) a.) must remain under HITS Staff observation until the paperwork is presented, or b.) will be asked to leave the grounds.

Show Weeks May Close: Exhibitors are advised that some show weeks may sell out. After the Closing Date of Entries, priority is given to exhibitors who enter two or more show weeks.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to eighth place in all Hunter and Jumper Classes unless otherwise noted. Prize Money is awarded to Sixth place in Hunter classes and Eighth place in Jumper classes. For Special Classes and Classics, see Prize Money Distribution on following pages.

International Riders: All classes held during the 2024 HITS Ocala Winter Circuit will be run under National rules with regard to riders. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a First come, First served basis. All International Riders must have an active, competing USEF Membership as well as having completed SafeSport Training for Riders 18 and Older.

HJ106.2: All horses regardless of show or non-showing are required to submit an entry with the Horse Show Office and wear or display the back number at all times. Any horse without a back number or with an incorrect back number will be asked to leave the area.

HUNTERS

Jog: Jogging will follow the modified method of trotting a circle at the end of a round. The following sections will not jog: Hi-Low, Low, Schooling, Training, Baby Green, Green, Young, HITS Hunter, Thoroughbred Hunter, Children's, Adult, Modified Child, Modified Adult, Pre-Children's, Pre-Adult, Post Time Child Hunter, Post Time Adult Hunter, Short Stirrup, Schooling Pony, Modified Amateur and Modified Junior.

Hunter Champion & Reserve: Awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences. In addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model.

Warm-Up: Ticketed warm-ups will be offered daily Tuesday through Thursday from 8 am - 5 pm with ring availability. Tickets are \$30 each. Back number required.

Schooling is prohibited in the show rings.

24-Hour Stabling Rule: Any class of \$25,000 or more will be subject to the USEF 24-Hour Stabling Rule. Horses must purchase a stall directly from the show and reside in the stall on the official Showgrounds of HITS Ocala for the 24-Hour period leading up to and during the class.

2024 Zone 4 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Adult Amateur Hunter:** Open to Adult Amateurs showing horses and/or ponies. Riders may enter any Equitation class. If showing in Amateur-Owner Hunter 3'6", rider may only show other horses that they **own** in the Adult Amateur Hunters. If showing in Amateur-Owner or Hunter 3'3" (and not 3'6"), rider may show one horse they do not own in Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses/ponies may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible. Fences 3'.
- **Adult Amateur Hunter Low:** Open to Adult Amateurs showing horses and/or ponies. Riders may enter any Equitation class, but may not cross enter into any hunter or jumper class with fences higher than 3'3". If showing in Amateur-Owner Hunter 3'3" or Adult Hunter 3', rider may show horses they own, and one horse they do not own in the Low Adult Hunter division. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any class with fences higher than 2'9".
- **Children's Hunter:** Open to junior riders showing horses. Riders may enter any Equitation class, and may compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter 3'3" section, but may not show in the Junior Hunter 3'6" or Junior Jumper section at the same show. Horses may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible. Fences 3'.
- **Children's Hunter Low:** Open to junior riders showing horses. Riders may enter any Equitation class, but may not cross enter into any hunter or jumper class with fences higher than 3'3". If showing in Children's Hunter 3', Regular A-rated Pony Sections and/or Junior Hunter 3'3", rider may show only one horse in the Low Children's Hunter division. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any class with fences higher than 2'9".
- **Children's Hunter Pony:** Open to junior riders showing ponies. Rider age restrictions as found in "Regular Pony" sections do not apply. If showing in the Regular or Green Pony Hunter section, riders may ride only one pony at 2' or one pony at 2'6" at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3". Exception: Pony Jumpers. The Pony, with another rider, may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible. Fences 2' small and medium, 2'6" large. No Combinations.
- **General (Hunters):** Horses/ponies are not required to be jogged for soundness. To be judged on performance, soundness and suitability to count.

JUMPERS

Jumper Nomination Fee: \$200

Nominated Jumper Sections: 1.20m - 1.40m, Junior and Amateur Jumpers.

Non-Nominated Jumper Sections: .65m - 1.15m, Junior, Amateur, Thoroughbred and Pony Jumpers.

Eligibility: Any horse, regardless of winnings, is eligible to enter any .65m - 1.45m and Open Jumper Class.

Amateur Jumper: Amateurs may compete up to two horses, they do not own, per height section of Amateur Jumpers per competition. There is no limit on the number of horses that may be ridden by the owner or an amateur member of the owner's family.

Declarations: Nominated Jumpers must declare on the appropriate form in the Show Office the day before the class is to be held. Late declarations will be subject to the Post Entry Penalty and may require the horse to work first or last in the order at management discretion. Classes entered on the Entry Blank constitute a Declaration.

Jumper Tables: Refer to the Time Schedule. Management reserves the right to change tables based on weather, entries or other criteria.

Time Allowed: The Time Allowed will be based on a speed of 360 yards per minute for Pony Jumpers, and 382 yards per minute for all other sections unless otherwise noted, and may be adjusted accordingly.

Martingales: 1.30m or below: No martingale restrictions when used in a conventional manner. Draw Reins/German Martingales: allowed when schooling or in classes 1.20m or below that do not offer prize money. **Above 1.30m** (and all classes restricted to young horses): Only running martingales used in the conventional manner. **Note:** Ponies may not be ridden by a Junior in draw reins or German martingales at any time.

Ties: Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated.

24-Hour Stabling Rule: Any class of \$25,000 or more will be subject to the USEF 24-Hour Stabling Rule. Horses must purchase a stall directly from the show and reside in the stall on the official Showgrounds of HITS Ocala for the 24-Hour period leading up to and during the class. Horses must be entered in the class and have purchased a stall.

2024 Zone 4 Specifications: (Check USHJA.org for the most updated specs.)

- **Junior/Amateur 1.10m/1.15m Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. Riders competing in a Junior or Amateur Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic above 1.15m, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show. Horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Jr or Am Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above, that offers prize money, at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic.
- **Junior/Amateur 1.0m/1.05m Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. Riders competing in a Junior or Amateur Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic above 1.15m, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic.

SPECIAL CLASSES

The General Rules and Regulations of the Horse Show will prevail for the Special Classes except as provided for each individual class and as noted herein.

The League presented by Marshall & Sterling Insurance Group Membership

- **Classic Riders:** M&S Insurance League membership required for points to count for Classics and Classes that are affiliated with the M&S Insurance League.

National Grand Prix - Specs: Table II.2.a. National Standard.

- **Ranking List Points:** Riders are no longer required to designate a "Point Horse" effective December 1, 2014. Riders will receive Ranking Points from the placing points earned on his/her highest placed horse.

Special Hunter Classics: Judged on performance and soundness with manners and suitability emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 15 (or 1/3) horses (ponies) from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied will be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine the winners. In case of a tie for first place only, judges will confer to break the tie. All other ties will remain and riders will toss a coin for the ribbons.

- **Separate Two-Round Classic** - For the first round, each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10-12 fences at the required height.
- **Designated First-Round Classic** - A designated class of the division will be the first round of the classic. **You must enter the classic prior to competing in First-Round class.** Scratches are not permitted after the First-Round class has begun. See Time Schedule for Designated First-Round class.

Special Class Nomination/Declaration: Special Classes entered on the Entry Blank constitute a Declaration.

- **Classics:** Horses must be entered the day before the class or pay the Class Post Entry Fee.

Special Class Scratch: Any scratch must be made before the class starts or be accompanied by a Vet's Certificate. See "Rules & Regulations" for more information. Scratch fee will apply.

- **Classics:** In the event of scratch on the day of the class, horses are subject to the Classic Scratch Fee.
- **Grand Prix:** Once Nominated, the Grand Prix Nomination Fee is not refundable.

Order of Go: The Order of Go will be drawn. In the jump-off, if any, all horses will go in the original drawn order.

Attire: Formal attire required in Special Classes.

Awards: Winners to ride for presentation of awards in Special Classes.

International Riders: All classes held during the HITS Ocala Winter Circuit will be run under National rules with regard to riders. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a 1st come, 1st served basis.

Trophy & Ribbons: 1-12 in Special Classes unless otherwise stated.

Show Champion or Circuit Champion: Classics will not count toward Show or Circuit Champion awards.

GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Every class offered herein that is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, news media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

INSURANCES: a) Florida Senate Bill 1658 Equine Zero Liability Statute: Warning-Under Florida Law an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. b) All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

BILLING POLICY

- All entry, stall, feed, and other charges are to be paid weekly and, without exception, must be paid in full by the end of any consecutive showing weeks.
- Prize money won will only be applied if the payee has been provided with a proper SS# or Fed Tax ID#. Net Prize Money credits will be issued as a check within 30 days as required by USEF and mailed or hand-delivered during consecutive weeks of showing and will be valid for 60 days from issuance. Reissuance of checks must be requested within the same calendar year as the Prize Money was issued (exception: Ocala December Holiday shows).
- At the end of every calendar year, tax-eligible prize money recipients will receive an IRS Form 1099-MISC reporting taxable prize money income for that year.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE:

Ocala Winter Circuit: Wednesday, January 3, 2024

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted. Customers paying by credit card should reference the Retail pricing. See the insert in this book for forms and instructions for paying by credit card.
- Horse Deposit Fee and all other applicable fees on the Entry Form must be submitted with the Entry Form or the Entry will be considered Late. Any partial payment will be applied to later week entries first.
- Entry Form must be completed in its entirety.
- Entry Forms should be submitted **online** through Show Management System. **FAXED, MAILED OR EMAILED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

ENTRY POLICY:

- Horse Deposit Fee will be credited to the horse's entries only if the Entry is received by the Closing Date and meets the Entry Procedure.
- Entries received after the Closing Date will be Late and subject to the Post Entry Penalty.
- A Signed Open Check or Credit Card Authorization must be lodged with the Show Secretary each week before Numbers are issued.
- Accounts must be closed at the end of each show week. Management will close Exhibitor Accounts that have not been settled at the conclusion of each show. Billing questions or refunds will not be considered after the show in question.
- Back numbers will not be issued until previous week balances are closed.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to close out their account in person. Exhibitors who do not close out in person automatically authorize HITS to close their account using the Check / Credit Card on file. **Billing questions or refunds will not be considered after the show in question.**
- The Horse Show policies herein stated regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of GR 912.
- An **All Inclusive Facility Fee of \$125** will be assessed to all showing horses. This fee entitles the horses to unlimited adds / scratches according to the add/scratch policy (does not apply to Special classes) as well as access to riding and lunging areas.

TRAINER'S BARN ACCOUNT:

- Trainers must create a "Barn Account" Entry Form if ordering tack stalls, paddocks, RVs, will order feed/shavings, will do trainer splits.
- Enter "Barn Account" on the Entry Form in both the Owner and Trainer boxes.
- Complete a "Barn Account" Entry Form for each week you will be showing.
- Individual owners/riders should add miscellaneous items such as extra stalls, paddocks, RVs, etc., to their horse's Entry Form.

ENTRY CLARIFICATION:

- Classes may only be entered or declared by using a Class Number. A Class Number written on the Entry Form, Add/Scratch Form, or Barn Add/Scratch Form or submitted online constitutes a Class Entry or Class Declaration.
- An entry with incomplete information for horse, owner, rider or trainer, such as a horse entered as "Entry" or "TBA" or any such derivative, will be subject to the \$50 Incomplete Entry Fee. An entry with missing USEF/USHJA numbers, names or signatures is also subject to this fee.
- Equitation riders must ride the horse and wear the number of the horse they have entered to ride. There is no penalty for the rider to scratch an equitation class from one horse and add it on another horse. Exhibitors who enter an equitation class on one horse and ride or wear another horse's number will be charged on both horses.
- Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which he/she is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the Scratch Procedures outlined below, will be billed for the class.
- Horses shown in a class without being officially entered will be assessed a penalty as shown below.
- Exhibitors are responsible for a knowledge of the Rules and Regulations governing the horse show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee, class placing and prize money award.
- Show means the Show Week.
- **Non-showing horse** is designated by marking an "x" in the box for "Non Showing", and must be on the entry form when entry is submitted. A horse that is declared Non-Showing after the Entry form is submitted will be charged a Show Scratch Fee. A non-showing Horse who ultimately enters the show will be considered a Post Entry. **Leaving the class area "Blank" constitutes an entry and will be charged a Scratch Fee.**

POST ENTRY FEES:

- Entry received after the Closing Date \$50
- Incomplete Entry \$50 (See Entry Clarification above)

ADD/SCRATCH/CHANGE: Any class add, scratch, or change, or any complete Show Scratch or Circuit Scratch must be made in writing in the Show Office on an official form or by facsimile, or by letter or email and received prior to the start of the applicable class or show. Failure to scratch a class(es) or show according to this procedure will result in the exhibitor being responsible for the class fee(s) or double the Show Scratch fee, respectively. Scratching a class "at the gate" does not constitute an official scratch. Once a class or division begins, it may not be scratched, except for a Vet Scratch. If a Vet Scratch, the horse must be scratched in the Show Office on the day of the class and the Official Show Vet's Certificate must be received that day. Scratch Fee will still apply. A class that has been closed may not be scratched. **Note:** If entries warrant, Management may elect not to accept day-of adds in the Grand Prix Ring / Stadium, or other rings should it see fit. Check in the Show Office for updates to this policy.

COMBINING, DIVIDING OR CANCELING DIVISIONS, CLASSES OR CLASSICS: The Decision to Combine, Cancel or Divide classes will be made at the discretion of Show Management within one hour of the close of the Horse Show Office the night before the class. The update will be noted on the "How Many" schedule on the website.

- **Combining:** Once a class/classic/division has been combined due to insufficient entries, it will not be re-divided for additional entries on the day of the class.
- **Dividing:** A class/classic/division that has been offered as split may be combined on the day of if scratched entries warrant. Management has the right to run all sections of the class/classic/division in their entirety before pinning if insufficient entries seem likely.
- **Canceling:** A class/classic/division that has been cancelled due to insufficient entries will not be reinstated for additional entries on the day of the class.

REFUNDS:

- Refund of pre-paid fees will be given for show scratches received prior to or on the Closing Date. Scratch must be made in writing, according to the procedure outlined above.
- Refund for Horse Deposits, Stalls, Paddocks and RV Sites **will not be given for entries scratched after the Closing Date.**
Exhibitors are responsible for any such outstanding fees.
- If eligible for refund, a check for refund due less an office fee of \$25 will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the final Show of the Circuit.
- Billing questions or requests for refunds will not be considered after the Show in question.

MOVE IN / MOVE OUT DATE RESTRICTIONS:

Note: Arrival for stabling assignments must be between the hours of 8 am - 5 pm daily. Off-hour arrival allowed only with prior approval of Horse Show Management. All early arrival must be approved with the show office.

- **Circuit Items:** Sunday, noon, January 14 through Monday, noon, March 25, 2024.

Will be billed during HITS I Ocala January Classic for the entire Circuit (HITS I-X). Arrival prior to Sunday noon will incur early arrival fees.

- **Weekly Items:** Monday, 3 pm to the following Monday, 8 am of each Show Week. **Arrival prior to Sunday noon will incur a full week charge for the previous show week.** Exhibitors staying consecutive weeks may occupy their Stalls / Paddocks / RV's all day on the Mondays between weeks. Any stall order made by Entry, Fax, Email or other method will be considered an official stall order and exhibitors will be responsible for payment.

STABLING: Stall Orders should be made when submitting entries by mail or online. For Questions and Information, contact Stabling@HITSShows.com. Tent Stalls are approximately 10'x10' or 10'x12' (Premium), portable, under tents, with doors, dirt floors. Permanent Stalls are approximately 12'x12', with doors, dirt floors. **Stall Fees are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. Any stall order made by Entry, Fax, Email or other method will be considered an official stall order and exhibitors will be responsible for payment. Stalls are not transferable or sublettable** except within the same trainer group. The discounted price for Circuit Stalls is intended for actively showing horses. If your stalls are not occupied for any show week, i.e; you purchase circuit stalls but do not arrive until a later week, or you vacate your stalls at any point, HITS reserves the right assign your stalls to another exhibitor without compensation. Stalls may be stripped or reconfigured at HITS discretion. Please contact our office with your plans and we will work with you to arrange the best options. Any showing horse, that has not purchased a stall from HITS will be assessed the Ship-in/Grounds fee per week. Bedding on straw is prohibited except when the horse's health is at issue. Please obtain prior approval from Stable Office. Clean-up fee may apply.

On-site spaces are limited and preference will be given to Circuit RV reservations. **Sewer and Gray Water/Pumpout is now included.** Pumpouts will be done Wednesday, Friday, Sunday each week. **RV spaces are non-refundable after the closing date of entries.** RV spaces ordered after the closing date of entries will be accepted on a space available basis and may be subject to a Late RV Fee of \$50 additional per week. Permanent Stall and Series Stall holders should order a Series RV Space if arriving prior to January 1, 2024. *Price includes 7% Sales Tax and 4% County Tourism Tax.

PRICING AFTER NOVEMBER 1

- **RV Weekly** \$450* Monday, 3 pm – Monday, 8 am of each week.
 - **RV Circuit** \$3,950* Sunday, January 14 – Monday, March 26, 2024. Must complete HITS I Entry Form to order.
 - **RV Series** \$4,175* Sunday, November 26, 2023 – March 31, 2024. Must complete Holiday I Entry Form to order.
 - **RV Early Arrival** \$55 Monday, 3 pm Per night, prior to noon Sunday, January 14, 2024, including units not tenanted or not hooked up to electric/water, unless stationed in Long Term Parking. (Prior to noon, Sunday, November 26, 2023 for Holiday Shows.)
 - **RV Early Arrival Late** \$65 Per night, as above, if Early Arrival is not pre-ordered and fee prepaid on HITS I Entry Form.
- Note:** Once ordered, Early Arrival Fees are not refundable.

SERVICES:

- **Feed Store:** Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For deliveries prior to or upon arrival, use the Feed Order form in the prize list. Place orders by 2 pm for same day delivery. Discrepancies in billing or delivery will not be considered unless brought to the attention of the Feed Office within 24 hours of placing the order. No commercial feed or bedding source will be permitted to deliver on the HITS Ocala Showgrounds at any time.
- **Horse Watch:** Horse Watch extends from approximately 9 pm until 5 am daily. Horses will be checked approximately six times per night each night during Show Weeks. Trainers/owners should provide emergency contact information for Horse Watch personnel. Forms available in the Feed Office or in the Prize List on Feed Order form. Cell phone numbers for Horse Watch will be available in the Feed Office for trainers/owners to be able to contact Horse Watch personnel directly.

- **Trainer's Splits:** This service allows trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until **close of business Friday**. Only items billed by the Horse Show such as feed, bedding, tack stalls, etc., will be split. Only dollar amounts will be split and totals will be rounded up. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected.
- **Exhibitor Check Cashing** is no longer available. Please make arrangements with local banks.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS:

- **Returned Checks or Credit Cards**, for any reason, will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the face value of the check/credit card charge, whichever is greater. Upon notification, exhibitors will have three days to make full payment, including penalty, in certified funds, cashier's check, money order, or credit card. A 3% Retail Adjustment will be applied to all Credit Card transactions. Sanctioning organizations will be notified if exhibitors fail to pay in full within three days. A monthly service fee equal to 18% per annum will begin accruing after 30 days. **Note:** First time returned checks will automatically be redeposited.
- **A declined credit card** will be resubmitted within several days.
- A closed account, Stop Payment, incorrect or incomplete credit card information or a chargeback will be turned over to sanctioning organizations immediately.
- **Cash Only** may be required if you have previously given a non-negotiable check to HITS.

PRIZE MONEY:

- **Prize Money** Prize Money will be applied to entries. The Payee will default to the Owner, if the Prize Money Recipient is not provided on the submitted entry. A valid Social Security or Federal ID number and complete mailing address must be provided. Net Prize Money credits will be issued as a check and will be mailed or hand-delivered within 30 days after the Show, thereby ending the show's responsibility. **Exhibitors:** Please verify the correct payee and mailing address is recorded in the Show Office. **HITS is not responsible for checks lost or issued to incorrect payees.**
- If the SSN/EIN is not provided, Prize Money will be withheld until SSN / EIN is provided.
- If the IRS has notified us of a discrepancy in Payee name or SSN / EIN prize money will be withheld until the discrepancy is resolved.
- If an outstanding balance exists on an account, prize money may be withheld.
- **Prize Money Won by Foreign Exhibitors** is subject to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a Social Security number and will be asked to complete Form W-8BEN prior to receiving prize money.
- **Prize Money** is awarded through 6th place in hunter classes and through 8th place in jumper classes. A class that pays based on a number of entries will pay based on the number of on-time entries and post entries will not be included in the number used to determine the payout.
- A class with fewer than three entries will not award prize money.

ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP & FEE REQUIREMENTS

ADDITIONAL USHJA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS ARE COMING INTO EFFECT. DETAILS AVAILABLE SOON.

MEMBERSHIP - PEOPLE:

- **Owner-Rider-Trainer:** Must be ACTIVE COMPETING members of USEF and USHJA, or join at the show, or pay Show Pass fees. **Note:** Owners and Riders are limited to ONE USEF Showpass per competition year, Trainers MUST be members.
- **Adult or Amateur Status:** Riders showing in classes restricted to Adults or Amateurs must have USEF Amateur Certification. Foreign Exhibitors must present documentation indicating their Amateur status with their home Federation and must **JOIN** USEF as ACTIVE COMPETING Members and Sign for Amateur Status.
- **Safe Sport:** Beginning January 1, 2019, All Senior members of USEF will be required to complete Safe Sport training at USEF.org before competing in a USEF Licensed competition. **An exhibitor will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.**
- **International Riders:** All classes held during the 2024 HITS Ocala Circuit will be run under National rules with regard to riders. If the capacity of International riders exceeds the National riders rule, riders will be accepted on a First come, First served basis. **All International Riders must have an active, competing USEF Membership as well as having completed SafeSport Training for Riders 18 and Older.**

Reminder: USEF MAAP Requirements All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at USEF.org.

MEMBERSHIP - FARMS & OTHER ENTITIES: Farms, Partnerships, and any entities owning a horse competing in a USEF Licensed Competition must be Recorded with USEF, and one recorded owner of the entity must have a current USHJA Competing Membership.

MEMBERSHIP - HORSES

- **USHJA Horse Registrations:** All horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have or apply for a Registration Number from USHJA.
- **USEF Horse Recording:** Horses earning points toward USEF HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards, USHJA Hunter Derby and or competing in Grand Prix must be Recorded with USEF Annually or for Life.
- **Microchip:** Beginning December 1, 2018, all horses competing in USEF licensed Hunter/Jumper/Equitation competitions must have a USEF-approved Microchip on file with USEF. **Horses will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.**
- **Measurement Card:** Small Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, and Pony Jumpers must have valid USEF Measurement Card or copy of a valid Measurement Form, or be a measured at the show prior to showing. Foreign Measurement cards are not acceptable as proof of Measurement.

MEMBERSHIP HORSE FEES:

- **Horse Fee:** USEF \$8, USHJA \$7
- **Horse Drug Fee:** USEF \$15
- **High Performance Fees:** Horses entered in Grand Prix are required to pay the \$35 IHP Fee up to a total of the cap \$420 per competition year. Please refer to the USEF website for additional information.

THE SHOW SECRETARY WILL NOT ISSUE A NUMBER TO ANY EXHIBITOR UNTIL ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET. ONCE THE NUMBER IS ISSUED, ASSOCIATION FEES, INCLUDING SHOW PASS FEES, WILL NOT BE ADJUSTED FOR THAT SHOW. Failure to provide proper credentials will result in show pass fees and/or Incomplete Entry fees charged in each incident.

The Exhibitor has the ultimate responsibility for proper registration of horse, owner, rider and trainer with USEF/USHJA and for entering the horse under proper ownership where points are concerned.

FACILITY INFORMATION:

- **Footing:** at the HITS Ocala Showgrounds is all-weather.
- **Ring sizes:** Stadium - 200x350, Grand Prix - 175x325, Jumper 1 - 200x350, Jumper 2 - 175x250, Hunter 1 - 200x280, Hunter 2 - 200x275, Hunter 3 - 190x275, Hunter 4 - 145x240, Hunter 5 - 145x240, Hunter 7 - 175x275
- **Food Service:** will be available every day.
- **Lunging:** will be allowed in the designated areas only. Details will be posted in the Show Office.

HEALTH & VETERINARY:

- **Sharps & Medical Waste** - Appropriate Sharps Containers for the disposal of used Needles will be placed in all barns and tent stabling areas, at the end of aisles. Sharps must only be disposed of in these containers. Anyone found in violation of proper disposal or in vandalism or removal of any provided Sharps Container will be fined \$100 and may face further penalties deemed necessary by Show Management. See GR1210.4 for complete details.
- **Show Veterinarian** - phone number will be posted at the Show Office.
- **Equine Health Requirements will be enforced.** All horses (**competing or not**) that enter the grounds must present the Health Entry Requirements which include a Event Participation Declaration, Coggins and Proof of Vaccination. All horses are subject to examination by HITS officials/designated representatives and/or state officials (collectively "officials") for determining whether such animals are, or have been infected/exposed, or are likely to become infected with an infectious or contagious disease. If after such examination, officials have reason to believe that an animal's health condition places other animals at risk, such officials, at their sole discretion, may quarantine such animal (and others that may have been infected/exposed) or, if appropriate, require that such animals be transported off the grounds. All participants agree to fully cooperate with event officials and abide by their decisions and instructions. Failure to comply shall be grounds for immediate expulsion and potential disciplinary action by organization, state/local or federal animal health officials. All exhibitors are encouraged to review the equine health entry/transport requirements of the destination state prior to entry. Additional information may be obtained from the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services at 850.488.3022.

SAFETY:

- **Emergency Medical Centers:** the nearest Hospital & Trauma 1 Medical Center to HITS Post Time Farm is: **Ocala Regional Medical Center** - 1431 SW 1st Ave, Ocala, FL 34471 – 352.401.1000, 17 miles, 25 minutes by car.
- **Accidents Involving Competitors.** GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.
- **Protective Headgear:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee and Licensed Official are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. GR 801.2.7.
- **Motorized Vehicles:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. **Electric Golf Carts** WILL NOT be permitted to plug into any electrical outlet on the grounds. Violation will result in the plug or charger being confiscated by show management, and/or a Fine if deemed necessary.
- **Dogs must be restrained on the Showgrounds.** Loose dogs will be picked up and detained and the owner fined \$100. The owner may be barred from showing and expelled from the Showgrounds for a second offense, or for refusal to pay the fine, and will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- **Electrical/Fire Regulations:** Electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable Liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the Horse Show without recourse. Additional appliances are not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to confiscation of the item(s), and/or a Fine if deemed necessary.
- **Stall Alterations are strictly forbidden.** The removal of stall tent side poles, side ropes and/or stakes/anchors is strictly prohibited. Any exhibitor found in violation will be issued a single warning. If violation continues, Management reserves the right to remove from the Showgrounds all property belonging to or under the control of said violator. Further, Management reserves the right to bar any exhibitor found to be in violation from any further participation in the Horse Show without recourse to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due.
- **Damage:** Owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings and other properties on the Showgrounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
- **Alcoholic Beverages** in any form may not be brought onto the Showgrounds.

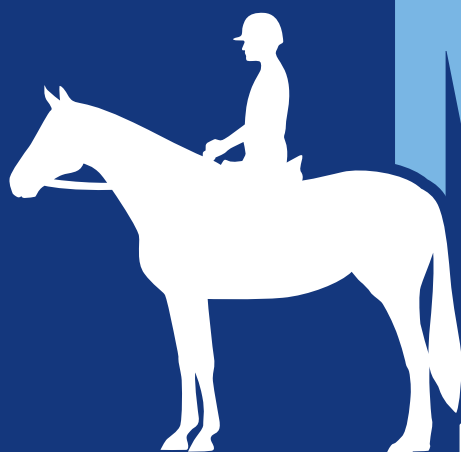

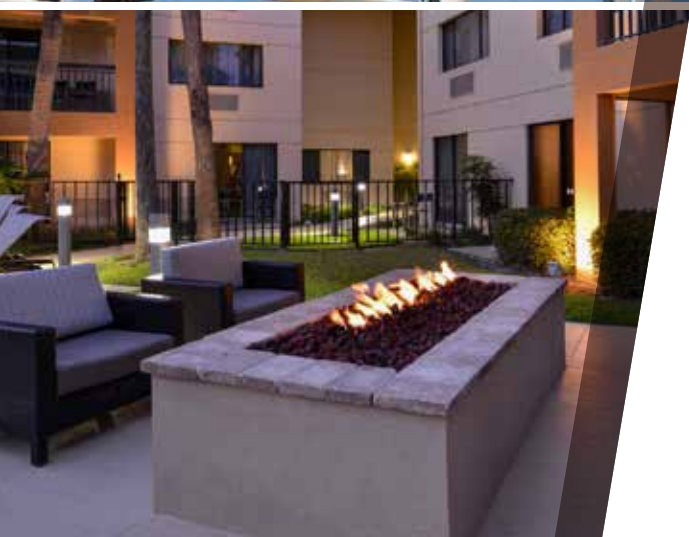

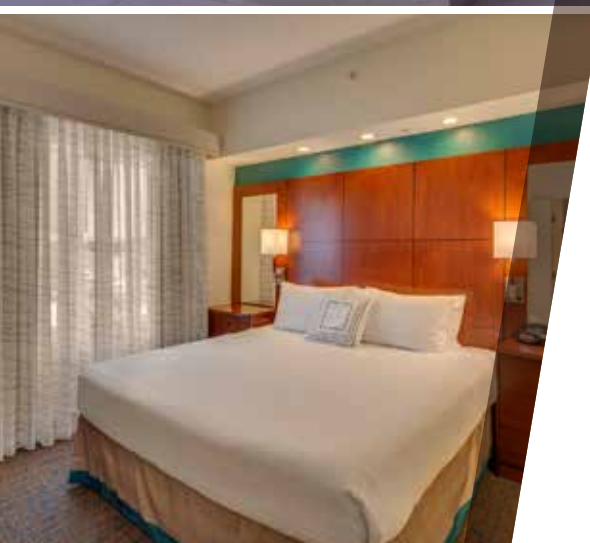
