To focus and worry on all the things that aren't quite right just paralyzes us in the Kingdom work and steals our trust in Jesus. It steals our belief that God will never leave us or forsake us. It steals our assurance that Jesus hears our cry and answers our prayers according to *His* plan. PRAYER changes that; it is the most powerful tool we have available to us and we have not only used it extensively but asked others to pray and intercede on our behalf.
