Maloney Outreach!



June saw the launch of our medical clinic outreach in a village about 30 miles from Tonj, called Maloney. We have been praying for an effective way to further our medical services *and* the Gospel into the remote areas around us. This outreach is a direct answer to those prayers. We have a Community Health Worker (CHW) ready for training and plan to prepare him over the next three months in our clinic in Tonj before sending back into the bush in Maloney. Every Thursday our medical team will make a visit to Maloney to deal with more serious cases and support the CHW. Our last two outreaches have been fruitful; we used the evangelicube to share the gospel with the waiting patients. One problem we encountered was we had so many patients we were not able to get to every person. The community were so happy we

were there they tried to send us home with a goat but we had no room in the car! Pray we have wisdom as we proceed and make changes to this program to further benefit the community needs.

New Medical Clinic!

We have been discouraged and burdened to have our new medical clinic project standing untouched for 6 months due to our Ugandan work crew's refusal to return to Sudan during pre-election and cattle raids. Our greatest concern was the state and safety of the structure as the steel trusses were held weakly by welding waiting for the cross-bars to be attached. With the rainy season starting we were faced with high winds which already brought three trusses crashing to the ground. Unsure where to turn to for help, we turned to the One who has all the answers and wants to carry our burden, Jesus Christ. He faithfully connected us through Mission Aviation Fellowship Sudan with two German volunteers. Andy and Jonathan came and immediately began securing the trusses and giving instruction to our laborers. By God's grace and favor we were able to lift these heavy steel trusses 40 ft and reposition and weld them in place. They have now been secured with the crossbars and we can start the next phase of our clinic building.
