Hallelujah! Thank you to those who were praying for our supplies to get here safely. The truck arrived from Kenya in record time, carrying one year's worth of food for the compound, medicine for the clinic, medical furniture for the new clinic, bore hole equipment, and plumbing supplies. We were hurting so badly for some items, so the timing was just perfect. I (Suzy) spent most of my time in April, during the recent medevacs, purchasing these supplies in Nairobi, so the whole process took over four months! We consider this arrival a miracle. Everything was intact, and it arrived in eight days, the fastest we've ever had a truck come. It cleared the border with minimal cost even though we only had custom clearance for the medicine. The real joy was watching our staff and missionaries unload the truck in just 2 hours!
