Sabet arrived safely in USA and is looking forward to seeing many of you while he is stateside. He will be attending our annual prayer walk fundraiser on October 23rd and sharing our ministry and the needs here in Sudan with as many churches and small groups as possible. Our goal is to raise money to purchase an ambulance for our medical clinic so we can help more people in critical conditions, like Matoch (pictured with Sabet) who was shot in the face in February. Matoch survived this attack but most certainly would have died had we not medevaced him to Kenya. He was shot by cattle raiders and our only vehicle was being used daily to transport other victims to the nearest hospital 70 miles away. Jesus said *Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. (Matt. 7:12)* and Jesus came to fulfill the law. In Galatians it says, The entire law is summed up in a single command: **"Love your neighbor as yourself"**; *not* stepping up in these situations is

The New Clinic!



Last year we began the building of our new clinic but since have faced one obstacle after another. The steel frame is up, the foundation is dug and all the supplies are in place to complete but getting the labor and expertise has been challenging. This recently changed though when we had the opportunity to purchase an interlocking brick making machine. It makes 1500 bricks per day from local dirt and cement mixed and requires no mortar between the bricks, saving us to purchase Sudan's cement priced three times the normal rate. We purchased it second hand from a missionary in Uganda who gave us a Ugandan pastor to teach us how to use it and complete the building. Pictured is the first brick being carried, it is very exciting and this project may be finished before the end of the year!
