Miracle Baby Boy!

Everyday our work in Sudan is full of challenges and the needs are always overwhelming but our Lord tells us to pray and not grow weary in doing good for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. The staff and the missionaries in the clinic are faced with a huge task because of the number of patients we see continues to rise on a daily basis. Despite this, our clinic remains the primary source of quality and professional health care available to patients 24 hours. The Lord has directed us to love our neighbor as our self and this is evident to our patients when they come to us for health care.



Like Ayen, a Dinka woman that had been in labor for 3 days, came to our clinic to get help in delivering her baby. Dinka women usually prefer to deliver at home due to the distance of walking to our clinic, so when they come in labor there is normally a serious problem or they live close-by. For Ayen, this was her first child, so there was no history of previous birthing problems and we found her pelvis was small. She clearly needed an emergency C-section which we are not able to do at this time and the nearest hospital is 70 miles away and three hours driving on a dirt road. It took a team effort from all our senior medical staff to help her to deliver. The team knew this was going to need God's intervention for a miracle and began with a word of prayer. Margaret, our nurse/midwife assisted by Dr. Tom used a vacuum extractor to ease the head that was stuck but once the head was out, the shoulders got stuck. They continued to maneuver the baby, fully aware this child's life and even the mother's were in their hands. The whole process took several hours and when the baby boy was finally born, the cord was wrapped tightly around his neck. Dr. Tom quickly cut the cord but the baby was not breathing and no heartbeat was detected. Dr. Tom immediately used mouth to mouth resuscitation while Dr. Dennis was doing chest compression and the whole time everyone is praying. Then it happened, we saw a

miracle, the little guy's heart started beating and then he began to breathe! What a joy and reward for our team that worked so diligently in love for this woman and her child. Dr. Tom exclaimed the situation was so serious and both mother and baby should not have survived, he said there was definitely another Person working alongside them. We kept Ayen a few days for observation but she became restless and one day just disappeared with the baby. After weeks of not hearing anything from her she suddenly showed up at the clinic with the baby for a medical checkup. We were quite amazed to see the child had survived and was doing so well. To God we give all the glory for His amazing love and mercy.

What an honor and blessing to have Joe and Nancy Losee come back to Tonj for a two week visit and teach our pastors. After living here with us for a year in 2009, they were received with great joy from our staff and pastors who remember the amazing work they did helping us start the bible school. They are like family to us and have become grandparent figures to our children. The pastors had a wonderful time of fellowship and studying the Word of God. In the time the Losee's have been gone they can see the great improvement in the pastors, how the truth of the Bible is slowly molding them into Godly men. Pastor Joseph Yout has been faithfully attending our Pastor's discipleship program since we began in July '09. He is on fire for the Lord and since the training has started he has planted two churches in addition to the two he already pastors. He loves the Lord and wants to serve him all his life. He defies culture by being married to only one wife and has chosen not to sell his daughter in marriage for cows but wait on the Lord to bring her the right husband. He has a heart to reach his tribe chief and elders of his village with the Gospel. After praying the past two years God has opened a door for him to arrange a meeting with them. When he goes home from our school this month he will start planning that meeting and has asked for prayer for boldness, favor and wisdom.
