

## SingleScore scoreboard operation at Cofer Park (Feb. 26, 2019)

You must download the SingleScore app to your phone or table to operate the scoreboards at Cofer park. It is available on the Apple AppStore, Amazon, and Google Play. Or go to [www.singlescore.com](http://www.singlescore.com) to find it.

1. Locate the SingleScore transmitter on the shelves in the shed. Handwritten on the back of the transmitter is the field number - '1' (big field) or '2' (small field).
2. Plug the transmitter into the electrical outlet on the scorekeepers tower.
3. Turn on the SingleScore app. The app will attempt to find scoreboards. You must be within 30' of the transmitter for this to work. Once the field you are looking for is found (Tucker 1 or Tucker 2), tap on it to begin.
4. Tap on any number (balls, strikes, outs, runs, innings) to add 1. To subtract 1, swipe down across the number.
5. To turn the scoreboard off, tap on Settings, tap on Diagnostics, turn on Blank Test, tap start.
6. After the last game of the day, make sure the score board is off and return the transmitter and extension cord to the shed
