- Regions Discussion
 - Mary Fran, Polly and the board will look at the regions to see how clubs/teams can be shifted to make the regions more balanced
 - Delaware teams will no longer be a part of PAGLA scheduling; however, clubs can schedule with them on non PAGLA game days
 - An initial soft shift will happen based on the number of teams from previous years and by looking at the school leagues
 - Once all teams are registered for ALL REGIONS we will look and see if the regions still work or if certain teams will need to cross over for games
 - **ALL CLUBS must be registered and paid online by the FALL PAGLA meeting**
 - A FAQ section will be added to the website and these questions will be asked of each club during registration (Chuck will update)
 - **ALL TEAMS must be registered on the PAGLA site by January 31**
 - Teams will be allowed to register A, B, C for 5/6
 - After seeing registrations we will work to create a schedule or play days for the C teams
 - All regions will have a president, scheduler and assignor*
 - President is a two year term and has the following duties
 - Assists with scheduling issues
 - Enforces rules
 - Works with the scheduler and assignor
 - Collects scores* (east will continue with their own playoffs)
 - Create directory
 - Pagla playday
 - Positives
 - Fields, layout, organization, communication, schedule blocks,
 - Negatives
 - Officials worked too many games
 - Food Lines and vendors ran out of food
 - Some games were back to back and it was hard to get to the fields on time
 - Thoughts for 2015

 - Same location
 - Look into how many teams were on the waitlist to see if we should break it up over two days (k2, 3/4 Sat and 5/6, 7/8 Sun)
