 - ii) Each pool will contain members of different regions
- d) Officials will have less games
- e) More food vendors will be available

3) Important Dates/Deadlines

- a) All clubs must be registered on the website by: **October 19th**
- b) All teams must be registered on the website By **January 19th**
 - i) We suggest closing your club registration in early January to insure you know how many teams you will have for the season
 - ii) Teams will be leveled: 3rd/4th, 5/6thA, 5/6thB, 5th/6thC, 7/8thA, 7th/8thB
 - iii) After registering your team you MUST update your field information on the website

 - i) 3rd/4th will play round robins (3) 20 min games on each date

4) Region changes

- a) Minor changes have been made to the regions
 - i) Deep Run- moved to East
 - ii) Coventry- moved to South
 - iii) Souderton- moved to Tri
 - iv) Delaware- has been removed from PAGLA but games can still be scheduled with them
- b) To make the competition better we will be waiting until all teams have registered and then we will be putting them in pools of 8 or 9 based on

their skill level(A/B/C) and as close to their region as possible with out diluting the competition

6) Rule Changes

- a) **3rd/4th**
 - i) All $\frac{3}{4}$ teams must bring a shot blocker to home and away games
 - ii) 3rd/4th will NOT be allowed to roll the ball under the shot blocker
 - iii) (2) girls must stay behind the half field mark
 - iv) No (3) pass rule but you MUST have one pass once you have crossed the 50. If one team is up by 3 goals or more the 3 pass goal is suggested.
