

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Drinking or possessing alcoholic beverages on athletic fields and parking lots is strictly prohibited. All other beverages must be in non-breakable containers.
2. It is understood that the person in charge and/or the organization will be responsible for the actions and safety of the group and will comply with rules as stated.
3. All motorized vehicles must remain in designated areas, unless granted a specific exemption by the Facility Manager for loading and unloading.
4. Pets must be leashed. Owners are responsible to clean up after their pets.
5. The following uses are prohibited at all regional facilities: gambling, carnivals, amusement rides and metal detectors.
6. Requests for facilities will be accepted three months prior to the program season opening date as established in the current Department of Recreation and Parks Directive #12. Prior to submitting to the Program Coordinator, the Recreation Community Supervisor must approve all requests of council-sponsored programs.
7. Use of a regional facility will be on a year-to-year basis. Use of a regional facility one year does not guarantee future use. The Program Coordinator will schedule the facility and has final authority over all policy and scheduling conflicts.
8. Prior to issuance of a permit, a non-council sponsored group must submit a Facility Request and provide a certificate of insurance.
9. Programs are required to provide equipment pertinent to the program's operation.
10. Groups using the facility are required to collect their trash and restore the area to a clean condition.
11. The facility closing time is dusk unless otherwise noted on permit.
12. If it is necessary to cancel your permit, please contact the Program Coordinator as soon as possible so that your facility may be rescheduled.
13. The on-site representative of the Department of Recreation and Parks is the final authority in any dispute regarding the interpretation of printed facility rules and regulations or in any other matter that may arise that is not covered by these rules and regulations.
14. Any violation of the rules and regulations shall result in revocation of the facility permit, and the group will be required to vacate the facility. The group may also be subject to legal action.
15. Field playability shall be determined by the on-site representative of the Department of Recreation and Parks, who decision shall be final.
