



## NORTH DELTA MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION HOME TEAM PROCEDURES SUNGOD ARENA

### **Arrival and entering the arena**

- Players will arrive at the back side of the arena, near the Zamboni bay and enter through the doors on the right.
- Parents can drive down to the Zamboni area and drop off their play and then proceed out the back gate into the neighbourhood.
- Please arrive 20 minutes before game
- Line up outside the building on an available spot
- 15 minutes before the game players will be allowed to enter the arena.
- Please enter the arena fully dressed. Skates and Helmets can be put on inside
- Temperatures will be taken and the attached **Health Screening questionnaire must be completed** (Verbal is fine)
- **Hockey bags will not be permitted into the arena (except for Goalies)**, a small bag is allowed if you need to carry your skates and helmet in.
- Masks must be worn at all times when in the arena except when players have their helmets on

### **Inside the area**

- If you are the first game of the night proceed to change room 1, 2 or 3 (**limit 7 per room**) if you are the second game of the night proceed to rooms 4 (**limit 7**) or 5 (**limit 12**)
- Once ready head to the home bench (closest to the back of the arena)
- The home team can use the washrooms in the change rooms.
- The home team is responsible to clean all the change rooms and home team bench.
- Team video person can video from the media box

### **Leaving the arena**

- Once the game is over players can head to the change rooms and remove skates and helmet and then exit through the lower lobby doors. Please wait for the visitor team to exit before crossing the lobby
- Player will have **5** minutes to leave the arena

### **Important Information**

- NO SPITTING AT ANYTIME
- No sharing of water bottles
- Dispose of any garbage before leaving the building
- Physical distancing of 6ft is required at all times except when on the bench or ice.
- PLEASE STAY HOME IF YOU ARE. NOT FEELING WELL

The home team will be allowed to bring 22 people into the arena, this includes, Players, Coaches, HCSP's, Safety Assistants, Managers. At least **1 HCSP must be included** in this number \*\*\* Team officials can be added if the visiting teams numbers are less than 22. Referee's and Score/Timekeepers are not included in this number but must be included in the arena total of 50. The team video person is not included in these numbers.



## Health Screening Questions:

1. Do you have any flu/cold like symptoms such as a cough, fever, sore throat, chills, difficulty breathing? If you have these symptoms contact your physician or call 8-1-1 immediately.
2. Are you or someone you are close to ill with cold/flu like symptoms?
3. Have you or someone close to you been told to self-isolate by public health?
4. Have you or someone you live with travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days?

The answer to ALL of these questions must be no. If a response to any of the questions is “yes” do not allow entry into the building ask them to contact their physician immediately or to call 8-1-1.
