Safety Procedures for Visiting Teams

North Delta Rec Centre

We are excited to host your team at the North Delta Rec Centre, below is our list of procedures for game day. If you have any questions please contact the North Delta team manager.

Arrival and Exit Time

- Please arrive 15 minutes before game time.
- Doors will open 10 minutes before game time.
- Line up under the covered area outside the arena doors and find a spot to stand on.
- Players will have **5 minutes to exit the arena** at the end of the game.

Entering and Exiting the Aren

- Enter the area fully dressed (Goalies included), **no hockey bags allowed** (Skates and helmets can be put on inside as long as players can tie their own skates) players can bring a small bag to carry their helmet, skates and water bottles if needed. A mask must be worn when entering the arena
- Please follow your teams contract tracing and screening procedures when entering
- Please have players **complete the below Health Check on game day** we will ask when they enter if it was completed (verbal is fine)
- Players will enter through the the visiting teams door (Main arena doors, South side of the building)
- Players will leave through the same door they enter through
- No gathering in the parking lot before, during or after games

Inside the Aren

- Players find a chair in the lobby and put skates and helmets on (Maximum 20 people in the lobby)
- Coaches, HCSP and any other team officials or game staff will head into the ice area as soon as they enter the building.
- Visiting team washrooms are in the lobby
- When instructed head to the visiting teams bench (closet to the rink entrance)
- All bench staff must wear masks
- After the game head back to the lobby, take off helmet and skates and leave the arena.
- Everyone else will leave the arena immediately

Important Information

- NO SPITTING AT ANYTIME
- No sharing of water bottles
- Dispose of any garbage before leaving the building
- Physical distancing of 6ft is required at all times except when on the bench or ice.
- PLEASE STAY HOME IF YOU ARE. NOT FEELING WELL

The Visiting team can bring players plus 4 team officials to a maximum of 22, this includes, Coaches, HCSP's, and Managers. *** Please note that these numbers can change. The ND Manager will be in contact if there is a change



*****Managers please email your team roster including officials to the home team manager 24 hours before the game.**

Health Screening Questions:

1. Do you have any flu/cold like symptoms such as a cough, fever, sore throat, chills, difficulty breathing? If you have these symptoms contact your physician or call 8-1-1 immediately.
2. Are you or someone you are close to ill with cold/flu like symptoms?
3. Have you or someone close to you been told to self-isolate by public health?
4. Have you or someone you live with travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days?

The answer to ALL of these questions must be no. If a response to any of the questions is “yes” do not allow entry into the building ask them to contact their physician immediately or to call 8-1-1.
