

Camp Program

The Trojan Basketball Camp is designed to teach the fundamentals of the game of basketball. Dribbling, shooting, pivoting, rebounding, passing, and proper footwork are all needed to play the game properly.

With the use of stations, each camper will receive individual instruction on the basic offensive and defensive fundamentals necessary to play basketball successfully. In addition, each camper will be taught the offensive and defensive skills required to play two on two and three on three that provide the foundation of five on five play.

At the conclusion of camp each player will receive a personal evaluation. It is our goal that each player will leave camp having been exposed to the proper skills and techniques.

With this information, we believe that the players desire and willingness to work on these skills will directly affect his progress as a basketball player.

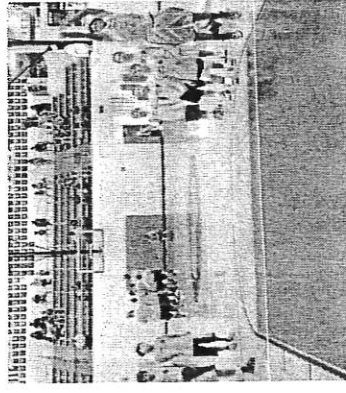
Trojan Basketball Camp Waiver

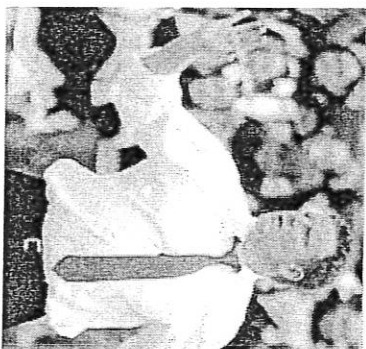
