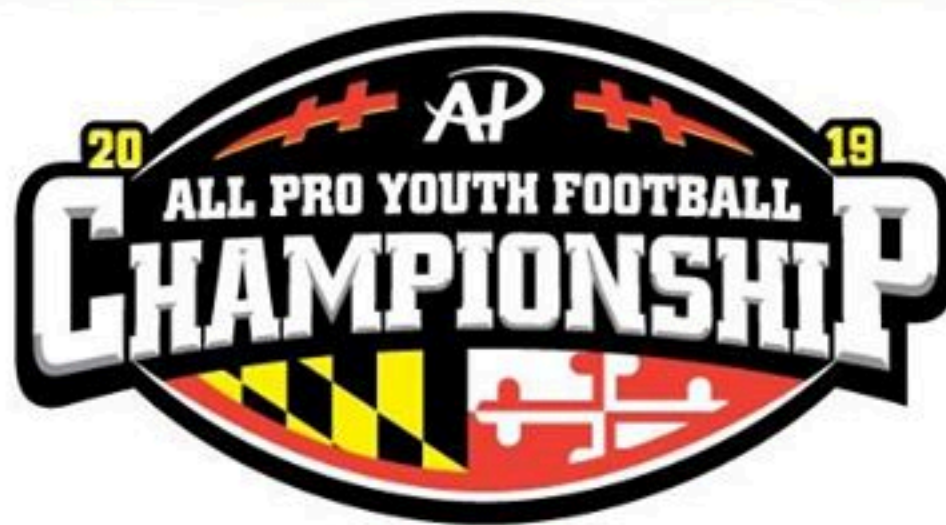

## **ALL PRO YOUTH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

Player Authorization, Injury Waiver & General Release Form

As a participant in the All Pro Youth Football Championships ("Event"), I acknowledge that the participation of my child in the Event exposes them to a possible risk of personal injury. I, hereby release All Pro Youth Football Championships, All Pro Team Sports, AAYFA, MMYFC, MYFA, SMYAC, UCYFL, Meade High School, Arundel High School, Blandair Park, Cedar Lane Park, Howard County Parks and Recs ("Company") and its officers, directors, employees, agents, licensees, subsidiaries, consultants, independent contractors and affiliates, from any and all liability from property damage, personal injuries or other claims arising from or in connection with my participation in the Event including claims that are known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen, future or contingent.

I covenant that I will not now or any time in the future, directly or indirectly, commence or prosecute any action, suit or other proceeding against All Pro Youth Football Championships (Company) and its officers, directors, employees, agents, licensees, subsidiaries, consultants, independent contractors and affiliates, arising out of or relating to the actions, cause of action, claims and demands hereby waived, released or discharged by me.

For good and adequate consideration, which I acknowledge I have received, I hereby grant, release and quitclaim to the Company the right and authority to use, sell, reproduce, and distribute, quoted material, biological information, my photograph, likeness, recorded voice or videotaped filmed appearances obtained in connection with the Event (the "Materials") for promotional and advertising purposes or programs as Company in its sole discretion deem appropriate.

## ALL PRO YOUTH FOOTBALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

Length of games: (4) 10 minute quarters with NO running clock (once lead is 24 points or more a running clock will be put in to effect)

Officials: UCYFL and Champions Officials Group (COG) will be used for this year's Championships  
7U - 2 Officials | 8U, 9U-11U- 3 Officials | 12-14U – 4 Officials

Rosters: We will use County certified rosters

ID Checks: ID Checks will be performed 30 minutes before the next game in line. ID Checks will be performed by All Pro Officials and Head Coaches, so player ID must be present

Coaching Staff – Maximum of (7) coaches are permitted on the sideline during the game, which also includes team moms or siblings. Each Coach will be given a wristband to note sideline eligibility. Please discuss with your team prior to the Championships who the (7) sideline personnel will be.

Home Team (team listed on the right side of the schedule) – will be responsible for the down and chain set. These (3) volunteers will not count toward the total of coaches permitted on the sideline

Minimum Plays: There will be no minimum play requirements

Balls: Teams will supply their own game footballs

Size

Pee Wee/ K2 - 7U | 8U | 9U

Junior – 10U | 11U

Youth - 12U | 14U

Additional Rules:

All Age Groups – there is no tackle to tackle restrictions

Coaches on field

7U - (2) coaches are allowed on the field for offense and defense. Once the official signals, "Coaches Out" the coaches must move to at least ten (10) yards from the deepest player on the field. The coaches may instruct players on positioning and give encouragement during play but not call out the oppositions plays. In no way, may a coach insult or taunt the other team or be a disruption to the game. Coaches may not touch players during "live" play situations. Violation will result in a 15-yard penalty



8U & 9U – No coaches are permitted on the field

Kickoffs are live at all weights

All punts from 7U and 8U can either be punted or request a 20 yard walk off but not beyond the 20-yard line. 9U must snap the ball and must punt from the catch or where the ball is picked up from. No rush is permitted at 7U, 8U and 9U. Fake punts are not permitted once a team declares to punt

No rush on extra points (kicks) at 7U. 8U must snap the extra point but defense is not allowed to rush. 9U must snap and is live. NO fake extra points

7U defenses can **NOT** lineup in front of the nose guard with a maximum of six linemen, therefore the remaining five defensive players must be at least three yards off the line of scrimmage. There are no restrictions inside the five-yard line

14U – High school students will not be eligible to participate in the All Pro Youth Football Championship

Overtime:

Overtime will consist of four plays from the 10 yard line. Both teams will have one possession. If neither team scores, we repeat the overtime process until a winner has been determined. If 7U progresses to double overtime the offense will start from the five-yard line.

Check in: All players will be checked in no later than 30 minutes before their game, most likely shortly after halftime and should be prepared for check-in. Players not checked prior to kick-off must wait until halftime to be checked in. There will be no check ins once the third quarter begins

Release Forms: All teams will be required to sign a release form and have it to present to a championship official at their initial check-in, which will be either a first round game or semi-final game

Code of Conduct

All teams will be responsible for maintaining a good code of conduct and responsible for their fan base, which includes: No smoking on school property, no alcohol, no swearing, no unsportsmanlike comments from the sidelines, making sure that both the sideline and stands are kept clean. ZERO tolerance.

The All Pro Championships were created to provide the best end of the season; Championship football our state has to offer. Playing in the Championships is a privilege, not a right. If programs don't carry themselves in a manner that warrants participation, they will be removed from the remainder of the Championship and will jeopardize future participation. All this being said, we have not had any issues in the past and do not foresee any this year.
