PITCH HIT & RUN COMPETITION

SRVGAL is proud to host a free Scotts® Major League Baseball® Pitch Hit & Run Competition for area youth. We invite all SRVGAL players up to 14 years old to drop in after attending picture day, show their softball skills, and compete for a chance to win a trip to compete at the MLB® All-Star Game®. Just walk down the hill from Oak Hill Park after your SRVGAL Picture Day session to find us at the softball fields.

Preregistration is not required but there is a form to complete that you need to bring with you. See instructions at the end of this note.

Date: Sunday, April 14, 2019 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Location: Monte Vista High School Softball Fields; 3131 Stone Valley Road, Danville.

Pitch Hit & Run is the official skills competition of Major League Baseball®. This grassroots program is designed to provide youngsters with an opportunity to compete; free of charge, in a competition that recognizes individual excellence in core baseball/softball skills. Pitching can be underhand or overhand.

Our event will be for softball players. The participants are divided into four age divisions: 7/8, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, and have the chance to advance through four levels of competition, including Team Championships at Major League ballparks and the National Finals at the 2019 MLB All-Star Game®.

Returning this year we will have a 6U division and a Coach/Board competition! Champions will be named in these two divisions but they are not eligible to advance to the regional competitions.

The individual Pitching, Hitting and Running Champions, along with the All-Around Champion in each division age group at the Local Competition will be awarded and advance to the Sectional Level of Competition.

All participants must have their parent or guardian fill out a registration/waiver form prior to the start of the competition. This form is attached for you to complete prior to the event. Note: the form requires a signature at the bottom of the second page. Forms will also be available at the field.

Participants that are not current registered SRVGAL players must bring a copy of their birth certificate.
