

College Scholarship Application - 2019

- A. Teaneck Junior Soccer League (TJSL) will award one-time scholarships to eligible volunteers who have contributed to the success of the league. The total number of scholarships and the value of each scholarship will be determined by the Board of Trustees each year.
- B. 2019 TJSL College Scholarship Applications must be submitted no later than Sunday, April 14, 2019. Mail applications to Teaneck Junior Soccer League, PO Box 265, Teaneck, NJ 07666 or scan and email to scholarships@teanecksoccer.com. Late applications will not be considered.
- C. An eligible candidate must (a) be a graduating high school senior and current resident of Teaneck or a Teaneck resident that graduated high school within the last 12 months but has yet to start attending college; (b) has served in a TJSL volunteer role in excess of 20 hours per high school year or two seasons of TOPSoccer; and (c) has been accepted into and will attend college.
- D. Eligible TJSL volunteer roles include Coach, Assistant Coach, TOPSoccer Buddy, Equipment Manager or Field Maintenance Manager. Participating in the league as a player and compensated positions, such as Referee, are not considered service to the league and do not count towards eligibility requirements.
- E. As a guideline, TJSL normally values scholarships on a candidate's total number of service years. A service year is defined as July to June. Candidates must have at least 20 hours of service during a year to be eligible for a service year except for TOPSoccer-only volunteers in which two seasons (in different years) may be combined for a single service year.
 - (a) 1 year of service or 2 seasons of TOPSoccer: 25% of full scholarship as determined by TJSL
 - (b) 2 years of service or 4 seasons of TOPSoccer: 50% of full scholarship as determined by TJSL
 - (c) 3 years of service: 75% of full scholarship as determined by TJSL
 - (d) 4 years of service: Full scholarship amount as determined by TJSL
- F. TJSL determines the value of each scholarship at its sole discretion and may change its guidelines for determining scholarship values at any time.
- G. Scholarship recipients can defer the start of college for up to one year after graduation from high school and still receive the scholarship award.
- H. Scholarships will be mailed directly to the college of the student's choice.
