Parent/Guardian Pledge

24-Hour Hothead Rule

Any parent, family member or spectator watching a CMYB/CMYS game understands that if they have a disagreement – question – criticism – or evaluation of any game decision made by a Coach, Umpire or Board

Member the following is to be observed.....

BEFORE TALKING TO ANYONE, COACH OR OTHERWISE, REGARDING A GAME DECISION, TAKE A COOLING OFF PERIOD OF 24 HOURS BEFORE YOU SPEAK TO A COACH OR ANYONE ELSE. ONLY COACHES OR CMYB\CMYS BOARD MEMBERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO TALK TO ANY LEAGUE VOLUNTEER, WHICH INCLUDES UMPIRES.

IF YOU HAVE AN UNSOLICITED OPINION, DO NOT TALK TO THE COACH AT A GAME OR PRACTICE OR IN FRONT OF PEOPLE. DO NOT USE SOCIAL MEDIA TO EXPRESS YOUR OPINION(S). Talk to he/she about a time you can call the next day. Call him or her the next day 24 hours later one on one.
