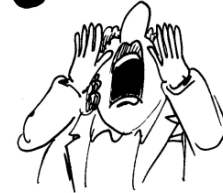

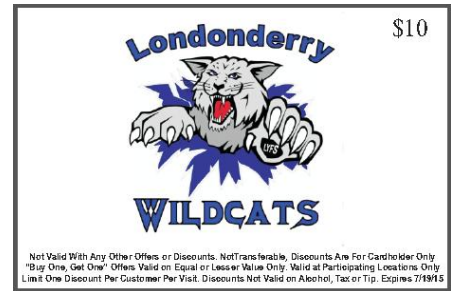
## Got a Card Yet ??
