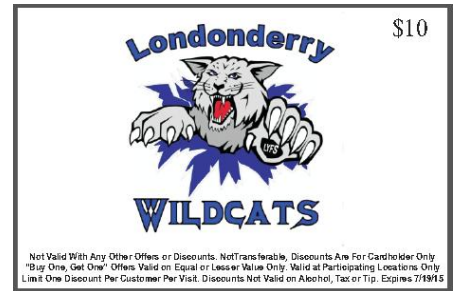

Parking at LMS – (Yes.....more about parking)

Unfortunately the LPD ticketed cars last night that were not legally parked. We approached the Londonderry Police last night after practice. To the left is a picture of where you can and can not park. Mammoth Road would be to the upper right and the path back to the "par-5" is lower left.

Basically if you can not pull into the inner circle at LMS – you are parked illegally and will be ticketed. You need to park in front of LMS – or better yet at LHS. For 7th and 8th grade teams, it is actually closer to park in the dirt parking lot at LHS and walk straight back behind Lancer Field.

You can not park on the grass over the side walk outside of the circle.

Parking is also not allowed next to LMS or in the paved area directly in front of the back LMS area (the triangle where all the roofing material is located now).

We apologize for the confusion, hopefully with this final clarification we will be all set with parking rules for the rest of this season. (we hope)
