Rules and guidelines for Season 2017-2018

- 1) A wrestler's age is determined by his/her age as of December 31st 2017
- 2) Experience level of "0" means no prior years of experience, "1" means one prior year, and so on
- 3) Rating is the coach judgment as follows:
 - 1- beginner
 - 2- average
 - 3- good
 - 4- excellent

4) Age Divisions & Weight Classes

BANTAM DIVISION: AGES 7 AND UNDER

- 5) These weight classes are used for the season finals in March
- 6) Madison pairings are used throughout the season
- 7) Wrestlers are paired during the regular season by age, weight, and skill given a reasonable variance. For example:
 - a. wrestlers are first viewed in terms of weight variations less than 10%
 - b. wrestlers are next viewed in terms of being 7U, 9U, 11U, 14U in terms of their birth year, a 9 year old could be paired with a 10 year old but most likely not with an 11 year old
 - c. when matching skill levels, it may be common to pair a skill level 3 and 4 together but not a 4 with a 2
 - d. variations may occur when trying to get matches, for example, a 9 year old at skill level 4 may face an 11 year old at skill level 2 if there is a need to create an additional match
