



Hit, Run, Throw Skills Competition

Hit, Run, and Throw is a baseball skills competition modeled after MLB's *Diamond Skills*. The program, entering its sixteenth season, invites Little League/Youth Baseball players to participate for the chance to represent their league at the finals at Dunkin' Donuts Park and ultimately win the grand prize, a **\$1,000 donation to their league**. The competition for the \$1,000 dollar prize is for the 9 & 10 year olds in your local league.

How it Works:

Round 1 (Qualifying) –Yard Goats staff members will visit your league's field to organize the competition. Players are tested in three areas – Hitting (for distance), Running (the bases for speed), and Throwing (for accuracy). The top 2 participants with the highest scores will be crowned League Champions and will advance to the 2nd Round. Prize packs will be awarded to the top 3 participants of the league.

Round 2 (Semis)– Winners from each league will be invited to compete in a semifinal at Dunkin' Donuts Park before a Yard Goats home game. The top 3 scorers from each of the semifinal rounds will advance to the finals. All League Champions will receive four complementary tickets for their families to watch them participate.

Finals – The finals will take place in August prior to a Yard Goats game at Dunkin' Donuts Park. The winner will be awarded a \$1,000 donation to their league and be named *2019 Hit, Run, and Throw Champion* in front of thousands of fans at Dunkin' Donuts Park.
