Applicant must be a resident of Bloomington. All attachments must be enclosed with application. Application deadline is the April 27, 2018.

1. Must be a high school age senior and a resident of Bloomington, MN.
2. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average (verified through school transcript).
3. Applicant must have participated in a BAA sport in the last four years while they were in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade (*pending BAA roster verification, number of sports participated in, team names, years played, etc.*).
On a separate paper, please list BAA teams you were on during the above grades.
4. Although athletic ability will not be a factor in awarding scholarships, participation in activities (clubs, marching band, choir, etc.) and High School sports in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade will be weighed in the selection criteria. Activities must be verified through school transcript.
5. Applicant must have volunteered in some way with BAA in the 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade. Volunteering can consist of:
 - coaching or assistant coaching a BAA team they are not a member of
 - acting as director or organizer of a sport level
 - helping or working with a (BAA) board member, equipment director, secretary, etc.
 - assisting with BAA equipment, registrations, tournaments, year-end banquets, etc.

Note that a minimum of five hours up to twenty-four hours/per year will be considered. Hours need to be verified by BAA Board member (i.e. city sport director, equipment director, secretary, etc).
6. Enclose a one page letter describing what your experience with BAA has meant to you.
