

GAME POSTPONEMENTS

Postponed Instructional games do not need to be made up. If both teams desire to make up the game, please contact the City Scheduler ([click here to automatically create the email](#)) with the desired time and place to verify the field is available.

Note that any halted Mite-Bantam game that completes the 4th inning (3-1/2 if home team is ahead) is considered an official game and is complete. For Majors any game that completes the 5th inning (4-1/2 if home team is ahead) is considered an official game and is complete. If the teams have not completed a full inning of an official game when the game is stopped, then the score reverts back to the last full inning. If the game is not official when halted then that game will be finished at a time and place as indicated in the policy listed below. When the game is resumed the exact same game situation (e.g. same inning, outs, runner positions, balls, strikes, player rotation, etc.) will exist as when the game was halted.

The following postponed game rescheduling policy is for both completely postponed games and games that were halted by the umpire before the game was officially complete. If the City Baseball Director does not call the game prior to 5:00 p.m. the umpire can postpone the game (prior to the start or in the middle of the game) at the field, if necessary. Postponements will be handled along this timeline:

1. First postponement of the week is automatically rescheduled for the first Friday night following the postponement, same time, same field when possible (verify with above link).
Allowed Exception: if coaches can agree to another night and notify the City Scheduler and the Chief Umpire ([click here to automatically create the email](#)) by 10:00 p.m. Thursday night.
2. Second postponement of the week is automatically rescheduled for the first Saturday morning following the postponement at 9:00 a.m. at the same field when possible (verify with above link).

Allowed Exception: if coaches can agree to another night and notify the City Scheduler and the Chief Umpire ([click here to automatically create the email](#)) by 10:00 p.m. Friday night.

Majors – make-up games will be automatically rescheduled as stated. If one of the two coaches cannot field a team for a make-up game and the coaches cannot find a date that works to play the make-up game, it will be considered a nongame and neither team will show a win or a loss for that game. If this happens, please notify the City Scheduler and the Chief Umpire ([click here to automatically create the email](#)) by 10:00 p.m. Thursday for a Friday make-up or 10:00 p.m. Friday for a Saturday make-up game.
