LYFA Report

- Potential for creation of LYFA league website for centralization of league rules.
- Rule Changes:
 - Change A8 Running back weight minimum.
 - Red Dots have to be visible from side.
 - Blitzing in A8. LB and DBacks can be 3 yards deep or at LOS, but they must be set.
 - Red Dot Defensive ends in A8 are allowed to drop into pass coverage 5 yards deep outside the tackle box.
 - A8 only - minimum player participation rule changed to 12 total. 6 per half.
 - Clarify: Each team will have one time out per overtime series.

Motion to Approve changes: Pass

- Hard casts are permitted with Doctor release form. Athletic trainer can approve wrap. Absent Athletic trainer, wrap can be approved by referee. This is different from VHSL. ULYFL will not agree to change from VHSL rule.
