Open Issues:

Women's back bathroom needs painting. Jon to do it prior to Nightmare.

Electrician lined up to wire them in.

Bird problem in back bathroom. Ryan put chicken wire up to prevent birds from getting in.

Ryan looking into back splash for the hand dryers and below the soap dispensers.

Hot water heater is leaking in concessions; needs replaced. (Handles the front bathrooms as well). Consider going tankless (electronic). VOTED: Approved – Ryan to purchase and install

Back bathrooms hot water heater not working at all.

Still considering locks for bathrooms. On the list of to dos for Ryan.

Cell Tower: Requesting us to sign a contract, but they have not even been approved yet. Dave S. sent contract to Dave W. for review. 10K/year for the first 3 years. At year 4 it would go up and every three years after that it will go up. They would like to pay us on a monthly basis. Tower is 150 ft. tall.

Parking Lot: Got approval from Bargersville. Ryan will begin to get RFPs. 75K committed at this time for the project. Target July/August 2018.

Club Survey: WIP – goal to be sent out by end of month or after tournament.

IT Help: More advisory needed for the SCSA webpage. Would like landing pages – need an overhaul

Heather has potential contact as does Ryan. Give them Steve's contact information.

Dumpsters: consider gating and putting locks on lids

VIVA: February 24th. Approved the new venue at the Armory in Franklin (96x96) (approx. 726 capacity). Right off 44 and 65 (Whiteland exit). Signed contract and sent back. \$600 a small fee because we are charging an entrance fee.

GiveSmart – Online silent auction tool – we will be getting a free trip to auction off.
