

## **TOURNAMENT ONLINE CHECK-IN DEADLINE: Monday 10/22/18 – 9 am**

Online check-in has become the preferred process for tournament hosts across the Midwest. You can avoid lines at tournament HQ to check-in. All you will need at fields are your player cards.

You can submit the required documents by uploading them to your Got Soccer team account under the Nightmare at the Rock event. All information must be received no later than **9:00 am on Monday, October 22, 2018.**

### **Submitting your documents via Got Soccer:**

1. Log into your team Got Soccer account and click the Nightmare at the Rock tournament.
2. Click on the Documents Tab and upload each of the required documents listed below:
  - a) **Scanned Copies of validated player/coach/manager passes** issued by USYSA or US Club Soccer (rostered players and guest players) as they are listed on your team roster below. Please scan them as a full page of cards, not 1 page per player.
  - b) You can create your **tournament ROSTER** for the weekend in Got Soccer. You will only be able to pull eligible players from your team into this roster. Guest players can be added by completing the Guest Player form found on the SCSA website tournament page. If you don't create this GotSoccer tournament roster, please upload a copy of your **team's official state issued & stamped and validated team roster**. Be sure that JERSEY NUMBERS are included on roster. The official rosters issued by Indiana can be found in your Player Registration event in your GotSoccer log-in (not the tournament). You'll find it under DOCUMENTS. You'll need to save to your PC. Make sure all jersey numbers are included/written in before you upload this to the tournament event documents tab.
  - c) Completed **Tournament Waiver of Liability**. Please complete this in its entirety (jersey #'s; parent signatures, Regular, Club Pass or Guest players) as we need to have this on file for all visiting teams.

**Medical Release for each player are NOT necessary to upload.** However, make sure you have copies on-site with you at all times during the tournament. These can be the ones you have/use for regular league season play. Make sure to have completed copies for your guest players also. If needed, here is a blank [medical release](#).
