

HC Lax Clinic Boys Age Group Overview



Birthdate range: SEP 1, 2010 - AUG 31, 2013

- This age group is designed for participants in kindergarten and pre-k, but first year players in first grade can benefit from the skills taught in this instructional group.

Age group goals:

- Teach the game of lacrosse in a cooperative and instructional environment.
- Develop physical fitness and coordination, foster teamwork, and encourage and reinforce good sportsmanship.
- Create a player-centered environment, which includes fun, constant active engagement, a relaxed and inclusive environment, frequent changes of activity, predictable routines, and getting as many touches with the ball as possible.
- Teach parents how to work on fundamental skills with their child outside of organized play and train parents to be able coaches at the next level of competition.

Equipment needed:

- Athletic shoes or cleats
- Lacrosse stick (must be between 36 and 42" long)
- Mouth guard
- Lacrosse Helmet*
- Lacrosse Gloves*
- *Rentals are available through Play it Again Sports

Uniforms:

- As part of the registration fee for HC Lax, all players will receive a full Under Armour uniform set, which includes a reversible Ripshot jersey and a pair of Raid shorts.

Format:

- Location – The HC Lax Clinic will take place at Cedar Lane Park West field 5.
- Dates, Day and Time - The HC Lax Clinic will be held on Saturday afternoons at 3:00 PM, starting April 7th and running until June 9th. Sessions will not be held on Easter or Memorial Day Weekends.

Who will be coaching my child?

- The HC Lax Clinic will have many experienced coaches and players from around the area helping to coach your child.
