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# 1. Building Entry and Health Screening Form

- Students will be dropped off and picked up by parents at entrance.
- Volunteer checks health screening form in the morning for each student at entrance.
- Only students, staff, and volunteers allowed into building.

### **Health Screening**

Fatigue

Muscle or body aches

Headache

New loss of taste or smell

## 2. Ventilation and Filtration System

- We will keep windows open at all times to ensure good exchange of air.
- In addition, there is a filtration system in place at the West Hartford campus.



### 3. Mandatory Mask Policy

- As of July 25, 2021, the DPH still emphasizes the role of mask wearing in crowded spaces such as schools (Pre-K – 12) to reduce transmission risk.

## 4. “Pausentisch” and Restroom Regulations

- Staggered break for the classes of 12-year-olds and above in 20-minute intervals (5 minutes to change rooms). All the younger students can stay in their classrooms and eat there.
- Good ventilation of break room regardless of temperatures.
- Hand sanitizer available and volunteers to ensure children use it before eating.
- Different sections of the room to be used for each group, so that previously used section can be disinfected.
- Only packaged snacks and drinks will be offered.
- Two students at a time allowed in the restroom, all others need to wait in line in the hallway maintaining 3 feet of social distancing.



## 5. Procedure in Case of a Positive COVID-19 Test

- As soon as we get notified about a positive case amongst our community, we will perform contact tracing and inform all students of the respective class.
- Students from the affected class can only return to school the following week with a negative PCR test.
- A notification email will go out to the whole school informing everybody about the occurrence. The email will identify an age group without disclosing the explicit class.



## 6. Social Distancing

- As of July 25, 2021, the DPH recommends schools maintain at least 3 feet of physical distance between students within classrooms. 6 feet when singing.
- We will act in accordance with guidance from the CDC, the State of Connecticut, the individual school districts, and our landlords.
