

SCRA Field Maintenance - Scope of Work Requirements

Pre-requisites:

1. Licensed and insured company
2. Company will provide their own equipment

Daily:

1. Mow all playing fields and common space as needed and at minimum of once/week.
2. Drag all baseball infields daily during baseball season and weekly during baseball off-seasons.
3. Field preparation for competition (to include, but not limited to: painting lines, chalking lines, painting/prepping bases, placing portable mounds)
4. Trash collection as needed.

Weekly:

1. Trim and maintain fence lines and infield edges.

Additional Expectations:

1. Repair all pitching mounds and bullpens
2. Maintain and repair batting cages
3. Provide pest control (ants, wasps) as requested
4. Provide seasonal weed control
5. Provide aeration and fertilization program for all playing fields
6. Provide additional field preparation due to inclement weather
7. Repair and maintain all batters' boxes and home plates
8. Address any unsafe areas within playing fields
9. Provide all routine field maintenance supplies (chalk, quick-dry, dirt, etc.)
10. Obtain and spread infield mix on all fields as needed and at the direction of SCRA. This would be done in January/February and/or July. SCRA will reimburse for the expense of the mix once completed.

Time Constraints:

1. Due to sharing the field space with Olde Providence Elementary School, mowing and other maintenance work may have time constraints throughout the school year.
2. In addition, any field prep done on Friday for the next day's games will need to be done after the completion of Challenge/All-Star practices (usually 8:00 or later).
3. Sunday morning field prep will be needed at times throughout both the spring and fall seasons--dependent on tournament hosting opportunities.
