Santa Cruz County Lacrosse - COVID-19 Manual

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1 INTRODUCTION

Organized sports programs are an integral part of Santa Cruz County's path towards re-establishing normalcy in a world coping with the ongoing impacts of COVID-19. We at Santa Cruz County Lacrosse believe that these programs provide opportunities for the student-athletes, parents and communities alike. They help improve the physical and mental capabilities of athletes and teach players the necessary elements of sustainability within a community.

2 DISCLOSURE

This document was created with the intention to complement the Santa Cruz County and State of California Guidelines regarding social distancing, quarantine, isolation and proper sanitization practices, as well as CDC recommendations on social distancing, quarantine, and isolation during the COVID-19 pandemic. It is a living document that will be updated in accordance to changes that are made in the health orders and guidelines at the local, county and state levels.

3 SIGNAGE

Signage shall be prominently posted at each field entrance in order to inform participants/families/visitors policies regarding social distancing, avoidance of entering if they have COVID-19 symptoms which include, but not limited to fever/chills, cough, SOB, Fatigue, Body Aches, Headache, Loss of taste or smell, Congestion, Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea, and wear face coverings at all times as appropriate.

4 COMPLIANCE

Steps will be taken to comply with all applicable and current laws, health orders, or other regulations. A specific position will be designated as a COVID-19 supervisor to enforce the protocols listed in this document. Warriors Lacrosse will follow Santa Cruz County and their city's mandated requirements for face coverings and other personal protective equipment (PPE) in order to maintain compliance with any mitigation of transmission regarding COVID-19.

5 EMPLOYEE TRAINING

Warriors Lacrosse coaches and staff will be educated on protocols established by the CDC as well as provided guidance from professional health experts. All Warriors Lacrosse coaches and staff will be educated on how to recognize the symptoms of COVID-19 and know how to act responsibly if they detect or exhibit symptoms. Training will be provided on PPE (when to use, different types, how to use and wear, how to apply and dispose of). Training for cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting will be provided to all Coaches and Staff. Additional training on maintaining physical distancing requirements, wellness screening, and practice-specific policies and procedures will also be provided. Ongoing training will be provided as the policies and procedures changes due to local, county and state health orders and guidelines.

6 MEASURES TO PROTECT EMPLOYEES AND PARTICIPANTS

Warriors Lacrosse's priority is the safety and well-being of our coaches, staff, and players. We will take every necessary precaution to protect against the spread of coronavirus during our clinics and practices. A copy of this document will be provided to all staff, parents, guardians, and users (electronically or as a hard copy upon request).

6.1 PPE & DISINFECTING SUPPLIES

PPE and disinfecting supplies will be provided to Warriors Lacrosse staff at a level that is appropriate based on Santa Cruz County and federal guidelines. At a minimum, this includes hand sanitizer, disinfectant, gloves, and face coverings to be provided to staff.

6.2 PARENT/PLAYER CONTRACT

All parents/guardians and participants will be required to sign a document that requires parents and players to abide by the plan of action set forth regarding lacrosse field physical distancing requirements and best sanitation practices. These must be signed prior to being allowed to participate.

6.3 LIABILITY WAIVERS

Warriors Lacrosse will provide liability waivers as part of the club's commitment to this plan of action, which must be signed by all parents and guardians acknowledging that they understand the risks, symptoms, and plan of mitigation regarding COVID-19

6.4 OPT-OUT OPTION

Warriors Lacrosse will acknowledge, support, and respect decisions made by parents and guardians of players if they feel uncomfortable participating for any reason. If this occurs during a training or practice session, there will be a designated area for these players to sit at for the remainder of the session.

7 FIELD PREPARATION AND OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

7.1 DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Warriors Lacrosse will develop a field-specific plan that accommodates drop off and pick up while adhering to physical distancing guidelines. Carpooling is not allowed due to the mitigation of transmission.

7.2 SOCIAL/PHYSICAL DISTANCING PRACTICES

Warriors Lacrosse staff will limit the number of people at the field at any one time. These mandatory and capped limits and distancing policies will be in place based on county, state and federal guidelines.

7.2.1 6-foot distance

Players and coaches are to maintain at least a 6-foot distance from one another at all times.

7.2.2 No contact/touching

There will be no physical touching permitted with any team participant or fellow staff member. Hugs, high-fives, fist bumps, etc. are not permitted.

7.2.3 Players only on field

Parents, siblings, and guardians are not allowed on the field. There will be absolutely no congregating or waiting for players on the field. We encourage parents to remain in their vehicle if they choose to stay for the duration of practice.

7.2.4 Face coverings

All staff and players must wear face coverings when entering and leaving the field. All staff must wear face coverings at all times during the training sessions. If parents leave their vehicle in the proximity of the field they are also asked to wear a face covering. This is a mandatory practice to mitigate transmission.

7.2.5 Hand sanitizer

To minimize sharing of items and reduce possible transmission, we strongly encourage all players to bring their own hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol to be used before, after, and during training or drill sessions. Hand sanitizer will also be available field side, in the event a player forgets or runs out of personal hand sanitizer.

8 HEALTH SCREENING

Parents must perform a health check of their player just prior to attending each session which includes a mandatory at-home temperature check of each player.

If any staff or participant has a temperature of 100.4 degrees or greater or any COVID-19 symptoms or exposure to COVID-19 cases, they will not be allowed to attend and should fill out the [Warriors Lacrosse Confidential Reporting COVID-19 Symptoms or Exposure Form](#).

8.1 AT HOME SCREENING QUESTIONS

Within the last 14 days have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or had a test confirming you have the virus?

No? Continue to the next question.

Yes! STAY HOME and seek medical care and testing and call 2-1-1.

Do you live in the same household with, or have you had close contact with, someone who in the past 14 days has been in isolation for COVID-19 or had a test confirming they have the virus? Close contact is less than 6 feet for 15 minutes or more.

No? Continue to the next question.

Yes! STAY HOME and seek medical care and testing and call 2-1-1.

Have you had any one or more of these symptoms today or within the past 24 hours? Are these symptoms new or not explained by another reason?

- Fever or Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath/trouble breathing
- Night sweats
- Sore throat
- Muscle/body aches
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Congestion or Runny Nose
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea

No? Continue to the field!

Yes! STAY HOME and seek medical care and testing and call 2-1-1.

Parents must fill out the [Warriors Lacrosse Confidential Reporting COVID-19 Symptoms or Exposure Form](#) if a player has been determined to have an unexplained fever, any ill symptoms, or has had close contact with a sick individual or a confirmed case of COVID-19.

8.2 ON FIELD SAFETY PROCEDURES

8.2.1 Screening

Warriors Lacrosse staff will screen all players using the questions above upon your player's arrival at the field. Occasionally, coaches may spot check the temperature of participants as they arrive.

If any staff or participant has a temperature of 100.4 degrees or greater or any COVID-19 symptoms or exposure to COVID-19 cases, they will not be allowed to attend and the coach or Covid-19 supervisor will fill out the [Warriors Lacrosse Confidential Reporting COVID-19 Symptoms or Exposure Form](#).

8.2.2 Attendance

Coaches must keep player attendance records accurate and up to date for all training sessions. Warriors Lacrosse is required to keep a daily recorded log of participants that

enter fields for practice and training as a means of facilitating contact tracing in the event of potential exposure. The coach will confirm player attendance on an attendance sheet for each training session.

8.2.3 Signage

Will be posted at field entrance. (See section 3)

8.2.4 Equipment

Team participants will be required to bring their own equipment and water bottle. Players must handle and care for their own equipment, as staff will not be allowed to handle a participant's equipment.

Players should not touch other players' equipment, water bottles, towels, clothing, bags, etc. until shared equipment is allowed per the local, county and state guidelines (even with gloves).

Players should not touch the coach's equipment (bag, clipboard, cones, balls, etc.) or goals. Each player will have a designated location for his/her bag and water that meets social distancing guidelines.

9 MEASURES TO PREVENT CROWDING AND ENSURE SOCIAL DISTANCING

9.1.1 Arrival & departures

Practice times will be monitored and staggered to regulate the number of team participants at the field at one time.

Players within a group may not arrive at the field until the previous group has completely left, ensuring that proper sanitization and cleaning practices have been carried out before a new group of participants comes on. Players must wait in their cars until the previous teams have left the field.

9.1.2 Field space

Warriors Lacrosse staff will place line markers that will indicate six-foot spacing prior to players arriving for placement of players' equipment.

All areas for practices and training for teams will be separated by at least six feet including pathways in and out of the facility.

At no time will the team or staff assigned to that team be allowed to intermingle or move from the teams' designated area.

9.1.3 Signage & markings

Warriors Lacrosse will place signs throughout the field advising all staff and players to remain at least six-feet apart in accordance with Santa Cruz County guidelines.

Warriors Lacrosse will place markings at fields that are at least six feet apart in any area where staff and participants may form.

Warriors Lacrosse will place directional trails/paths that require staff and players to travel on designated paths in and out of a facility.

10 MEASURES TO INCREASE SANITATION

10.1.1 Disinfecting Methods

Approved disinfecting wipes or disinfectant spray will be used to disinfect equipment such as cones after each use; however, no shared equipment will be used.

10.1.2 Hand Sanitizer

To minimize sharing of items and reduce possible transmission, we strongly encourage all players to bring their own hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol to be used before, after, and during training or practices. Hand sanitizer will also be available field-side, in the event a player forgets or runs out of personal hand sanitizer. PPE including hand sanitizer, disinfectant, gloves, and face coverings will be provided to staff.

10.1.3 Restrooms

Will be available at the discretion of the city for emergency use only.

11 WARRIORS LACROSSE COOPERATION WITH COUNTY REPORTING OF COVID-19 CASES & CONTACT TRACING

11.1 REPORTING & CONTACT TRACING FOR SUSPECTED, PRESUMPTIVE, AND CONFIRMED CASES

Warriors Lacrosse will contact Santa Cruz County with any suspected or confirmed Covid-19 case.

Warriors Lacrosse will generally follow the process listed below for suspected and confirmed cases based on CDC and state guidelines, however, measures recommended or required by California State and/or Santa Cruz County's contact tracing programs may supersede any CDC policy.

11.1.1 What is Contact Tracing and how does it work?

11.2 ILLNESS OR SUSPECTED COVID-19 CASE(S)

Warriors Lacrosse coaches and staff will identify an area to separate anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms.

Any player, coach, or staff exhibiting symptoms will immediately be required to wear a face covering and wait in an isolated area until they can be transported home or to a healthcare facility, as soon as practicable. For serious illness, a coach or staff will call 9-1-1 without delay.

Parents and/or coaches will submit the [Warriors Lacrosse Confidential Reporting COVID-19 Symptoms or Exposure Form](#).

11.3 CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE(S)

Warriors Lacrosse COVID-19 Supervisor Richard Yee will notify the County of Santa Cruz County Public Health Department immediately of any positive COVID-19 case. Warriors Lacrosse will provide information regarding close contacts to the County of Santa Cruz Public Health Department as requested.

Per contact tracing protocols, Santa Cruz County may advise close contacts to get COVID-19 tests and remain quarantined at home for 14 days or as required by the county health officials.

Warriors Lacrosse will notify all families in the community of a possible exposure to a positive COVID-19 case while maintaining confidentiality as required by state and federal laws.

Warriors Lacrosse or the city field maintenance crew will close off areas used by any sick person for cleaning and disinfection. For outdoor areas, this includes surfaces or shared objects in the area, if applicable. To reduce risk of exposure, Warriors Lacrosse or the city will wait 24 hours or as long as practical before cleaning and disinfecting. Staff will ensure a safe and correct application of disinfectants using personal protective equipment.

11.4 CLOSE CONTACTS TO CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE(S)

Close contacts (household or non-household) of confirmed COVID-19 cases will be sent home immediately, instructed to seek medical advice, and follow the guidance of the county contract tracing program.

Close contacts may consider COVID-19 testing immediately and on day 10 of the last day of exposure to the case.

Close contacts should, even if they test negative, remain in quarantine for a full 14 days after (1) date of last exposure to COVID-19 positive non-household contact or (2) date that COVID-19 positive household member completes their isolation.

No actions need to be taken for persons who have not had direct contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case, and instead have had close contact with persons who were in direct contact.

12 EXPECTED PLAYER AND FAMILY RESPONSE TO SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED CASES AND CLOSE CONTACTS

12.1 SANTA CRUZ COUNTY ISOLATION & QUARANTINE GUIDANCE

Players with suspected or confirmed Covid-19, or suspected or confirmed cases in the household or from close contacts must follow the County of Santa Cruz criteria to discontinue home isolation as described in the section below.

12.2 SANTA CRUZ COUNTY GUIDELINES FOR SELF-ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE FOR SUSPECTED COVID-19 CASES

12.2.1 Symptomatic individuals – negative test

Symptomatic individuals who test negative for COVID-19 can return 72 hours after resolution of fever (if any) and improvement in symptoms. Documentation of a negative test result should be provided to Warriors Lacrosse Coach and the Warriors Lacrosse COVID-19 Supervisor. In lieu of a negative test result, players and staff may return to play with a medical note by a physician that provides alternative explanation for symptoms and reason for not ordering COVID-19 testing.

12.2.2 Symptomatic individuals – positive test

Symptomatic individuals who test positive for COVID-19 can return 14 days after symptom onset OR 7 days after resolution of fever and improvement in other symptoms, whichever is longer.

12.2.3 Asymptomatic individuals – positive test

Asymptomatic individuals who test positive for COVID-19 can return 14 days after their positive test result.

12.2.4 Close contacts – positive test

If they test positive, close contacts to confirmed COVID-19 cases can return after completing the required isolation period described above.

12.2.5 Close contacts – negative test

If they test negative, close contacts to confirmed COVID-19 cases can return a full 14 days after (1) date of last exposure to COVID-19 positive non-household contact or (2) date that COVID-19 positive household member completes their isolation.

13 POST COVID-19 EXPOSURE RETURN TO PLAY CLEARANCE

13.1 MANDATORY PHYSICIAN'S NOTE FOR RETURN TO PLAY

In addition to completing all the required medical, isolation and quarantine guidance above, parents or guardians of players must provide a medical note from a physician with a date for clearing the player for return to play. This note is private protected health information and must be provided ONLY to the Covid-19 Supervisor, not to the coach or other team volunteer.

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING – THIS LIMITS WARRIOR LACROSSE'S LIABILITY

The following document constitutes an assumption of risk and release of liability pertaining to the consideration of acceptance of _____(Child's Name) entry into and participation in Warriors Lacrosse for the 2020-2021 season. I, _____(Parent/Guardian Name), do hereby sponsor the child's entry.

By signing this Agreement, I acknowledge my understanding that Coronavirus (COVID-19) is an extremely contagious disease that spreads easily through person-to-person contact and may be spread by persons who are not exhibiting any symptoms. Participating in Warriors Lacrosse activities includes personal contact which carries the risk of contracting COVID-19. I acknowledge and agree, on behalf of my child and on behalf of myself, to assume all risks associated with potential exposure to COVID-19 and to release the Released Parties from all liability associated with COVID-19 in connection with Warriors Lacrosse activities as set forth in this document. Warriors Lacrosse will take reasonable precautions to mitigate the risk of transmission inherent in the activities, but in no way warrants that COVID-19 infection will not occur through participation in Warriors Lacrosse Activities.

I understand that COVID-19 can cause physical and/or psychological injury, including, but not limited to, serious, permanent bodily injury, paralysis, illness, and/or death, to my child and to me. I knowingly and freely assume these risks, for my child and for myself, from any cause, including the alleged action, inaction, or negligence of Warriors Lacrosse, its current and former agents, directors, officers, employees, representatives, and affiliates (collectively the "Released Parties"), or by defects in equipment or instruction. I assume full responsibility for my child's participation in Warriors Lacrosse Activities. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at Warriors Lacrosse Activities may be associated with the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

My child and I agree not to make a claim against or sue the Released Parties, and my child and I release, forever discharge, and agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against all demands, actions, claims, rights, causes of action, losses, liability, costs, and expenses, including attorneys' fees, related

in any way to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) arising out of or in connection with my child's participation in Warriors Lacrosse Activities, whether caused by the action, inaction, or active or passive negligence of the Released Parties, my child or any other party, or otherwise, and whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during or after participation in Warriors Lacrosse activities. This Agreement shall be governed by California law and shall be interpreted as broadly as possible under the law.

This assumption of risk and release of liability is binding on myself, my child, and our heirs, executors, representatives, administrators, and assigns. This signed assumption of risk and waiver of liability is effective as of the date that it is signed.

WARRIORS LACROSSE ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT TO TREAT (General Liability Waiver)

Assumption of Risk & Release of Liability Agreement Relating to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING – THIS LIMITS WARRIORS LACROSSE'S LIABILITY

I, on behalf of myself and/or my child (collectively referred to as "I", "my", or "me") have voluntarily chosen to participate in recreational activities and instruction and training in those activities, including but not limited to lacrosse practice and competition, athletic training, and all coaching, instruction and travel associated with these activities (collectively, "the Activities"). I understand that my participation in the Activities poses inherent and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. The risks associated with the Activities include, but are not limited to, collisions and encounters with other participants, coaches, referees, and spectators; collisions and encounters with sports equipment including but not limited to lacrosse balls and goal posts; concussions and other injuries associated with lacrosse play, whether or not allowed under the applicable rules; falls; uneven field and playing surface conditions; natural and artificial field surfaces; hazards and illnesses associated with changes in or extremes of weather and temperature; risks posed by animals and insects; and potential exposure to communicable disease (including but not limited to coronavirus/COVID-19, other viruses, bacteria, and all other infectious pathogens and disease vectors). The risks also include hazards and dangers associated with the use of manmade equipment, structures, vehicles, and materials, including my own or others' misuse, defect, failure, or inadequacy of equipment. I am aware that I will be in close proximity and contact with others during the course of the Activities. Other risks include those associated with the use of all facilities and Activities locations, including home and away field locations (collectively, "Use of the Facilities"). Despite these risks and all other risks, and **TO THE FULLEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, I AGREE TO EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH** that might be associated with or arise out of my participation in the Activities or Use of the Facilities.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the Activities and being permitted to engage in Use of the Facilities, **I AGREE TO RELEASE FROM ANY LEGAL LIABILITY AND AGREE NEVER TO SUE** Warriors Lacrosse, US Lacrosse, and all of their successors, heirs, assigns, directors, officers, partners, investors, shareholders, members, agents, employees, owners, volunteers, facility landowners, parent and subsidiary companies, and affiliated companies (collectively herein, "Warriors Lacrosse") for injury or death resulting from my participation in the Activities or Use of the Facilities, regardless of the

cause, including the alleged **NEGLIGENCE** of Warriors Lacrosse. I further **AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Warriors Lacrosse for any claims, lawsuits, damages, attorney fees, costs or judgments arising out of my participation in the Activities or Use of the Facilities.

I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY that will apply whenever I participate in the Activities or engage in Use of the Facilities associated with Warriors Lacrosse. I understand that this **RELEASE OF LIABILITY** will prevent me, my child, and our representatives and heirs from filing suit or making any claim for damages in the event of injury or death from my or my child's participation in the Activities or Use of the Facilities. Additionally, in the event I file or my child or any legal representative files a claim or a lawsuit arising out of my or my child's participation in the Activities or the Use of the Facilities, **I AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Warriors Lacrosse for any damages, attorney's fees, or costs arising out of such a claim or a lawsuit. With a full understanding of this agreement, I enter into it freely and voluntarily and agree that it is binding upon me, my child, our heirs, assigns and legal representatives.

I acknowledge that Warriors Lacrosse's representatives and/or other participants may photograph or videotape the Activities and facilities, including my participation therein. I agree that Warriors Lacrosse may use these recordings in any way, including but not limited to for marketing, fundraising, or evidentiary purposes, without compensation or restriction.

I agree and consent that, if I become injured or ill, Warriors Lacrosse staff may respond to the situation as deemed advisable or necessary, in Warriors Lacrosse's sole discretion. I authorize Warriors Lacrosse to provide first aid and to transfer my care to any medical provider including but not limited to emergency responders, paramedics, ambulance transportation, doctors, dentists, and hospitals. I agree to be solely responsible for the costs of any such treatment, and agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Warriors Lacrosse regarding any such costs.

I understand and agree that this agreement is severable and that if any clause is found to be invalid, the balance of the contract will remain in effect and will be valid and enforceable. I agree that any action involving this agreement must be brought in the courts of Santa Cruz County, California, and will be subject to and determined under California law.
