

Seneca Valley Junior Football Association Cheerleading Guidelines for Teen Coaches

Student Coaches Duties & Obligations

- Will be called "teen coaches" and are all equal.
- Must call your Head Coach if you will not be attending practice or a game.
- Must communicate with each other. If one can't make practice or game, one should call the other coaches and let them know.
- Must have a teen coach present at every game.
- No teen coaches' boyfriends should be visiting them during practices or the games. They can sit in the bleachers, but they should not be with the team. Teen coaches should conduct themselves accordingly when they are with the girls and their boyfriends.
- No smoking, drinking or swearing in front of the girls. Any teen coach caught smoking or drinking will be removed immediately.
- All teen coaches are to be dressed to cheer; no bare midriffs, no dangling earrings. Proper attire and footwear are required.
- Some type of Seneca Valley attire must be worn at games.
- Teen coaches will not deal with parent issues. This will be handled by the Head Coach. Parents should be directed to the Head Coach.
- Every team is to have a stretching warm up time before practice begins.
- Remember the head coaches are in charge of the squad. A respectful attitude must be maintained towards the head coach at all times.
