Tournament fees are included in your 2017 Fall OLC registration fee. Entry form is due **September 27th**.
Entries received after 9/27 risk not being able to play in the tournament. Participation is not mandatory.
All players 10U and up are eligible.

Teams will be created equally based on player skill level and OLC Coach recommendation. No requests to be a on a specific team will be honored.

- Divisions** Boys & Girls Teams — 3rd Grade through 8th Grade, JV and High School
Depending on number of teams, grade levels may be combined.
- Rosters** Parents must complete the parent waiver form prior to the start of the tournament. If the Lincoln YMCA does not receive the parent waiver form before the start of the tournament, the player will be ineligible to participate.
- Game Times** Game times are Saturday between 9:00 a.m.—6:00 p.m. and Sunday between 9:00 a.m.—6:00 p.m. The YMCA finds it necessary to schedule games on Sunday morning. Lincoln offers a variety of churches with convenient times and locations. We want all teams to be aware that some games will be scheduled on Sunday morning.
- Registration Deadline** Registration deadline is September 27, 2017
The YMCA reserves the right to refuse any player/team/coach. This refusal may be dependent on behavior of player/team/coach in previous YMCA tournaments/leagues.
- Awards** Awards will be given out based on number of teams in brackets. All brackets will be awarded 1st and 2nd medals.
- Site** YMCA Spirit Park (420 S. 84th St.)
OLC players will play 7 v 7 on a short-sided field.
- Pairings Information** All teams will be scheduled for 4 games.
All tournament information (schedules, rules, site locations, etc.) will be available online at ymcalincoln.org/youth on Friday, October 13, 2017.
- Rules** Rules to be aware of include:
1. Two 20 minute running clock halves. Clock stops after goals, flag penalties and serious injuries.
2. The National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) and US Lacrosse rules will be used.
3. Games will be scheduled in 1 hour time blocks
4. One four minute halftime
5. One 2 minute timeout per half
6. All age groups can use long poles.
7. Overtime (pool play games) - Game will go to a 3 person shootout, if still tied, the shootout will continue in a sudden victory finish. Shot blocker will be used for shootout. Overtime (bracket play) - In bracket play, teams will play a 4-minute sudden victory overtime period until a winner has been decided.
