Acknowledgement 3.	<p>Calendar Fundraiser</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Registration fees cover approximately 50% of the NPF Football and Spirit operating budget. As such, fundraising is not a nice-to-have, it is a <i>must</i>-have. Every NPF Football and Spirit Program participant will be required to sell 5 calendar raffles valued at \$5 each for a total of \$25. NPF Football and Spirit Program participants must have complete this requirement no later than August 14 and prior to the taking the field for the first game on August 20. As in every season, we will have our main fundraiser, which will be determined by our Fundraising Director after suggestions and ideas have been presented. There will also be a post-season fundraiser that will be specifically for the travel fund. Thank you for your understanding and support of NPF.
Acknowledgement 4.	<p>Volunteering and Fundraising Commitment & Equipment Deposit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The NPF Volunteer Community logs over 20,000 hours annually, which allows us the opportunity to maintain the NPF Football and Spirit Program. NPF Football and Spirit equipment is very costly and we simply can't afford not having all our equipment returned - a helmet and a cheer uniform costs in excess of \$200. Every NPF Football and Spirit Program participant is required to provide a \$150 deposit in the form of a post-dated check for 12/1/2017. The Commitment check covers volunteering and fundraising requirements. Each family will be required to do a minimum of two volunteer sign-ups (depending on team size and the number of full time volunteers) during the season, per child, and one in the post-season depending on the needs of the league. Every NPF Football and Spirit Program participant is required to provide a deposit for their equipment and uniform. This will also be in the form of a post-dated check for 12/1/2017. \$50 for flag, \$200 for Spirit and Tackle Football. Any family that does not complete their commitment (volunteering and fundraising) and/or return their equipment in acceptable condition on the specified date and time will forfeit their deposit. Your check will be cashed and no refund will be issued. Thank you for your understanding and support of NPF.
