These five players had impressive offensive performances in Week 2:

KEVIN BUFORD

Canton: He ran for 90 yards, caught five passes for 88 yards, returned a punt 89 yards for a TD, intercepted a pass and had five tackles and three pass breakups in a win over Grand Blanc.

JALEN COUCH

Grand Rapids Ottawa Hills: The QB scored on runs of 24, 23 and 60 yards, had 247 yards rushing and passed for 151 yards and a touchdown in a 46-25 victory over Grandville.

TRAVIS TURNER

Brooklyn Columbia Central: Set a school record with TD runs of 16, 19, 1 and 12 yards, an 82-yard punt return and a 75-yard kickoff return in a 55-8 victory over Jackson Northwest.

COOPER RUSH

Lansing Catholic Central: The QB completed 11 of 19 passes for 194 yards and two TDs, and ran for another 95 yards and a TD in a 37-17 victory over Flint Powers

Catholic.

AUSTIN MAYNARD

Parma County Western: He sparked a 21-6 victory over Erie-Mason with TD receptions of 60 and 92 yards among his 170 receiving yards as well as 115 rushing yards, including a 60-yard TD run.
