

Canton football team outmatches Ann Arbor Pioneer 35-7

Canton football team took a 28-0 halftime lead en route to four rushing touchdowns and two touchdown passes in a 35-7 win over Ann Arbor Pioneer on Friday.

Pioneer quarterbacks John Kunec and Brandon Bertoia combined for 108 yards on 11 of 20 completions. Liam Quigley had a 27-yard touchdown run, while Brad Koenig earned 32 yards on five carries, as well as four receptions for 66 yards.

Larry Vitale led the Pioneer (3-6, 1-4 SEC Red) defense with nine tackles and a sack.
