



Snack Bar Duties:

Thank you Parents for helping the snack bar! For those of you who haven't worked the snack bar before here's what you'll be doing:

1. Someone from the league will come to open the snack bar. They will help get you started and answer any questions you may have. You'll be prepping the coffee, hot water, nacho cheese, chili and hot dogs. There are signs posted on how to make the coffee, set up the hot dogs on the grill, and start the crock pots with nacho cheese and chili. You'll need to use the hot water kettle and microwave to make hot chocolate, cup of noodles, mac 'n cheese, and popcorn. Hamburgers are made on the BBQ once someone has put in an order.
2. It will be up to you and the other parents working to decide who does what tasks. It's usually best if someone takes over the register/iPad, and the others get the food orders/drinks and use the BBQ.
3. The iPad is pretty simple to use and if you mess up, it's ok, you can delete items off your order. If a parent decides to pay with a card instead of cash, just start a new sale. As long as what you sold is the same as the money you took, it's ok.
4. There might be "Team Snack" orders during your shift. It will be your responsibility to take those orders and make sure there are enough hot dogs prepared by the end of the game. You will need to know how many players, team name and what time their game ends. You will give the purchaser 1 ticket per player and write the current date on the back of the ticket. There will be an order form to write this down on so you can keep track. If you have a lot of hot dogs to prepare it's best to get those cooked 30-45 min before the game ends and store in the extra crock pot to keep warm. If you're in a pinch you can always use the BBQ. When the game is almost over it's a good idea to have a bunch of sodas pulled out so the kids can grab what they want along with their chips and the hot dog. Please remember to take their ticket. If there are any vegetarians, they can replace the hot dog & chips with nachos. Please let the purchasing parent know that the ticket is only good for that day. If a player didn't show up they can redeem the ticket(s) or you can provide them a refund. No refunds/redemptions will be accepted after the date on the ticket. Each team snack is \$3 and this price is only for the players/coaches. This is not good for individual purchase.
5. During the slow periods of your shift please restock any candy or snacks on the counter along with restocking the Gatorade and sodas in the refrigerators.
6. Someone from the league will come to close the snack bar once the games have ended. You will need to throw away any cheese, chili, hot dogs, coffee that is left over. You will need to wash the crock pots, coffee pot and utensils. Please leave the snack bar tidy.
