# Poway captures lacrosse crown

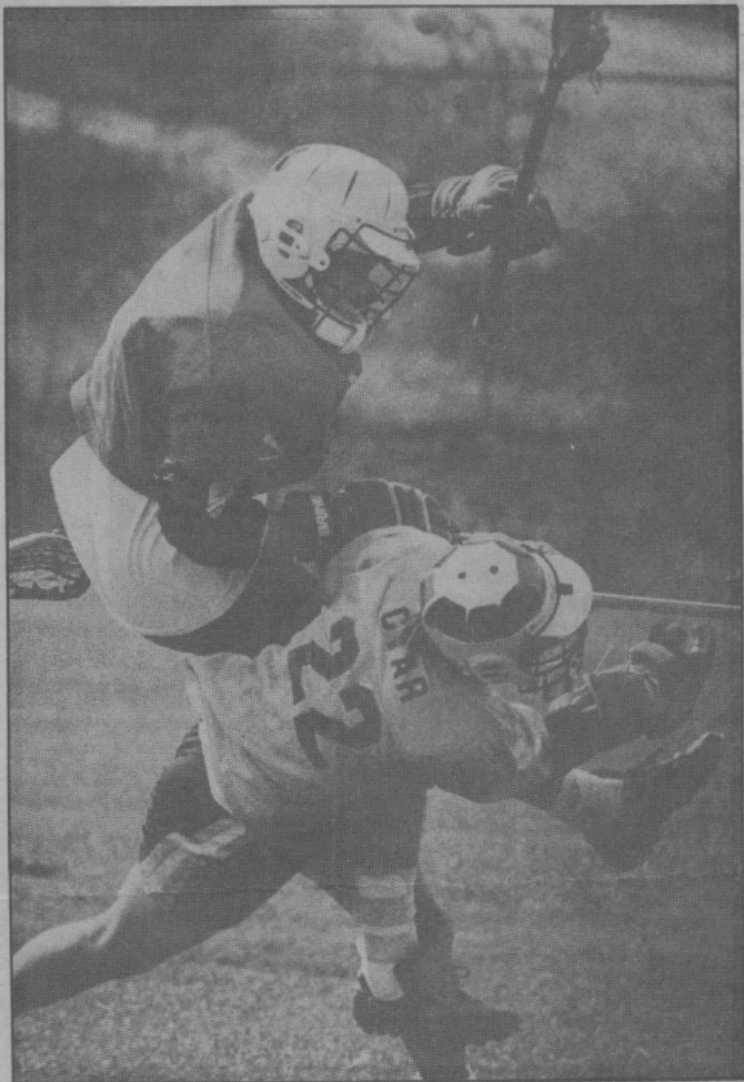
**POWAY** — Dan Rajskey fired in three goals and added an assist Friday to lead the host Poway High School lacrosse club team to a 9-1 victory over La Jolla in the San Diego County Lacrosse Association championship game.

It was 31st straight win and the second consecutive county title for Poway, which ran its record to 16-0. The Titans will meet a team from Northern California for the state championship at noon on May 20 at Balboa Stadium.

"They (La Jolla) came out running, but our guys really took off," said Poway assistant Coach Karey Gunn.

Jeff Carmichael, who scored a team-record 50 goals and 14 assists in 14 regular season games this season, added two goals and one assist for the winners. Scott Pearson also had two tallies, with Matt Miller and Drew Dies each adding one goal.

Poway, which won the Mountain Division of the San Diego County Lacrosse Association, represented Southern California last year in the state championship and lost.
