Online registration will close at midnight on **Wednesday, December 25th.**

Online Registration: You register online and pay via credit card. Once you have completed the registration AND payment process you will receive a receipt of payment.

If your payment is not made at the time of registration your information will not be saved and you will not be entered into the tournament. You WILL NOT receive a confirmation from Triple J Bout Masters. **Your wrestlereg receipt is your confirmation.** Online registration guarantees entry into the tournament. Included in the Entry Fee is \$2.00 nonrefundable fee.

Please make sure you are registered for the correct session (Novice or Open), division (8U, 10U, 12U, JH) and weight class. Refunds will not be given if you register for the wrong session, division or weight class. CAREFULLY REVIEW YOUR ENTRY BEFORE YOU SUBMIT YOUR REGISTRATION!!! Revisions can not be made after registration is completed.

RULES

PIAA Modified Rules and PIAA Certified Officials. Headgear and singlet are required.

Skin checks will be performed and any wrestler with any skin lesion(s) must provide the PIAA form filled out by a doctor to participate in the tournament. If the wrestler can not provide the form they will be removed from the tournament and refunded. The form can be found here:

Bout times will be 1-1-1. Overtime will be 1 minute sudden victory, then 30 second rideout.

Blind draw seeding. **7 mats used all day.** Proof of age must be available if challenged.

Wrestlers may enter more than one division but must pay a separate entry fee for each division.

There is no guaranteed rest time between matches if entering more than one division.

Novice Details - Round Robin - 4 man Madison Brackets

Pee Wee (6U), Bantam (8U), Midget (10U) (age on day of tournament, 12/28/2019)

Honor System Weigh Ins. A scale will be available for challenges, must be within 2 lbs of registered weight. Weight can not be challenged after 1st round or after challenger's match with wrestler being challenged.

First and Second Year Wrestlers ONLY!!! Years experience is CUMULATIVE, not consecutive.

Wrestler may not have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Tournament

Tournament director's ruling on novice eligibility challenges is FINAL!!!

Round Robin tie breaks will be head to head, number of pins, fastest pin.

If wrestler is not CHECKED IN for the event 30 MINUTES prior to event start time they will be removed from the event without refund. NO Exceptions!!!

Only first 200 registrants will be accepted
