16. CHANGES TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

- c. The Constitution and Bylaws of the League shall not be altered or added to except by a Special Resolution of the League passed by a majority of not less than 75% of the Voting Members present at an Annual General, or Special Meeting.
- d. Notice to propose a Special Resolution shall be deemed to be duly given if a signed by a proposer and seconder, both of whom shall be Voting Members, and delivered to the Commission not less than twenty (20) days prior to the Meeting, and the Commission has notified Voting Members (via mail/email) not less than fourteen (14) days before the General Meeting at which it will be dealt with.

"8(j) The Past Commissioner will be an appointed position by the League Commissioner of the day as a nonvoting member of the Commission responsible to the Membership to oversee programs and policies set forth by the Commission for a One (1) year term. The duties and responsibilities shall include (but not be limited to): 1) Serves as an Advisor to the Commission; 2) Oversees Special Projects of the league sanctioned by The Commission; 3) Supports and defends policies and programs adopted by The Commission; 4) Chairs nominating Committee; In the absence of a Past Commissioner, the League Commissioner of the day can select either a former predecessor of the Past Commissioner or a past Vice Commissioner to fill the position. The League Commissioner of the day can also leave the position vacant if choosing."

Reason: proposal to add this new position to provide legacy and historical assistance to the Commission of the day;
