Medical Injury Policy

Updated December 2014

This medical injury policy is intended to provide guidance to the Reading Youth Hockey Board of Directors on tuition matters related to a player's inability to participate in on-ice activities related to medical injuries or conditions.

It shall be the policy of Reading Youth Hockey to reserve the right to provide a pro-rated reduction in tuition to any player in good standing who sustains a medical injury or develops a medical condition that results in the player's inability to participate in on-ice activities for a period of more than six (6) consecutive weeks. This reduction is applicable whether or not the medical issue occurred as a result of the player's participation in Reading Youth Hockey activities.

The Board of Directors may, at its discretion, require attestation from a medical professional as to the nature of the medical issue and the impact on the player's ability to participate in hockey-related activities.

This policy is intended as guidance for the Reading Youth Hockey Board of Directors. The Board of Directors has the discretion to implement this policy in the manner in which it determines is in the best interest of the players, the families and the association, including a determination that a tuition reduction is not warranted.
