PROCEDURE FOR FIELD USAGE AFTER / DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER

DONOVAN FIELD

- PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME
- 1. CHECK WEBSITE TO MAKE SURE THAT FIELDS ARE OPEN AND AVAILABLE TO PLAY ON!
- 2. USE WET VAC (STORED IN SHED) TO REMOVE ANY STANDING WATER PUDDLES. THERE ARE ENOUGH EXTENTION CORDS TO REACH FROM THE BATTING CAGES TO DONOVAN. PLEASE WRAP THEM UP PROPERLY AFTER YOU USE THEM.
- 3. BROOMS HAVE NO PLACE ON A BASEBALL FIELD PLEASE DO NOT USE A BROOM TO MOVE PUDDLES!!!!
- 4. SPREAD FIELD CONDITIONER EVENLY OVER WET AREAS ALLOW A FEW MINUTES TO DRY AND GENTLY RAKE IN.
- 5. DO NOT USE TOO MUCH FIELD CONDITIONER ON PITCHERS MOUND OR BATTER'S BOXES, BECAUSE IT WILL NOT STIFFEN UP AND A PLAYER COULD GET HURT?
- 6. MOST IMPORTANTLY USE YOUR BEST JUDGEMENT IF IT WILL TAKE A LOT OF WORK TO GET A FIELD PLAYABLE THEN IT'S MOST LIKELY **NOT** PLAYABLE.

AFTER THE GAME IS OVER

- 1. BOTH TEAMS SHOULD WORK TOGETHER.
- 2. REMOVE THE BASES AND PUT IN PLUGS. BASES GO IN SHED ON THE SECOND SHELF ABOVE THE LIGHT SWITCHES.
- 3. DRAG ENTIRE INFIELD USING DRAG RAKE.

PLEASE WHEN YOU USE SOMETHING FROM THE SHED PUT IT AWAY PROPERLY SO THE SHED STAYS CLEAN AND NEAT.
