



Hommocks Park Ice Rink COVID-19

Protocols and Best Practices



At the Hommocks Park Ice Rink, our primary concern is the health and safety of our customers, staff, and all of their families. As we reopen, we are taking all possible measures to protect everyone who enters the facility. The Hommocks Park Ice Rink strictly adheres to all CDC, New York State, and Westchester County Health Department guidelines and mandates. Please see below the new protocols and best practices to facilitate that these guidelines are followed, and the facility remains clean and safe:

1. Social distancing of at least six feet is required at all times.
2. Face coverings must be worn at all times except when on the ice.
3. Customers are to enter through the front doors and exit through an ancillary side door.
4. Players must arrive fully dressed however; skates, helmets and gloves can be put on at the rink.
5. Players will only be allowed to enter ten minutes prior to their scheduled ice time.
6. Players must leave promptly after practice.
7. In accordance with the reopening New York guidelines, only individual or distanced group training Activities that are no/low contact will be permitted at this time.
8. Only one parent/guardian will be allowed to accompany the player at this time. Any parent/guardian entering the facility will be required to complete a COVID-19 waiver.
9. Rink employees will conduct frequent cleaning and disinfecting of high touch areas in addition to its normal cleaning schedule.
10. Additional hand sanitizer stations have been placed throughout the facility and are continually refilled.
11. Anyone entering the facility will be subject to health screenings prior to entering.
12. All employees are required to wear facemasks and will be required to wash or sanitize their hands regular throughout their shifts.
13. Food and beverage service is suspended, including vending. No food can be brought into the facility.
14. Water fountains are closed; however, the bottle fill station will be available. Bring your own water bottle.
15. Please follow all posted signage.
16. Locker rooms will not be available. Please do not bring or leave valuables/personal items during your visit. The Town will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
17. There will be no Lost and Found. Articles left in the facility will be disposed of.
18. Please stay home if you have a fever or a cold and/or flu like symptoms.
19. Facility occupancy limits are currently in place and will be enforced.

As COVID-19 is a fluid situation, please be advised that our guidelines and operation may change at any time at the sole discretion of management in order to maximize customer and employee safety. Management reserves the right to ask anyone not following these protocols to leave the premises.
